## City of Milwaukee Births: 1999-2008

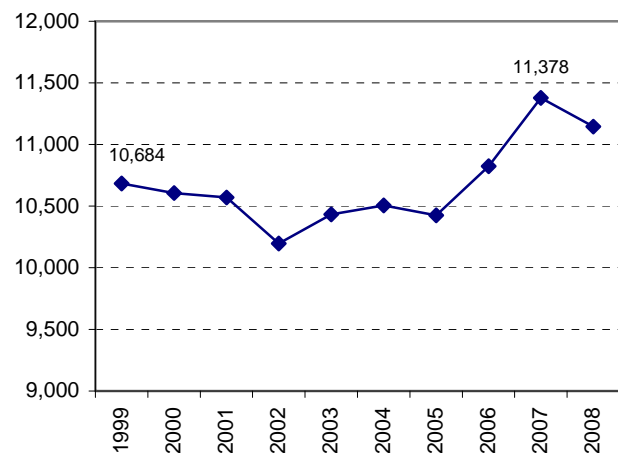
A total of 106,767 children were born to mothers living in the city of Milwaukee over the ten-year period from 1999 through 2008. Milwaukee showed a stable number of annual births (around 10,500) in the first half of the ten-year period, followed by increases beginning in 2006. The birth population of the city continues to diversify.

*Birth statistics collected by the city health department are revised by the state, and their release typically lags by 2-3 years. The next 2009 birth figures will be available in late Spring of 2011. For each birth, the following fields were provided by the Milwaukee health department: date of birth, gender, race/ethnicity of the mother (white, African American, Hispanic, Native American, Hmong, other), and the census tract and ZIP code of the mother's residence. All race/ethnicity data refers to the mother's identity.*

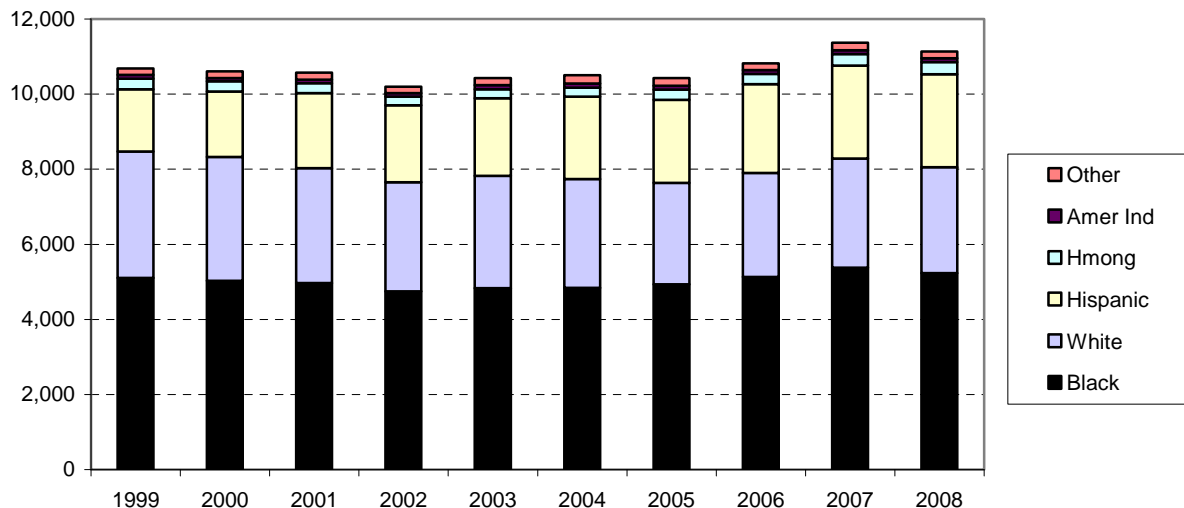
Annual births to city of Milwaukee residents remained stable at around the 10,500 level from 1999 through 2005, and then increased to 11,372 in 2007 and 11,131 in 2008.

Milwaukee births reflect a highly diverse city. A 16% decline in the number of white births over the 10-year period has been more than offset by a 49% increase in Hispanic births. African Americans showed a modest increase (2.4%) in births in 2008 compared to 1999 – after a drop in the middle years. Hmong births showed a 6.5% increase.

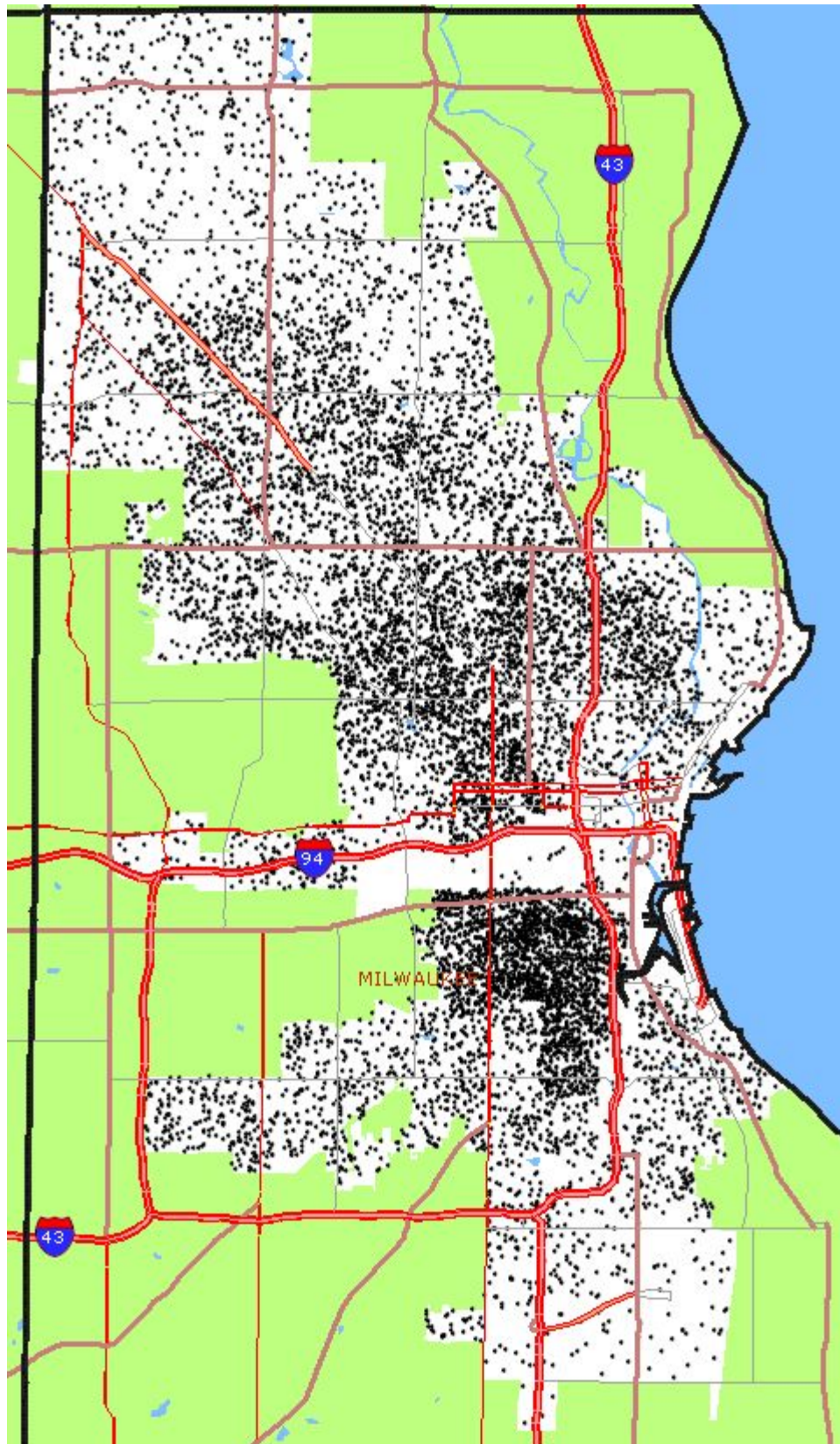

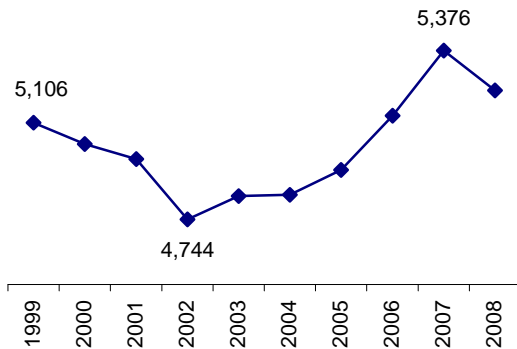


## 2008 Milwaukee Births

Each year the city has recorded a slightly higher number of births of boys than girls, with 51% of the births males and 49% females.



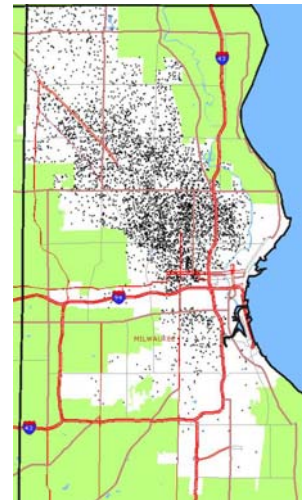
### African American Births



**African Americans** have the largest number of births each year in Milwaukee, with 47% of all births over the 10-year period.

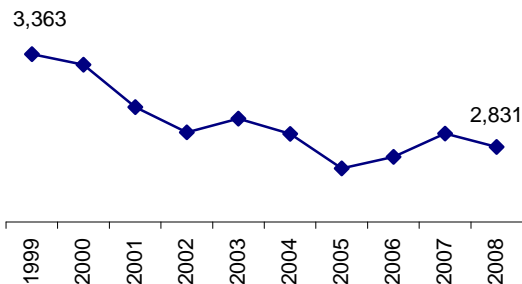
After a drop to 4,744 in 2002, African American births have totaled over 5,000 annually from 2006-2008.

African American births are highest in the north side zipcodes 53206 (N=650), 53218 (N=641), and 53209 (n=619), followed by 53216 (N=488), 53210 (N=481), and 53212 (N=369).



2008 African American Births

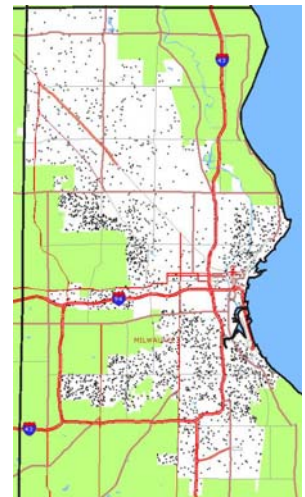
### White Births



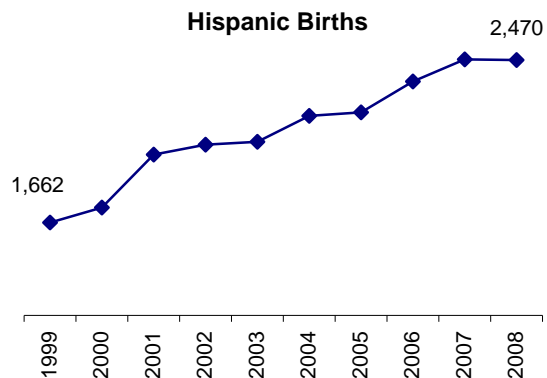
**Whites** made up 25% of all city births in 2008, down from 31% ten years earlier.

White births declined steadily from 2,363 in 1999 to a low of 2,708 in 2005, rising to 2,773 in 2006; 2,908 in 2007; and 2,831 in 2008.

In 2008 births to whites were highest on the southeast side of Milwaukee in 53207 (N=363) and 53215 (N=251), followed by 53222 (N=237) on the west and 53221 (N=236) on the south side.



2008 White Births



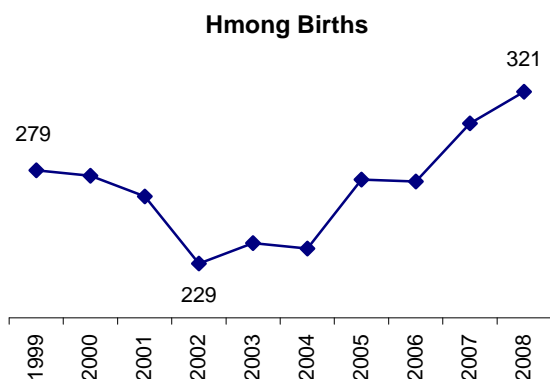
The largest birth increases have been seen among **Hispanics**, where births rose from 1,662 in 1999 to 2,470 in 2008.

Hispanics' share of total city births rose from 16% in 1999 to 22% in 2008.

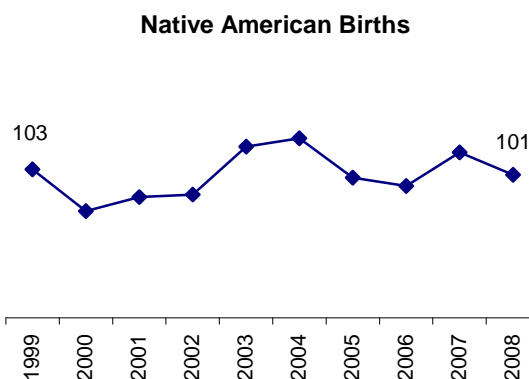
Hispanic births were most heavily concentrated in the near south side zipcodes 53215 (N=980) and 53204 (N=774) in 2008.

The number of **Hmong** births has been on the increase since 2002. In 2008 the most Hmong births were in the northwest side zipcode 53218 (N=87) and west side 53208 (N=73).



**Native Americans** have had about 100 births a year over the past decade. In 2008 the most Native American births were in the near south side zipcodes of 53215 (N=21) and 53204 (N=12).

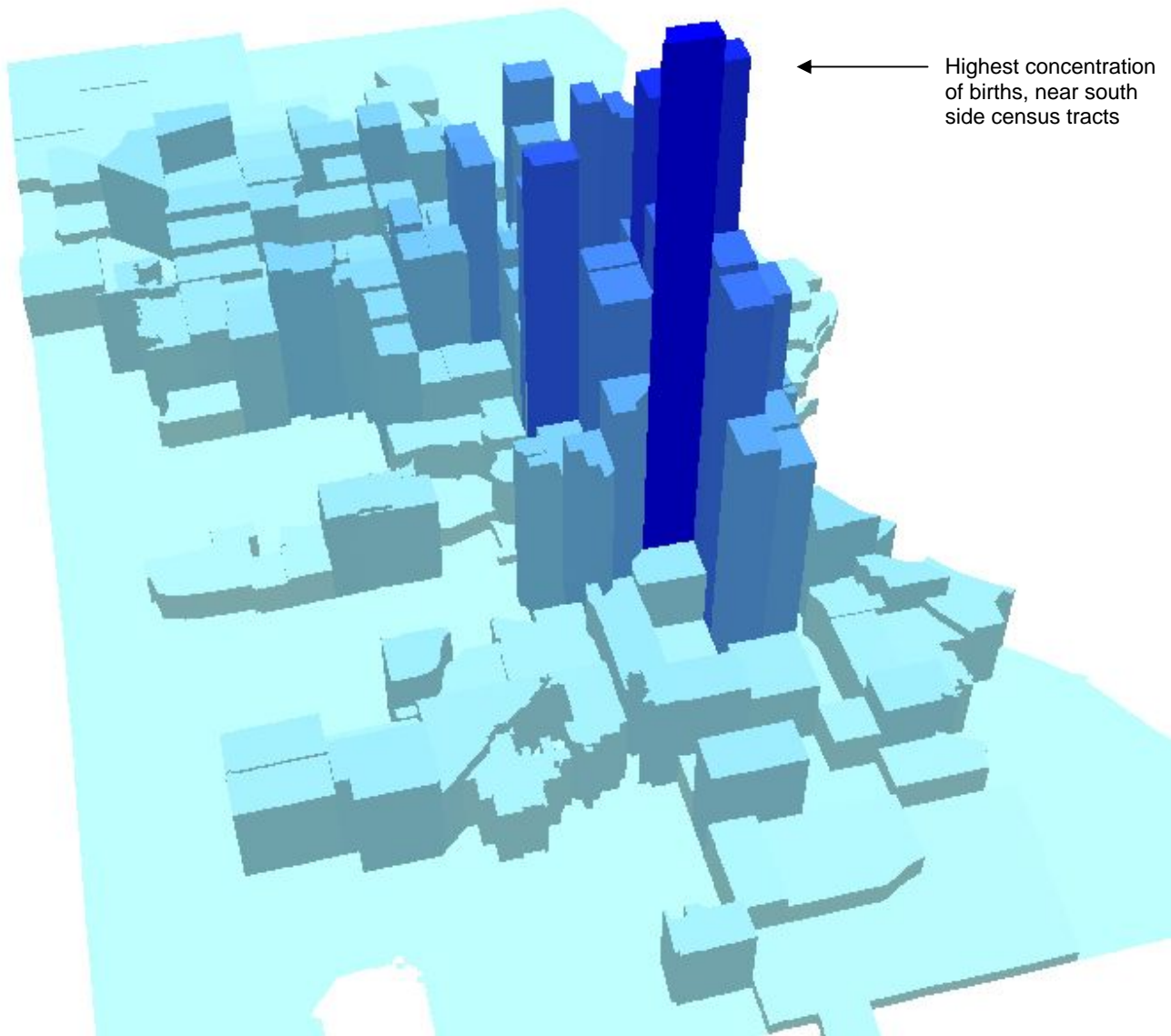

## Concentrations of the Birth Populations

Over the ten year period the highest numbers of births were seen in 2 south side zipcodes: 53215 (12,244 births) and 53204 (10,686). On the north side zipcodes 53218, 53208, 53206 and 53209 all had over 6,000 births during the 10-year period.

The map below shows concentrations of 2008 births per square mile by census tract. The highest birth density was seen in census tract 174 around S. 16<sup>th</sup> Street and Lincoln Avenue, tracts 163 and 164 around S. Cesar E. Chavez Drive and Greenfield Avenue, and tract 160 around S. 35<sup>th</sup> Street and National Avenue.

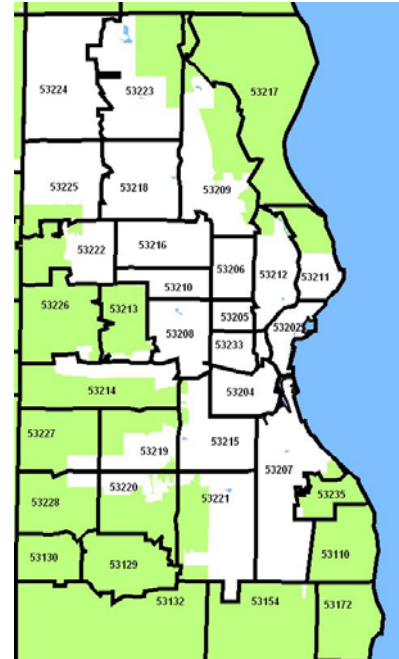
**Density of Births by Census Tract: 2008**



## Growth/Decline by Neighborhoods

When births in the most recent 3 years of the study period (2006-2008) were compared to births in the first 3 years (1999-2001), 9 zipcodes showed sizeable percent **increases**, with the highest increases seen in south side 53215 (up 24%), west side 53222 (up 22%), and south side 53221 (up 20%).

Six zipcodes showed sizeable **decreases** in births, with the largest percentage decreases on the east side in zipcode 53211 (a 30% decrease) and the west side zipcode 53214 (a 29% decrease).

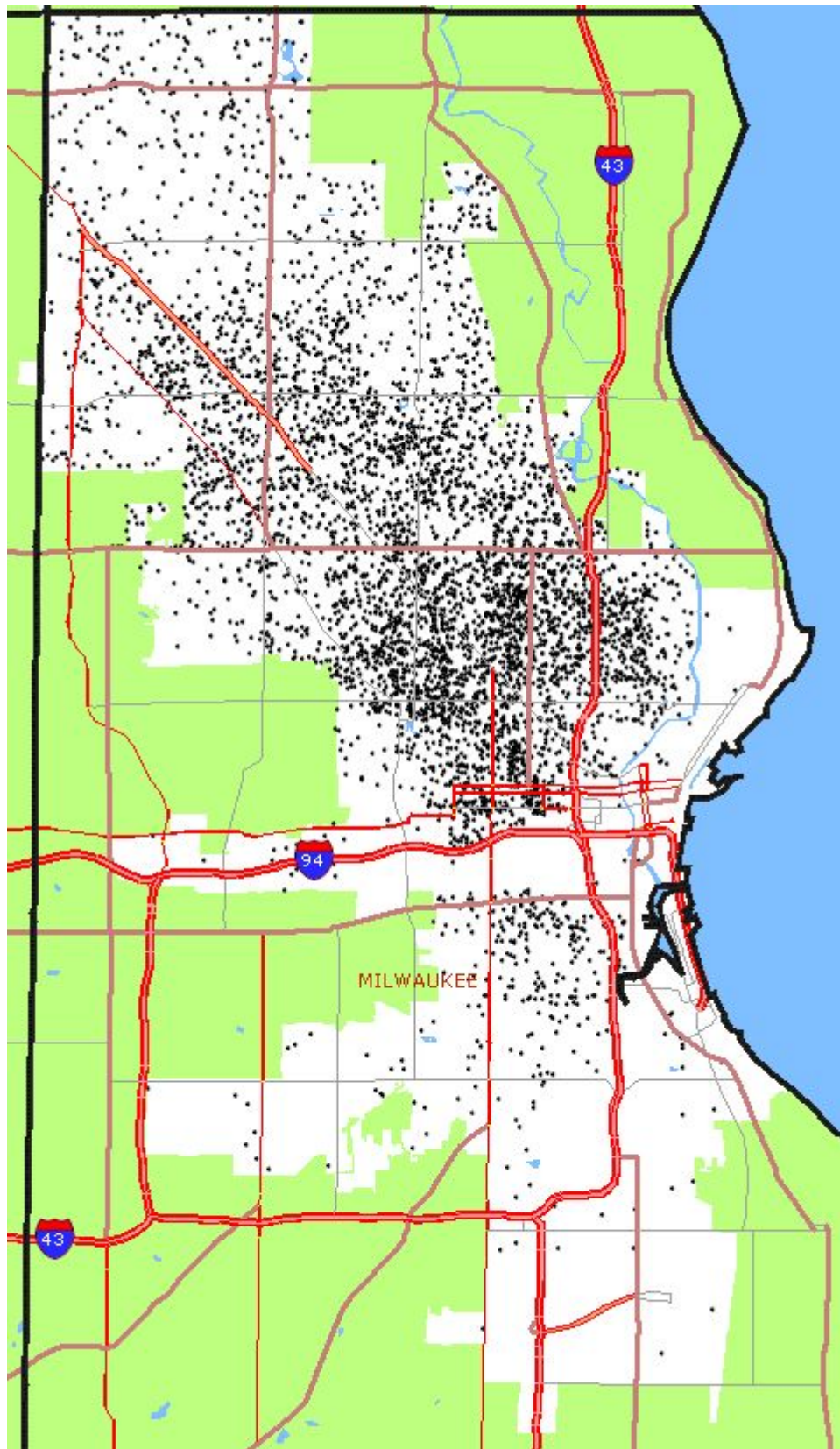

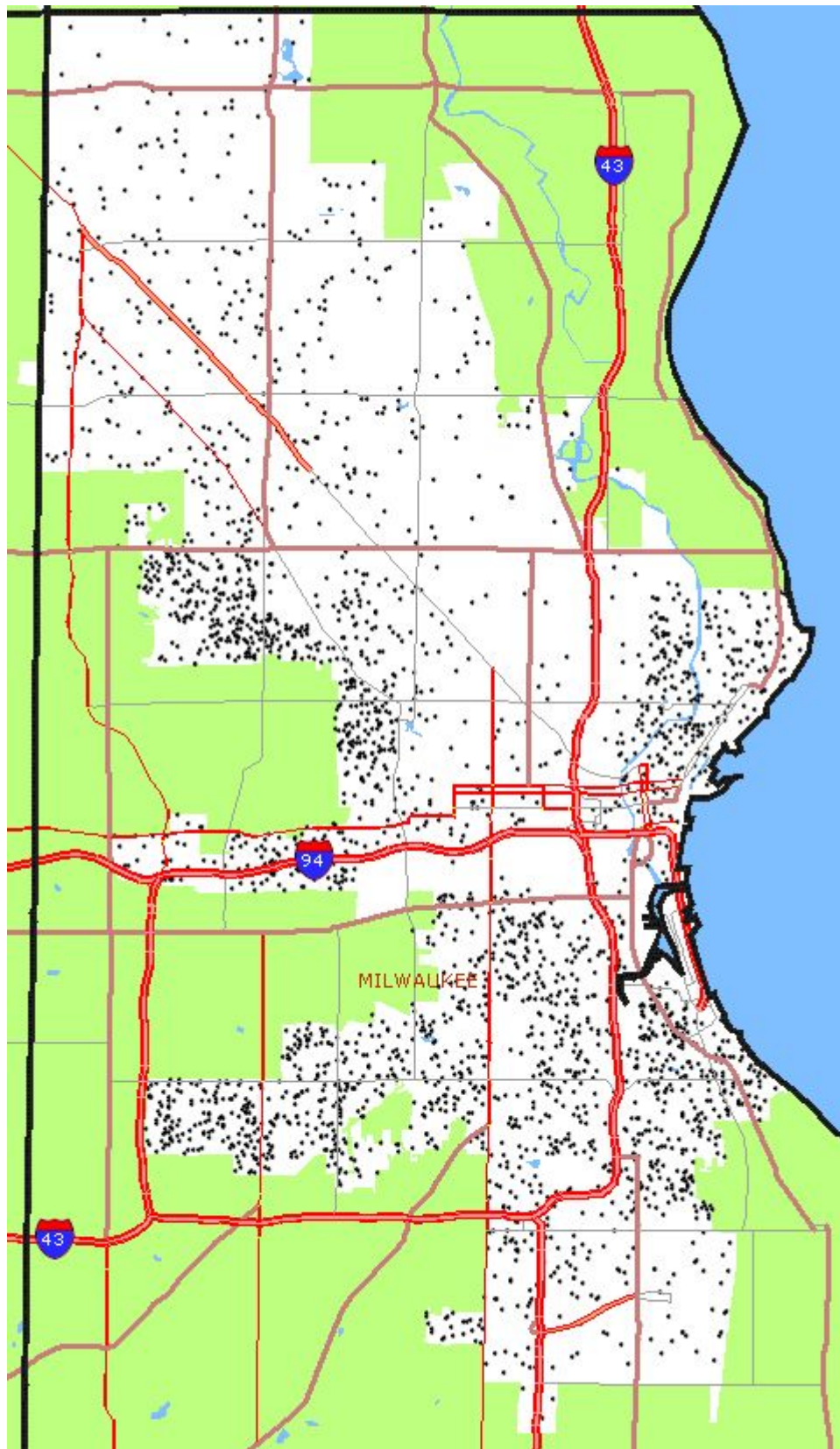


**African American Births in the City of Milwaukee: 2008**

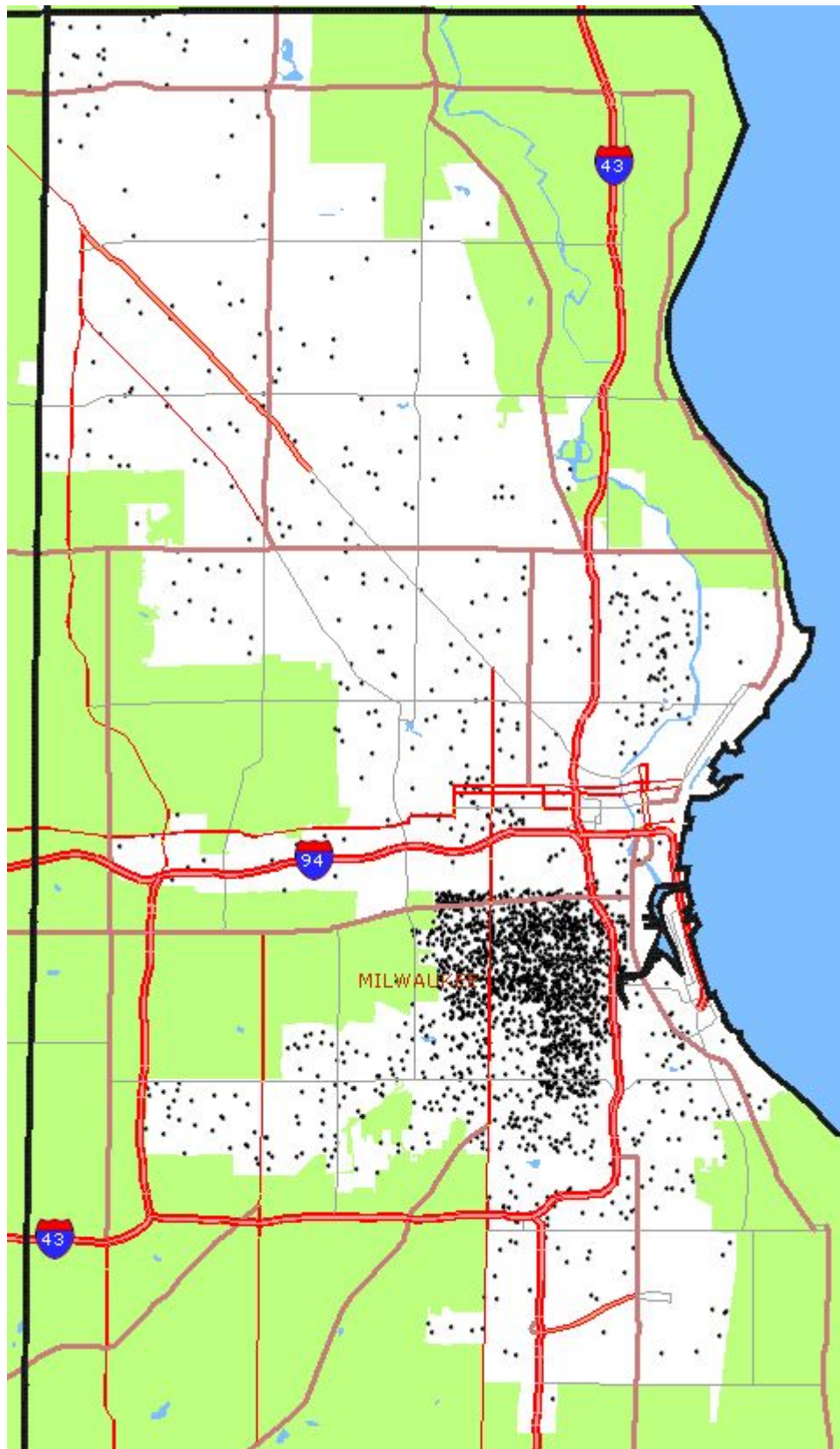
### White Births in the City of Milwaukee: 2008

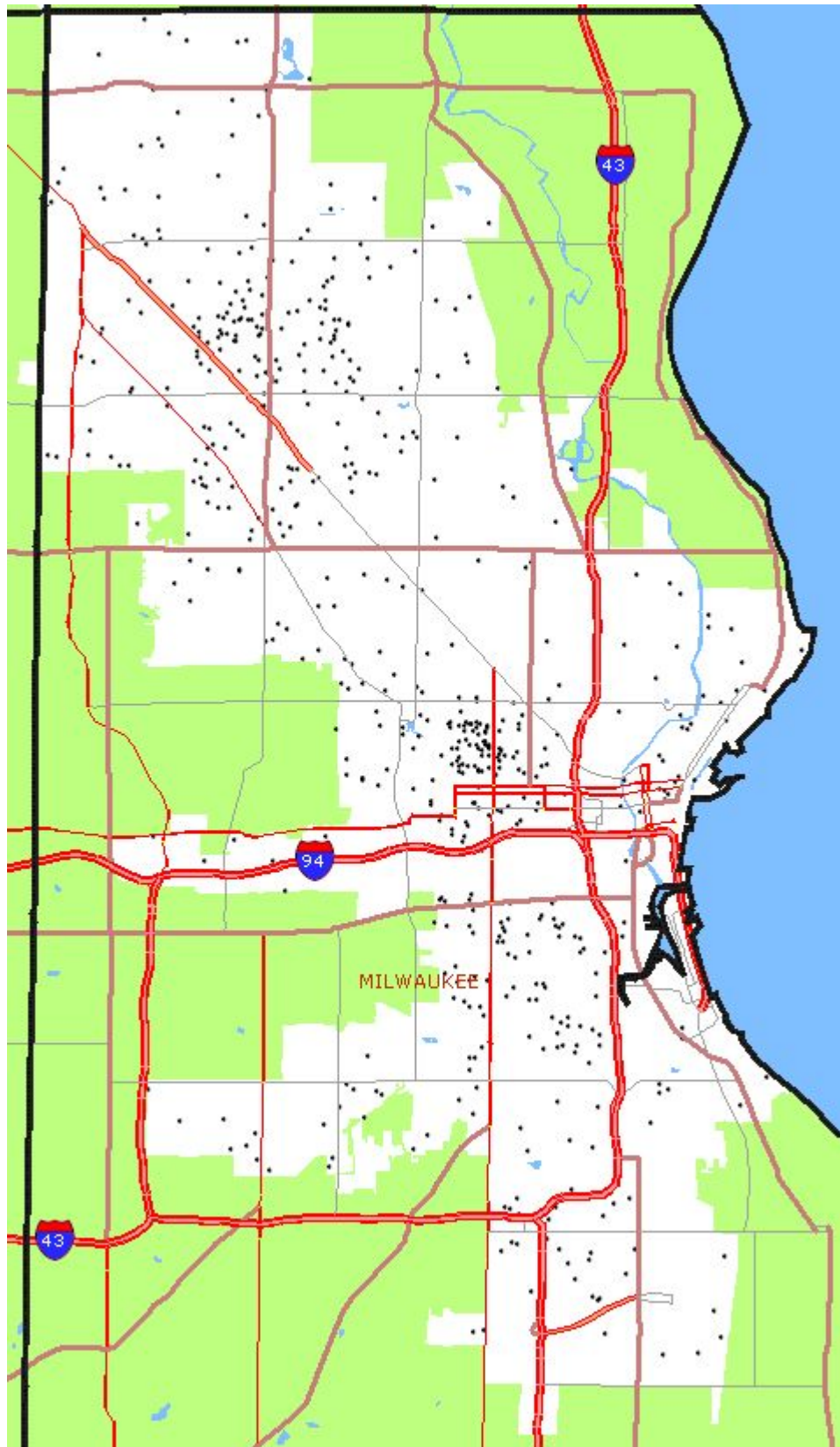


### Hispanic Births in the City of Milwaukee: 2008

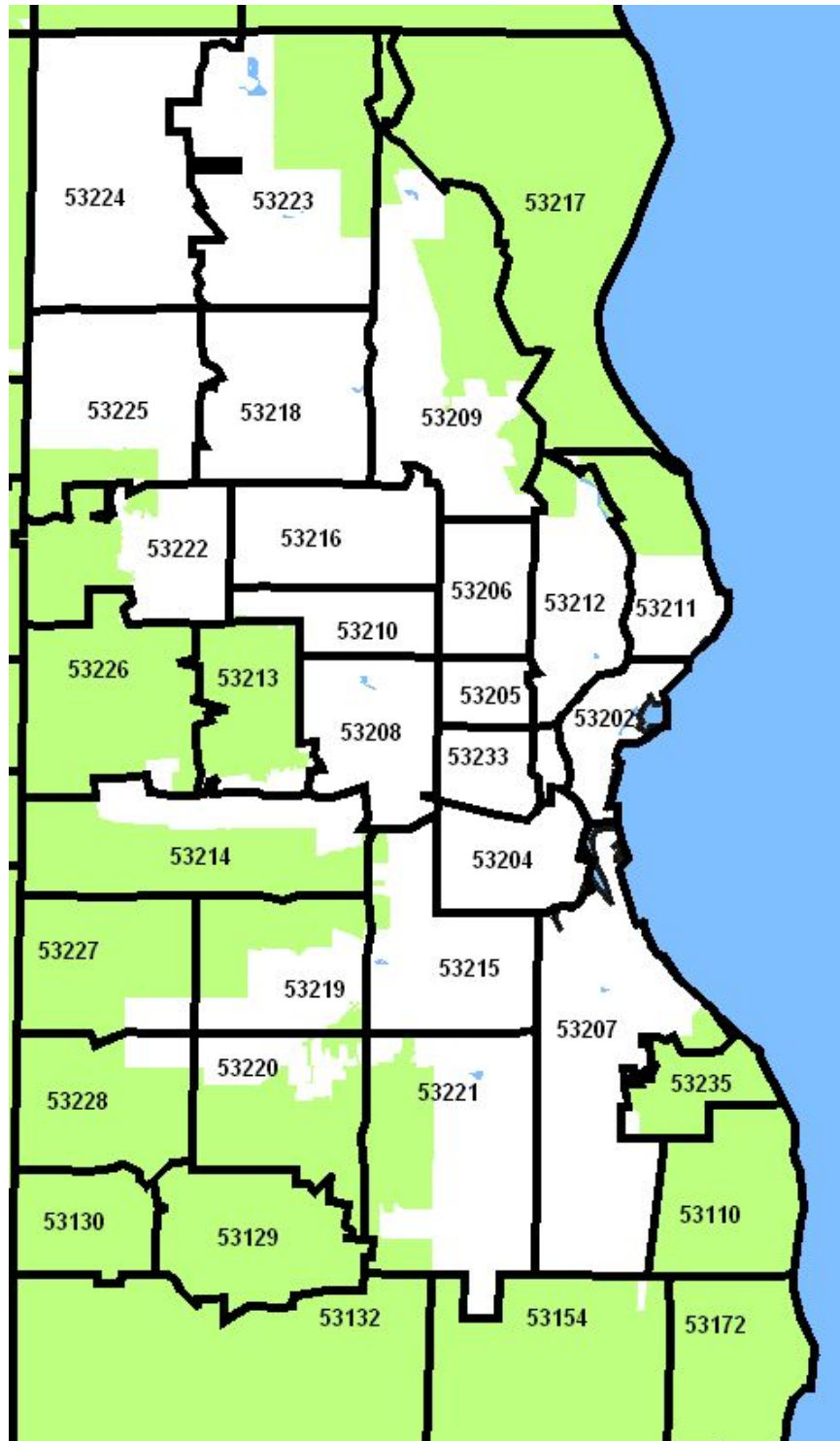

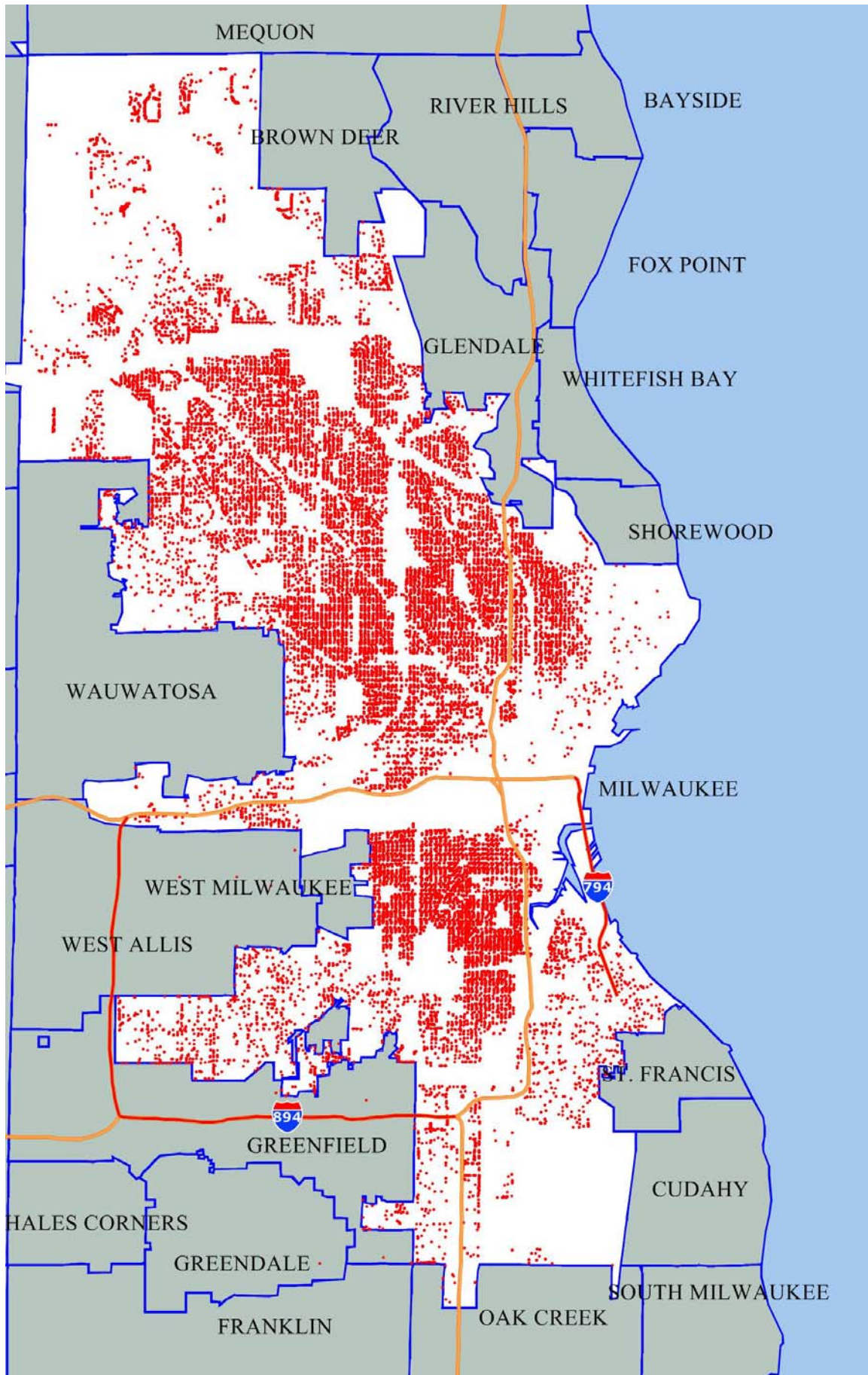

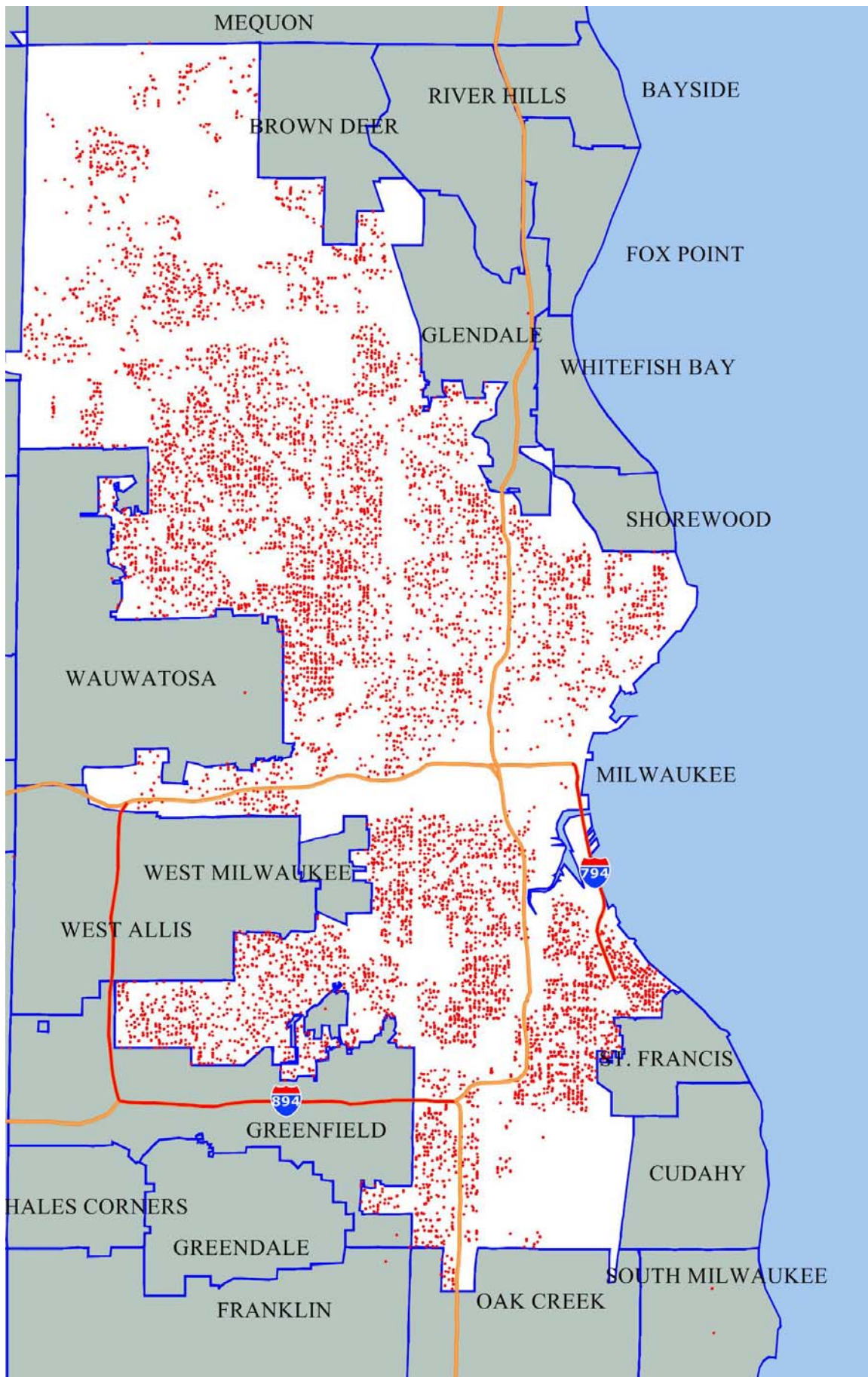

Map 1-1: Milwaukee MPS Students Eligible for Free or Reduced Price Meals (Fall 2010)



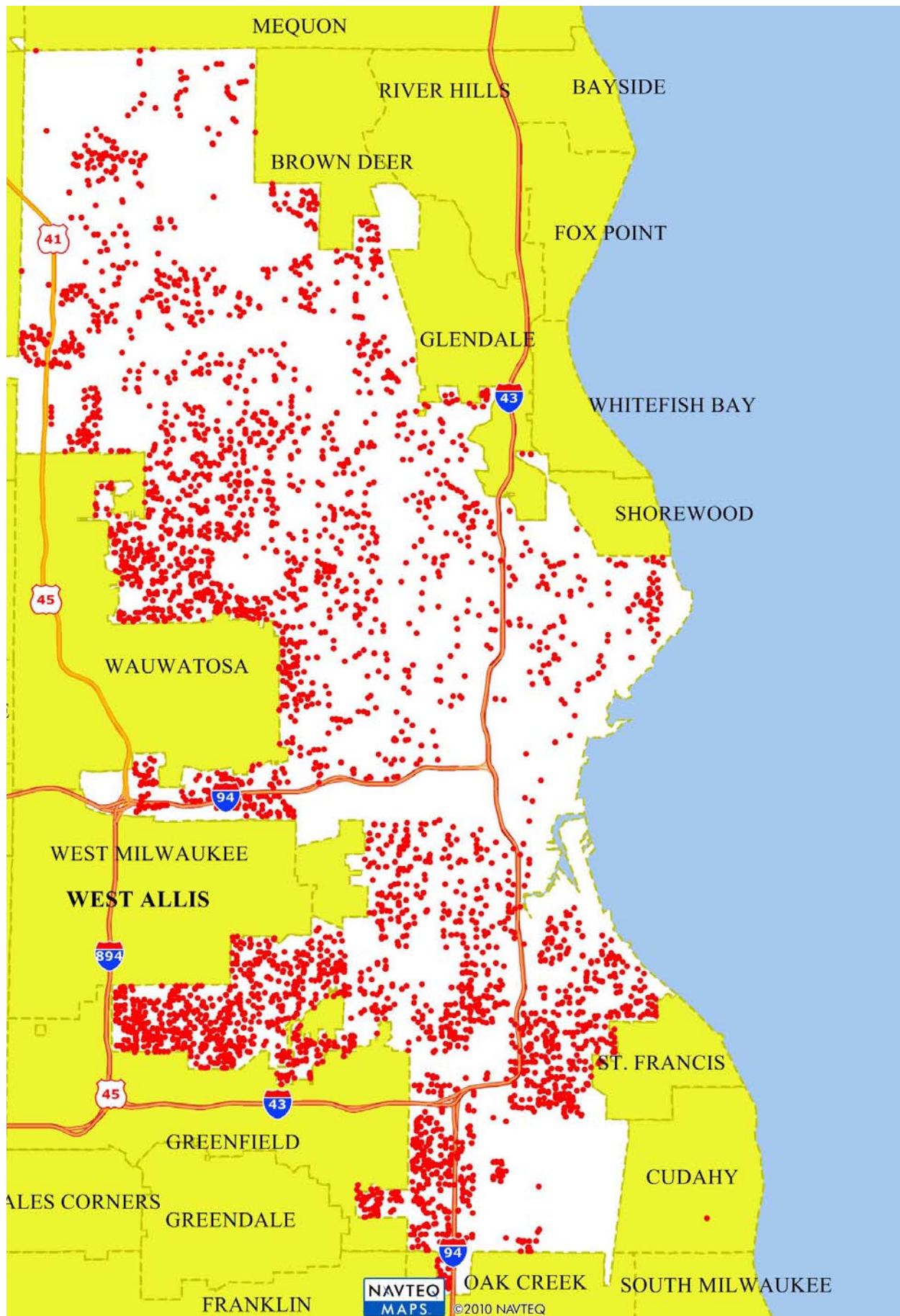


Map 1-2: Milwaukee MPS Students NOT Certified for Free or Reduced Price Meals (Fall 2010)

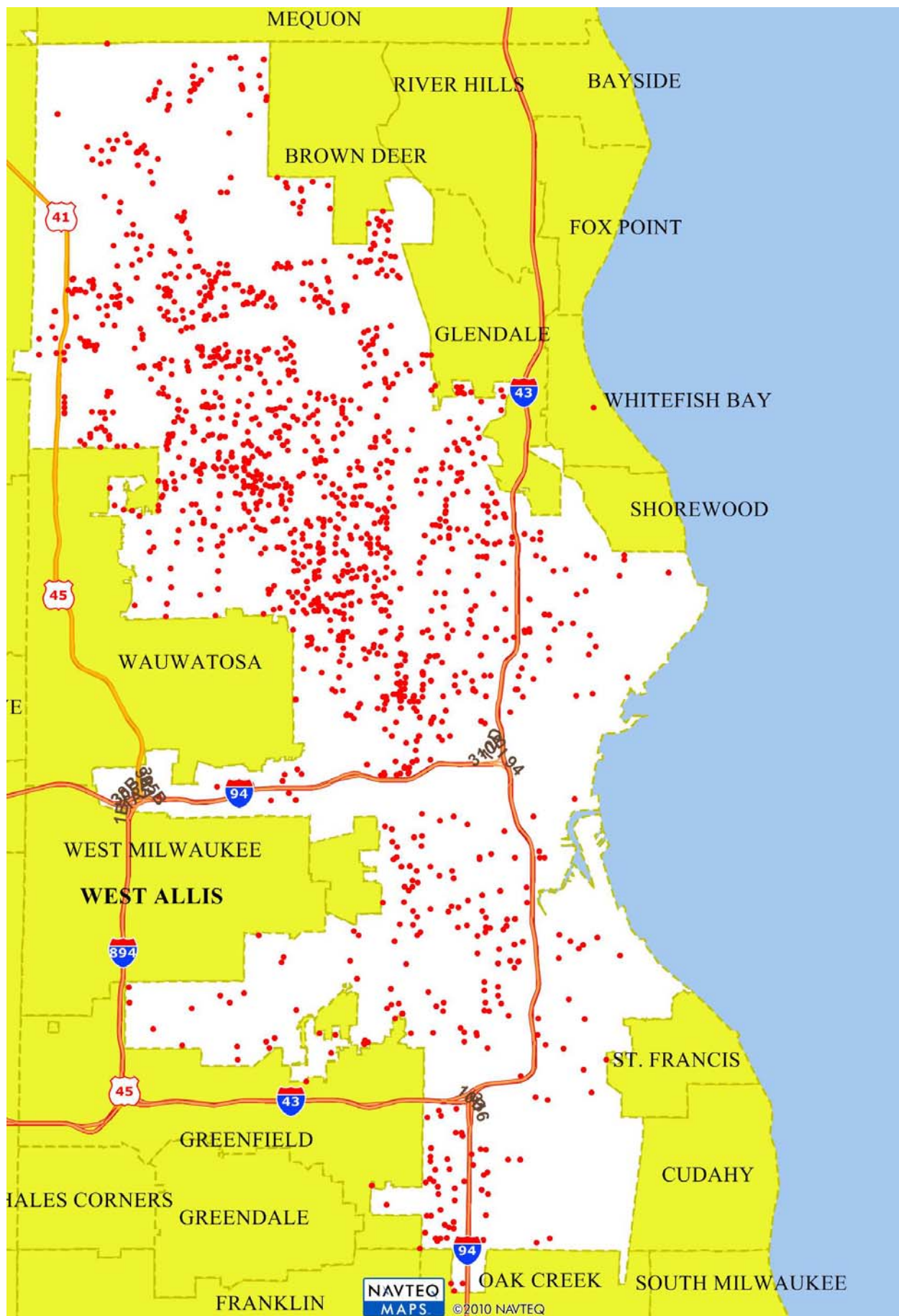




Map 1-3: Milwaukee Students Attending Suburban Public Schools under Open Enrollment (Fall 2010)

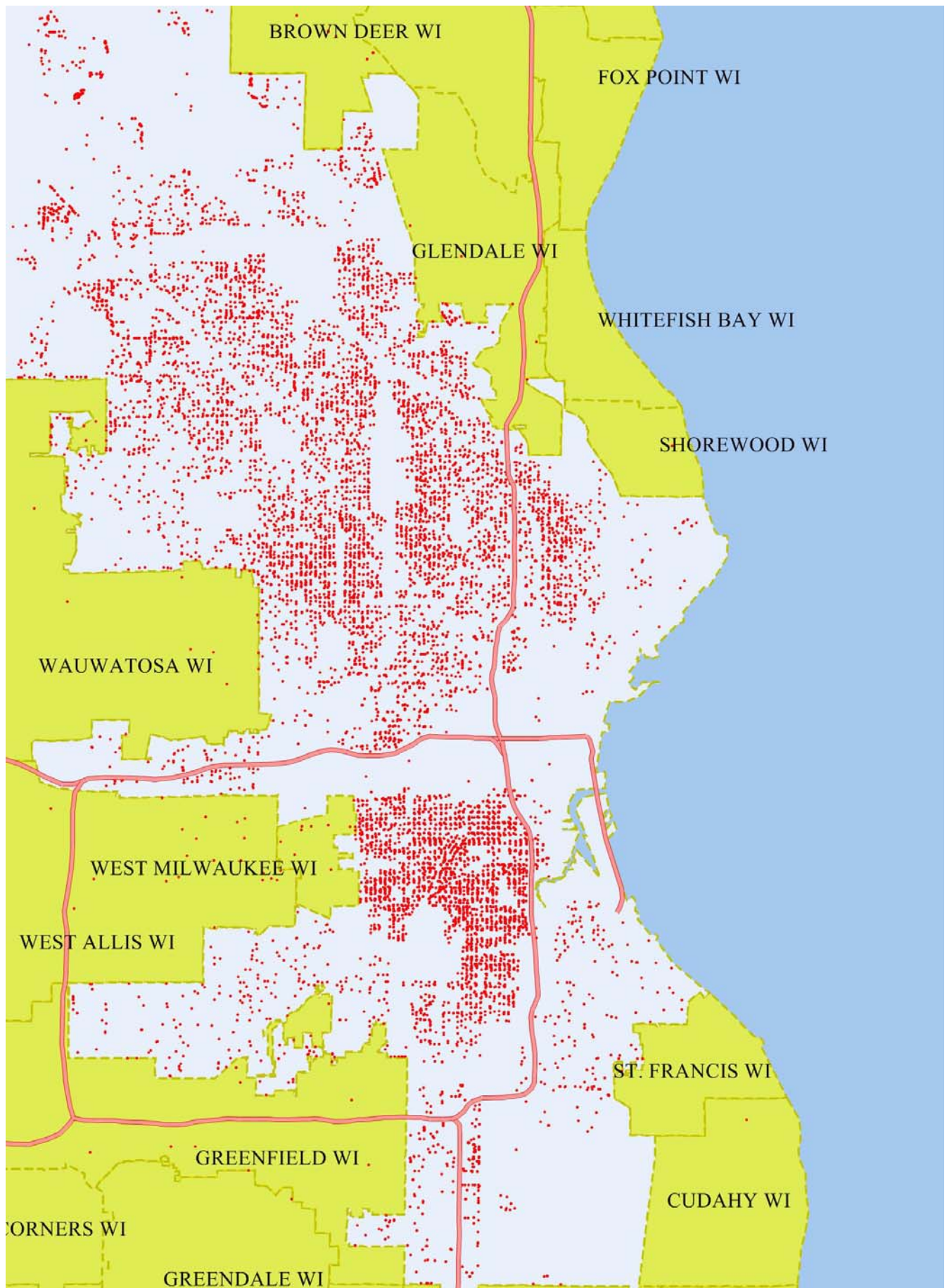


Map 1-4: Milwaukee Students Attending Suburban Public Schools under Chapter 220 (Fall 2010)

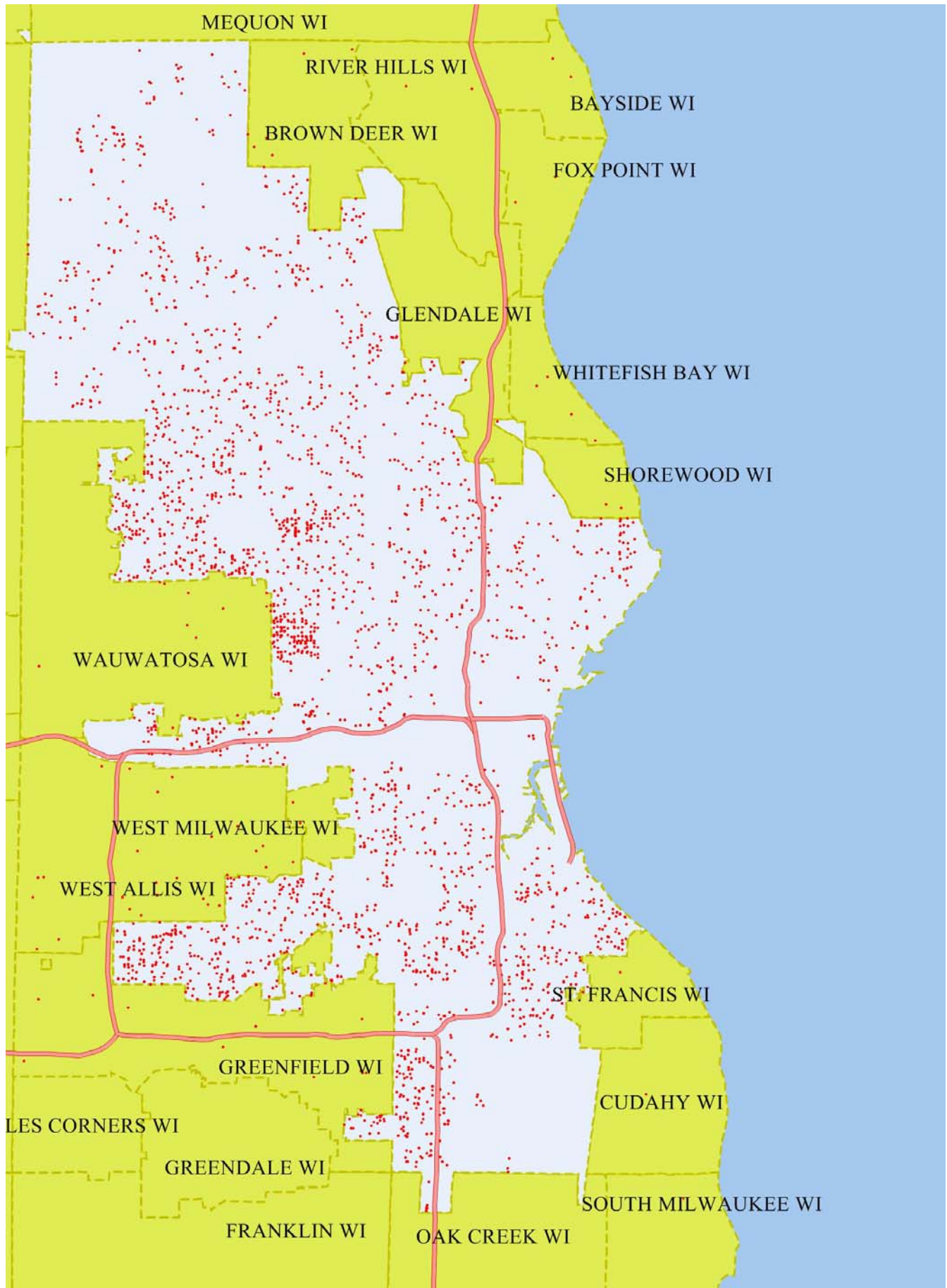




Map 1-5: Milwaukee Residents in Title I Private Schools and Eligible for Free or Reduced Price Meals

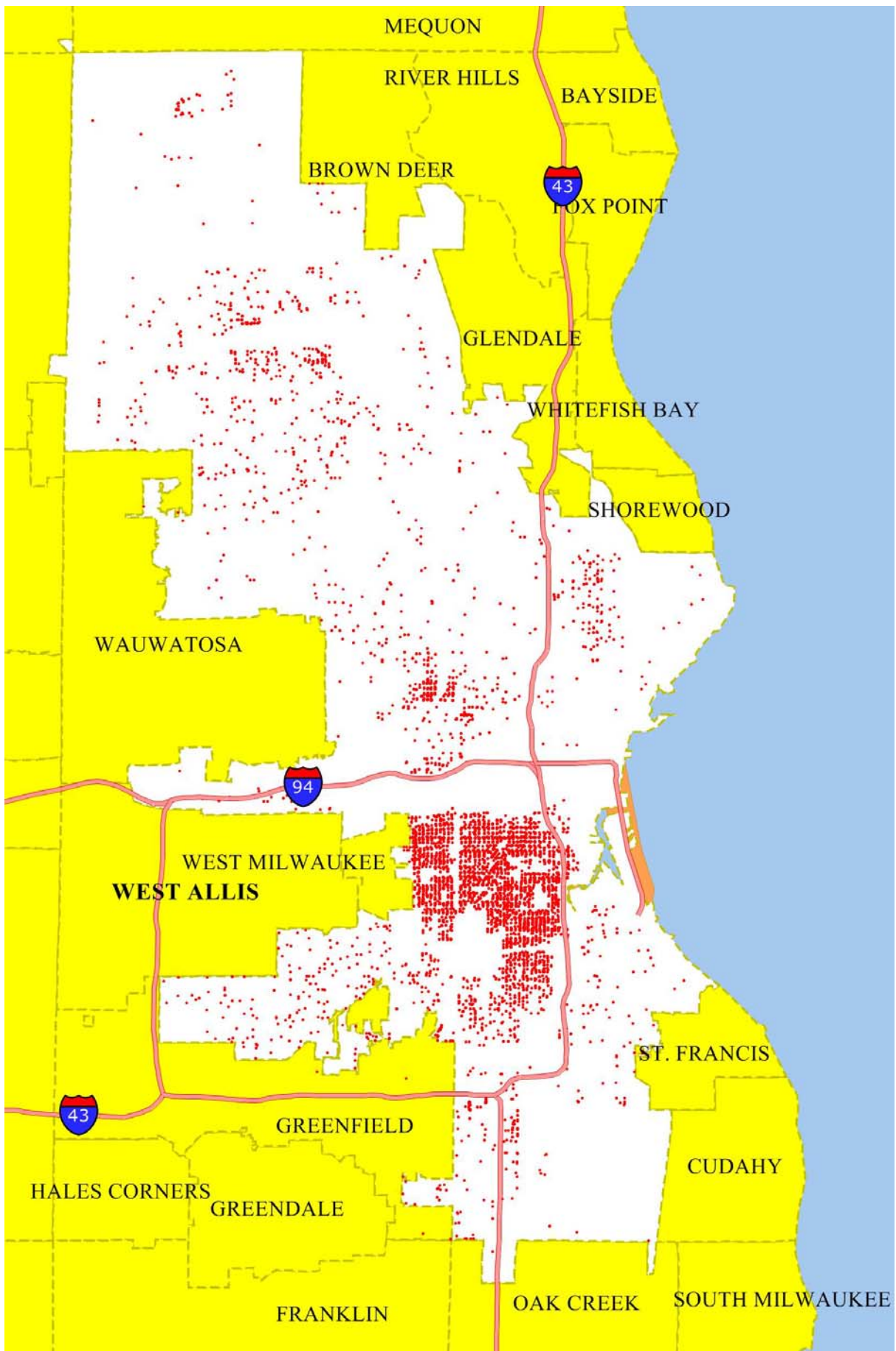


Map 1-6: Milwaukee Residents in Title I Private Schools and NOT Certified for Free/Reduced Price Meals

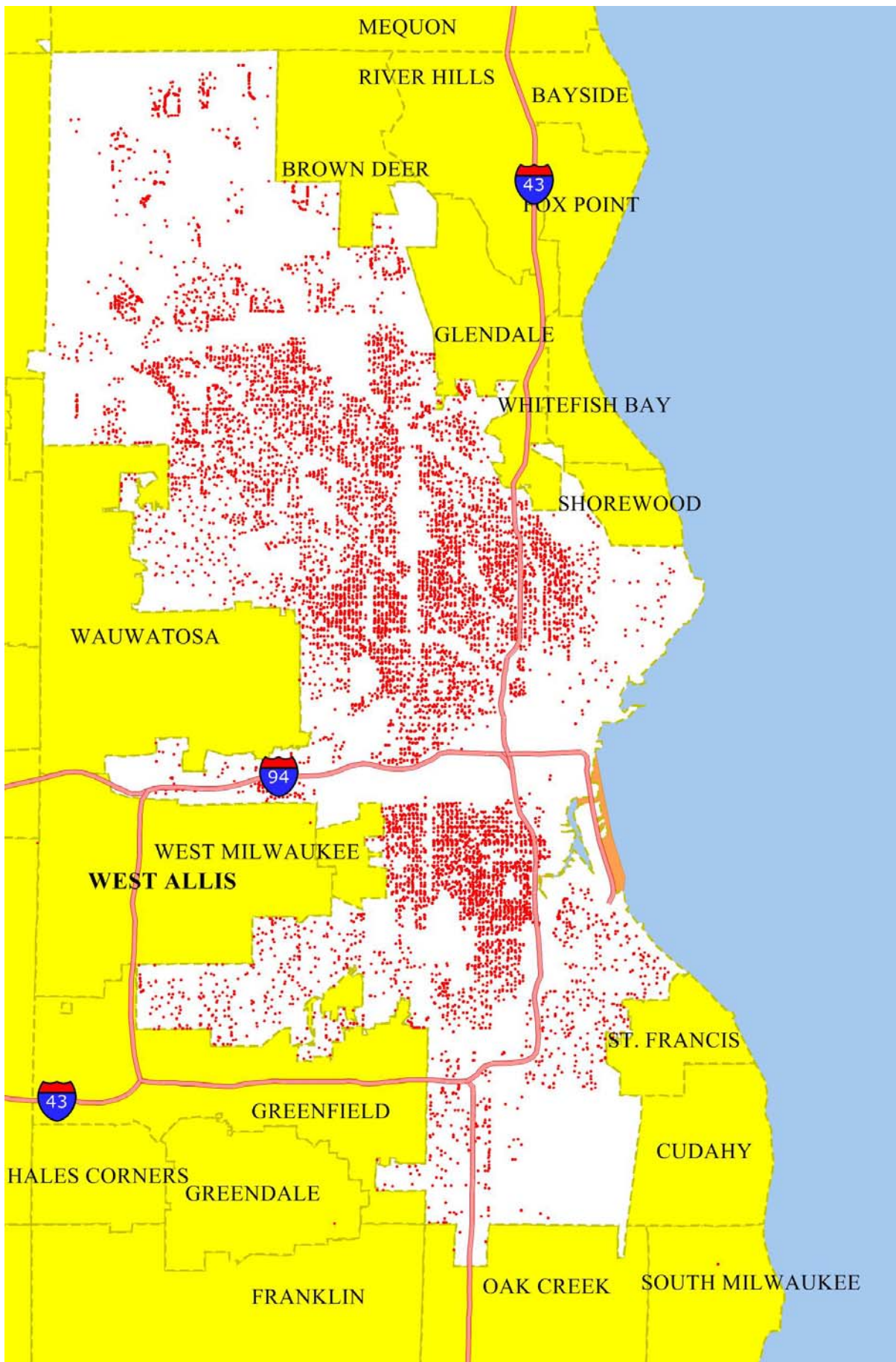




Map 1-7: MPS English Language Learners (Fall 2010)

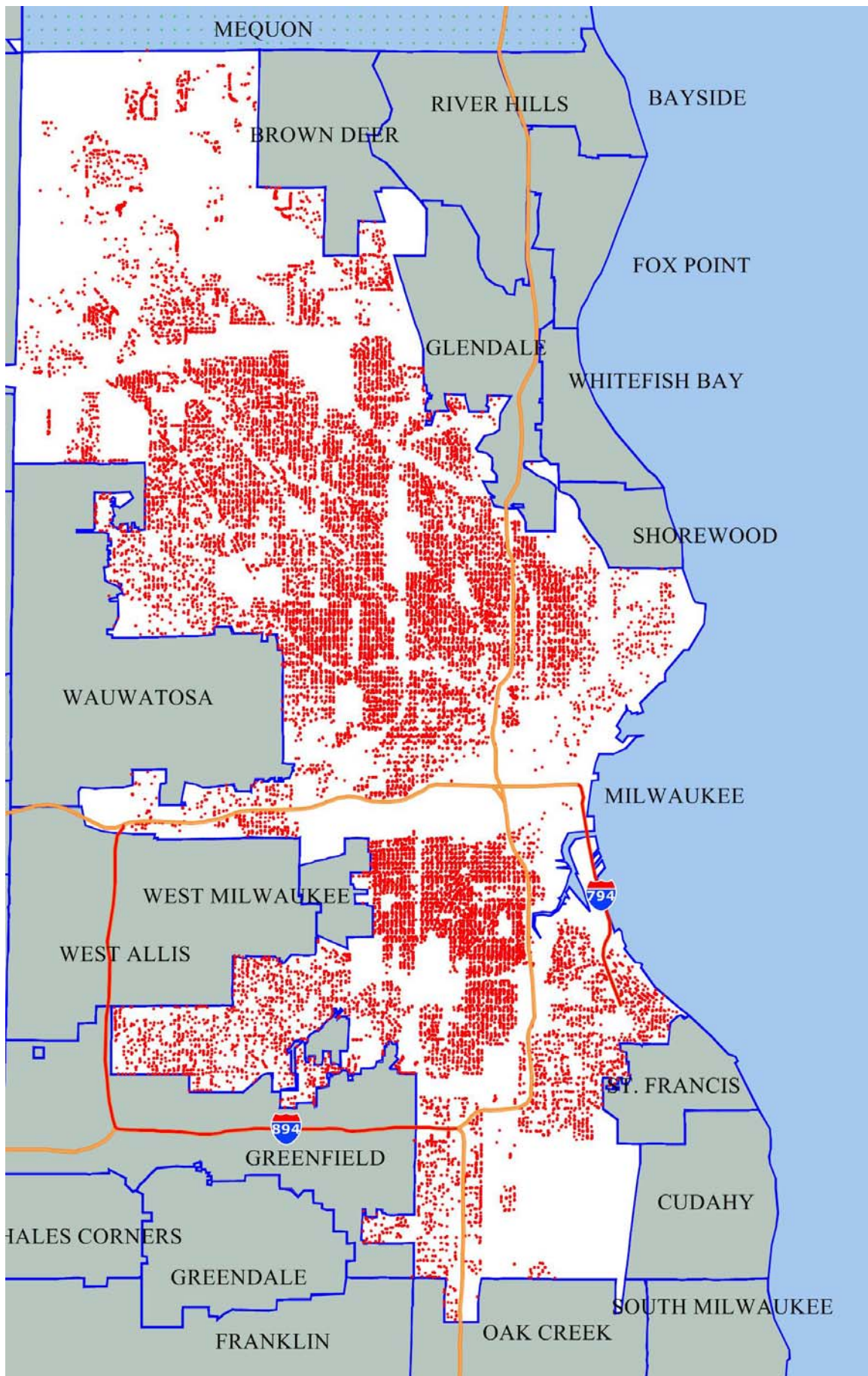


Map 1-8: MPS Students with Exceptional Education Needs (Fall 2010)

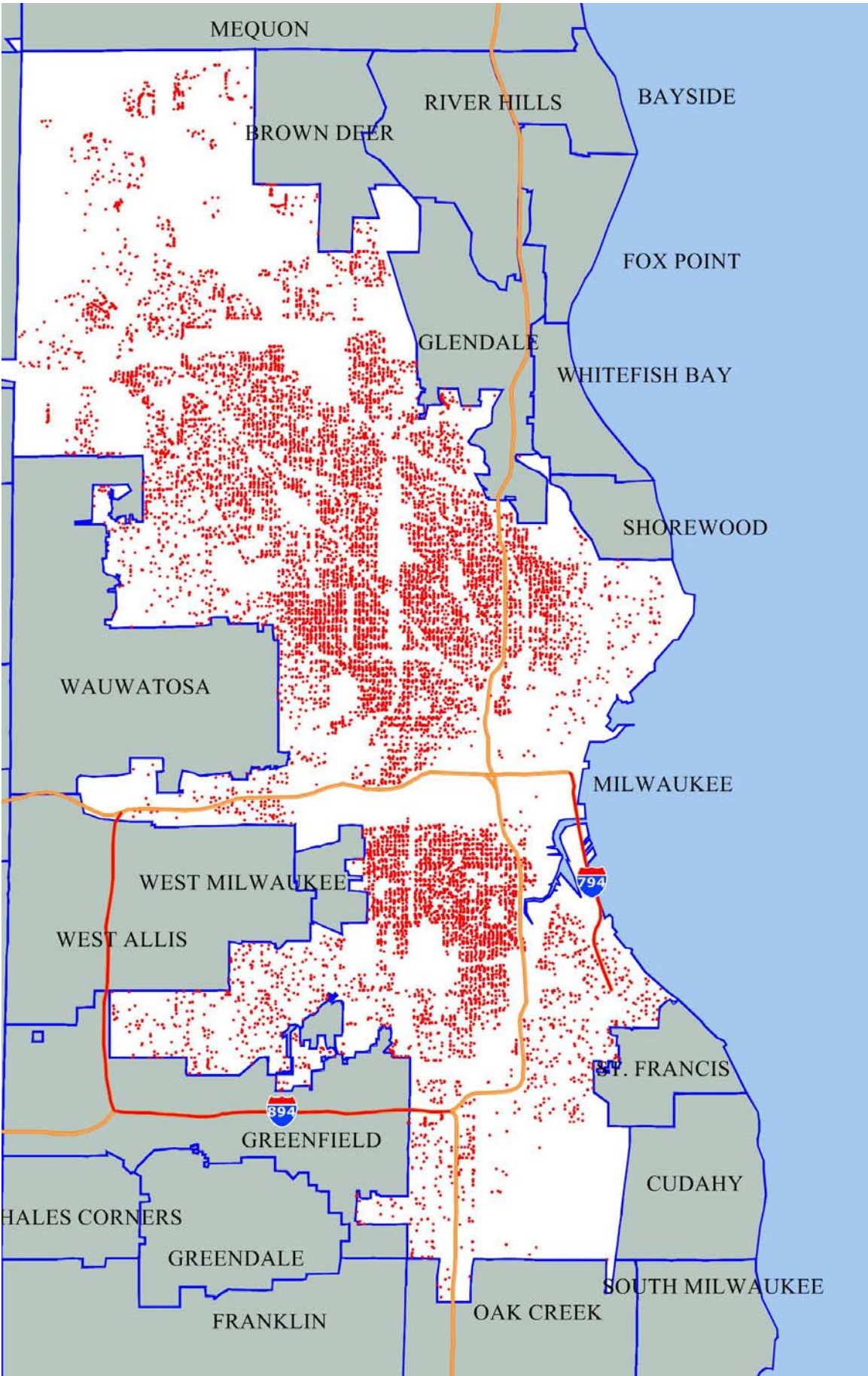




Map 1-9: Milwaukee Residents Attending MPS Schools Grades 1-8 (Fall 2010)

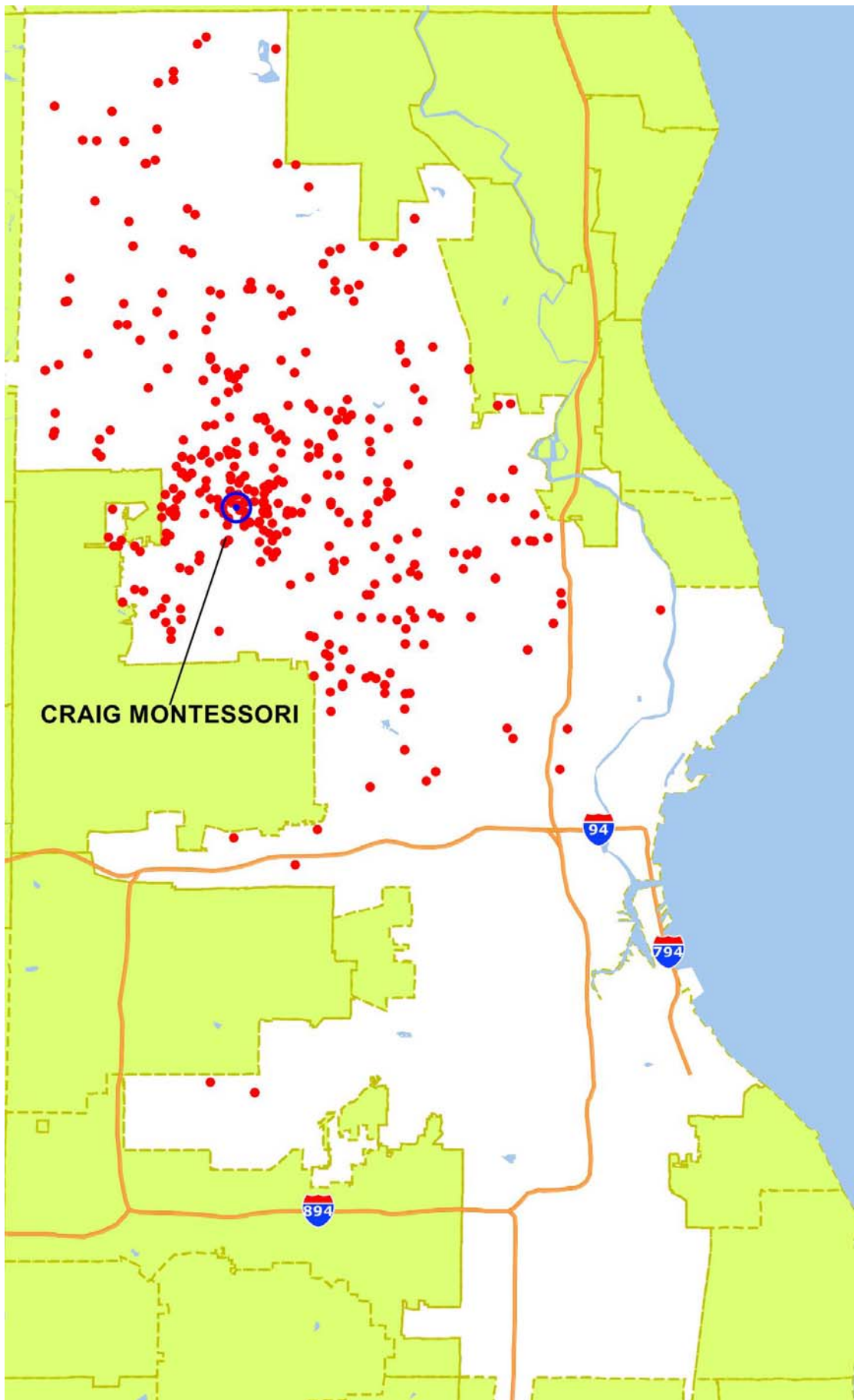

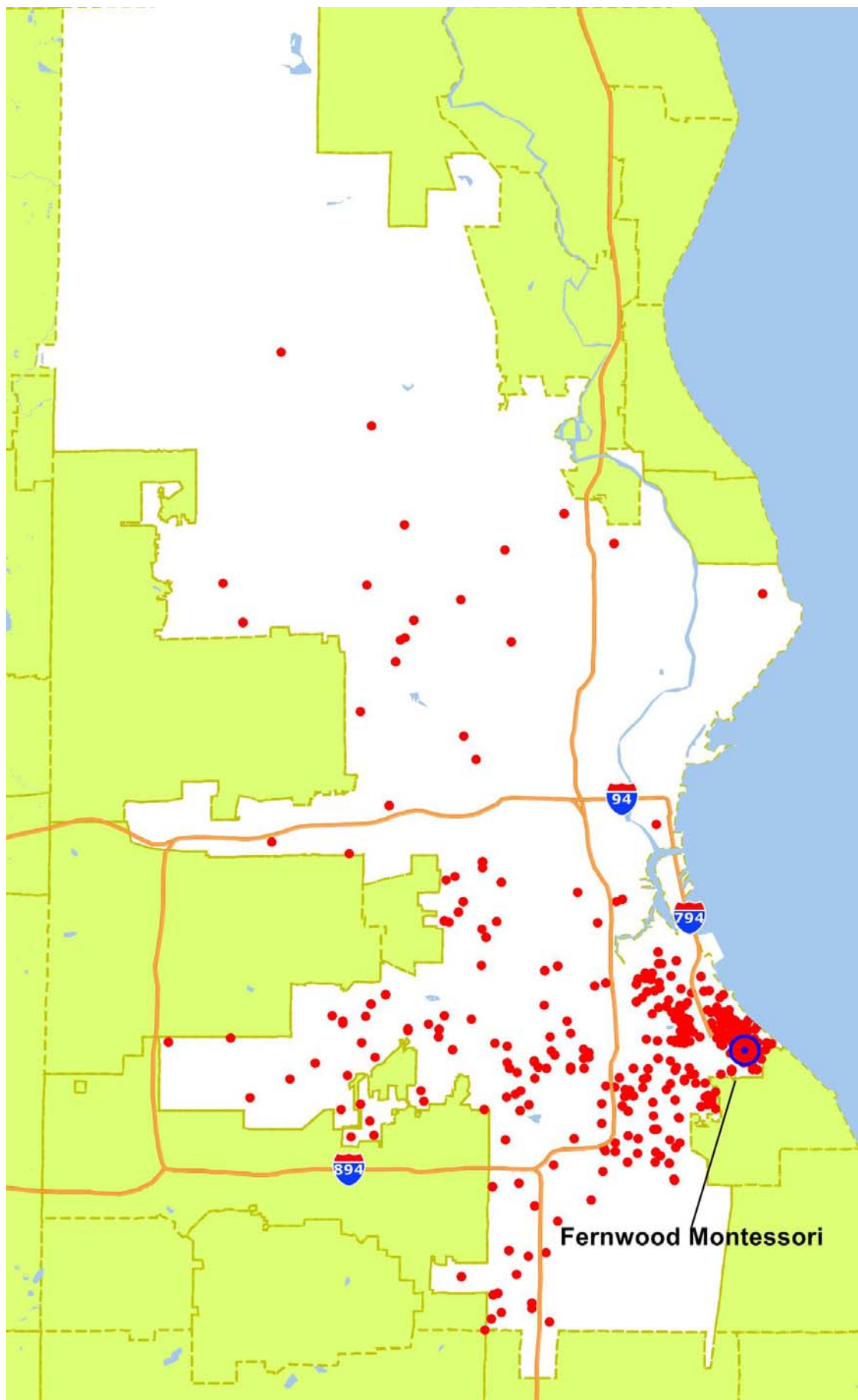

Map 2-1: Residence of Milwaukee Students Attending Craig Montessori, Fall 2010

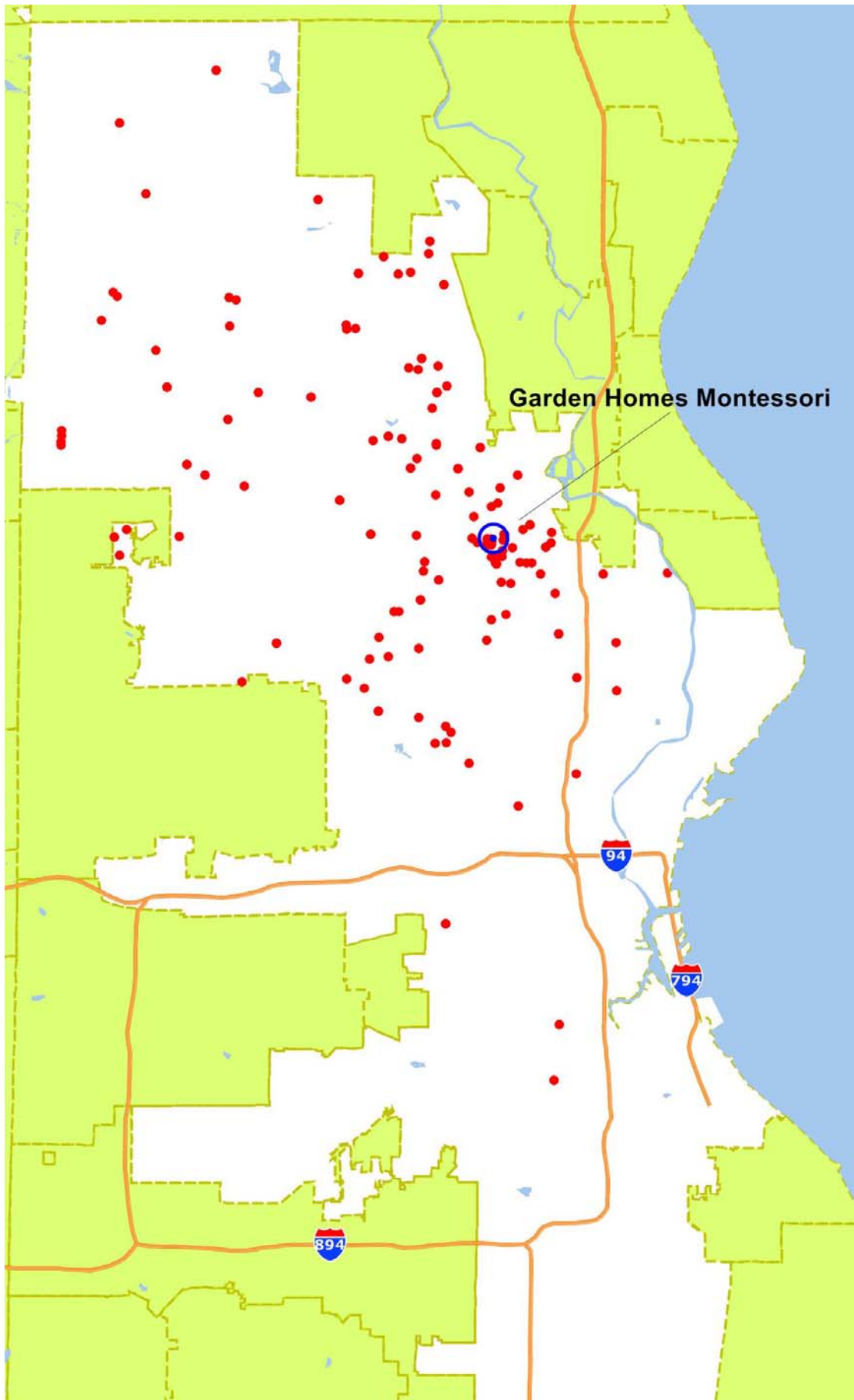




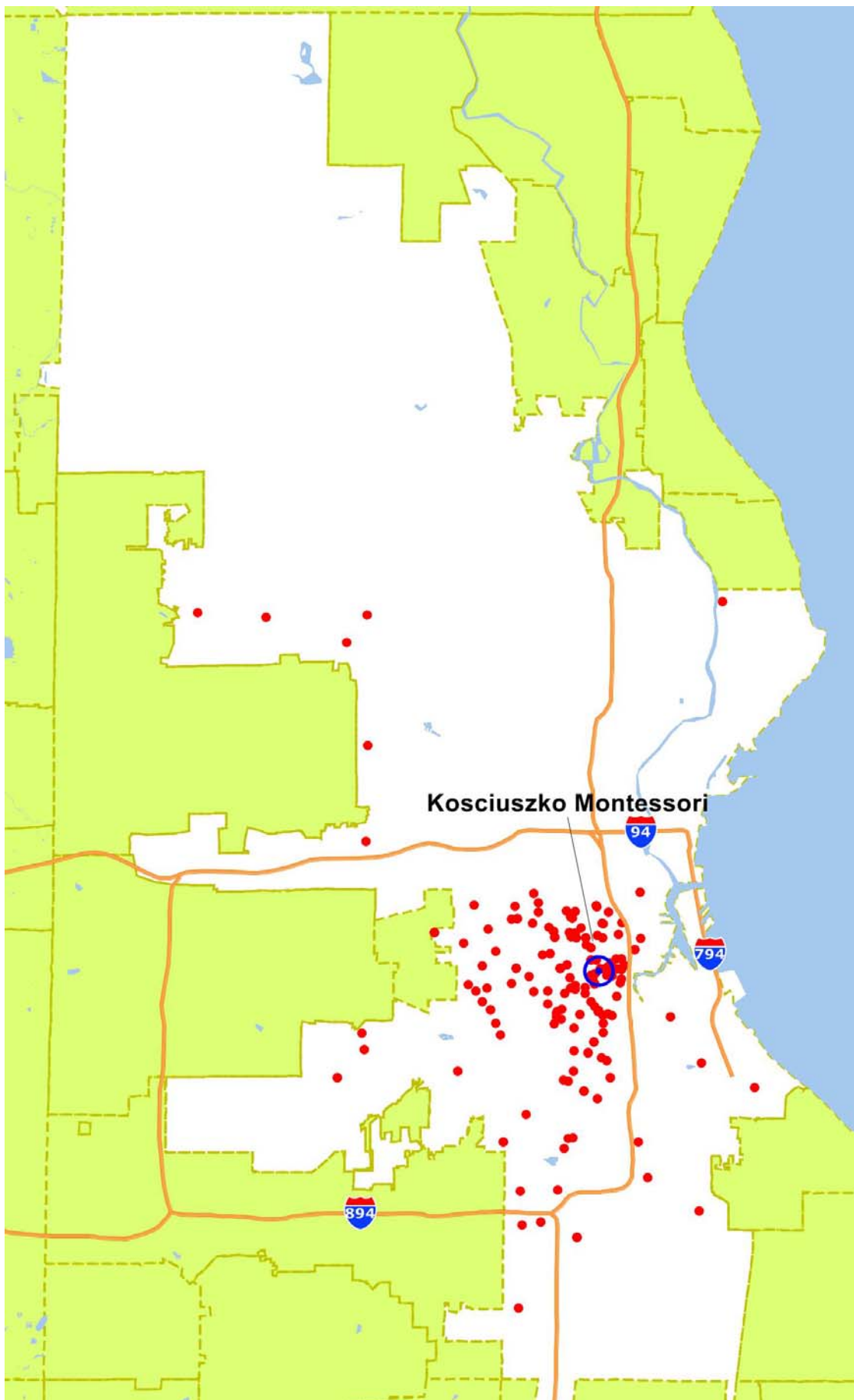
Map 2-2: Residence of Milwaukee Students Attending Fernwood Montessori, Fall 2010



Map 2-3: Residence of Milwaukee Students Attending Garden Homes Montessori, Fall 2010

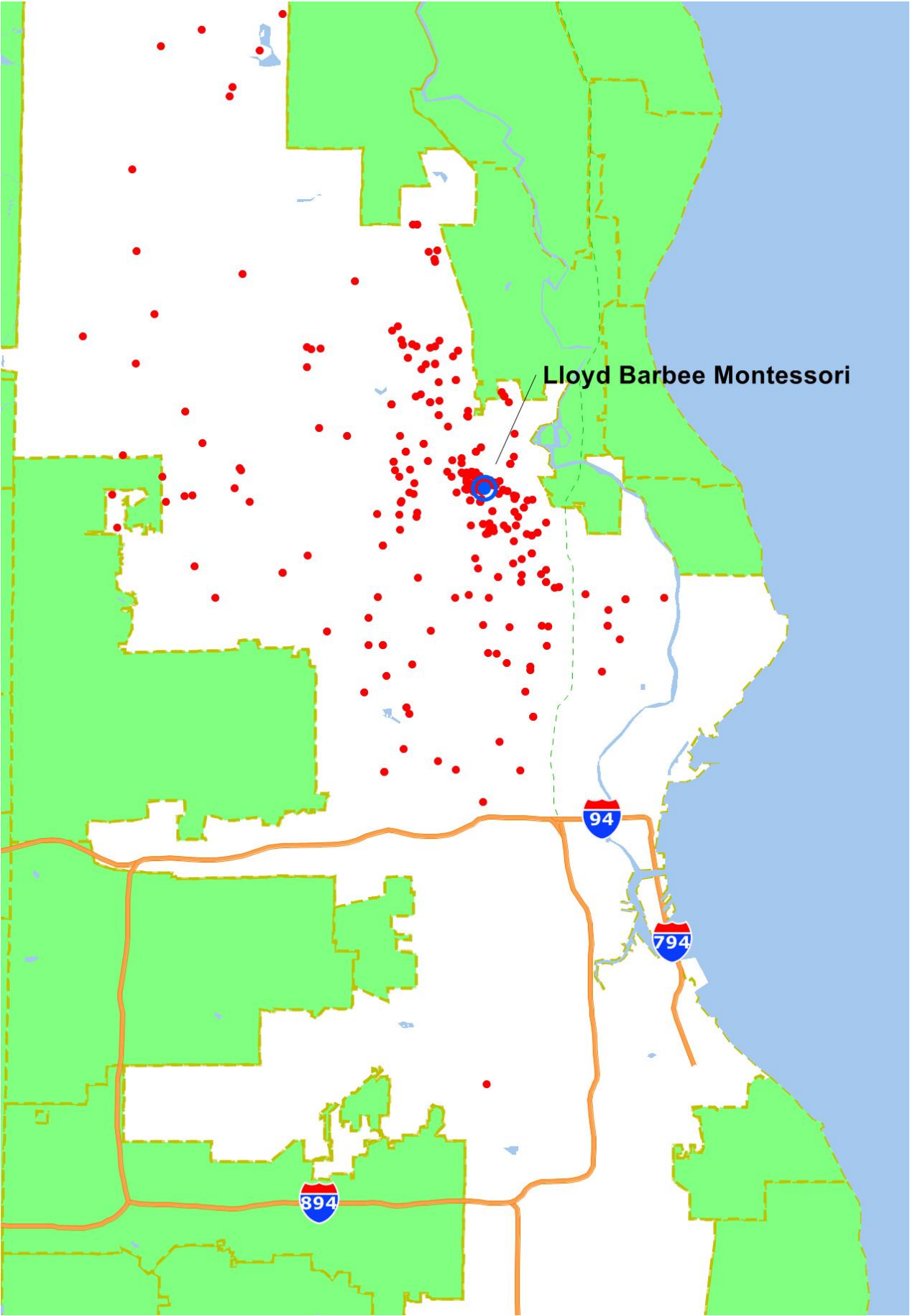


Map 2-4: Residence of Milwaukee Students Attending Kosciuszko Montessori, Fall 2010

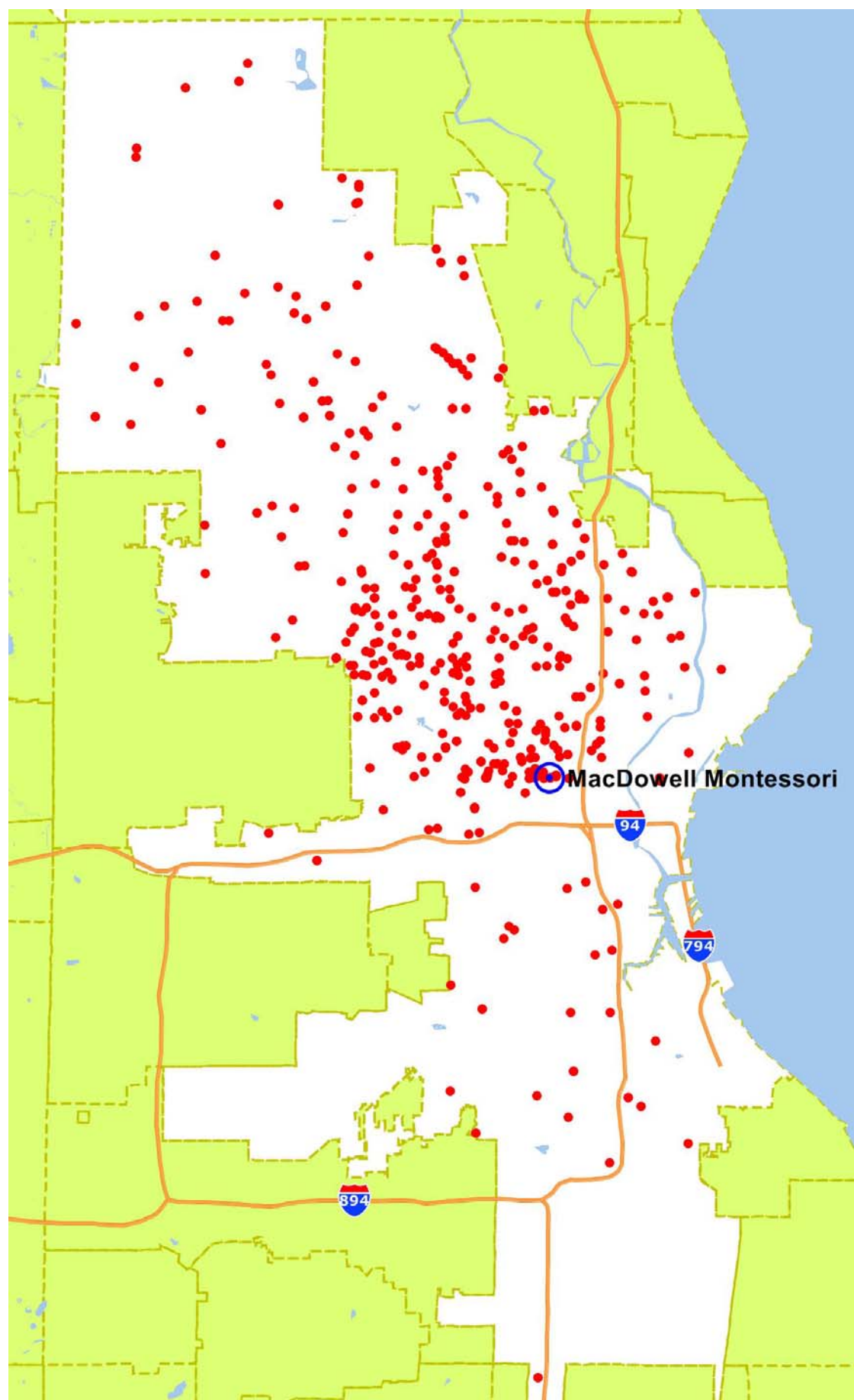




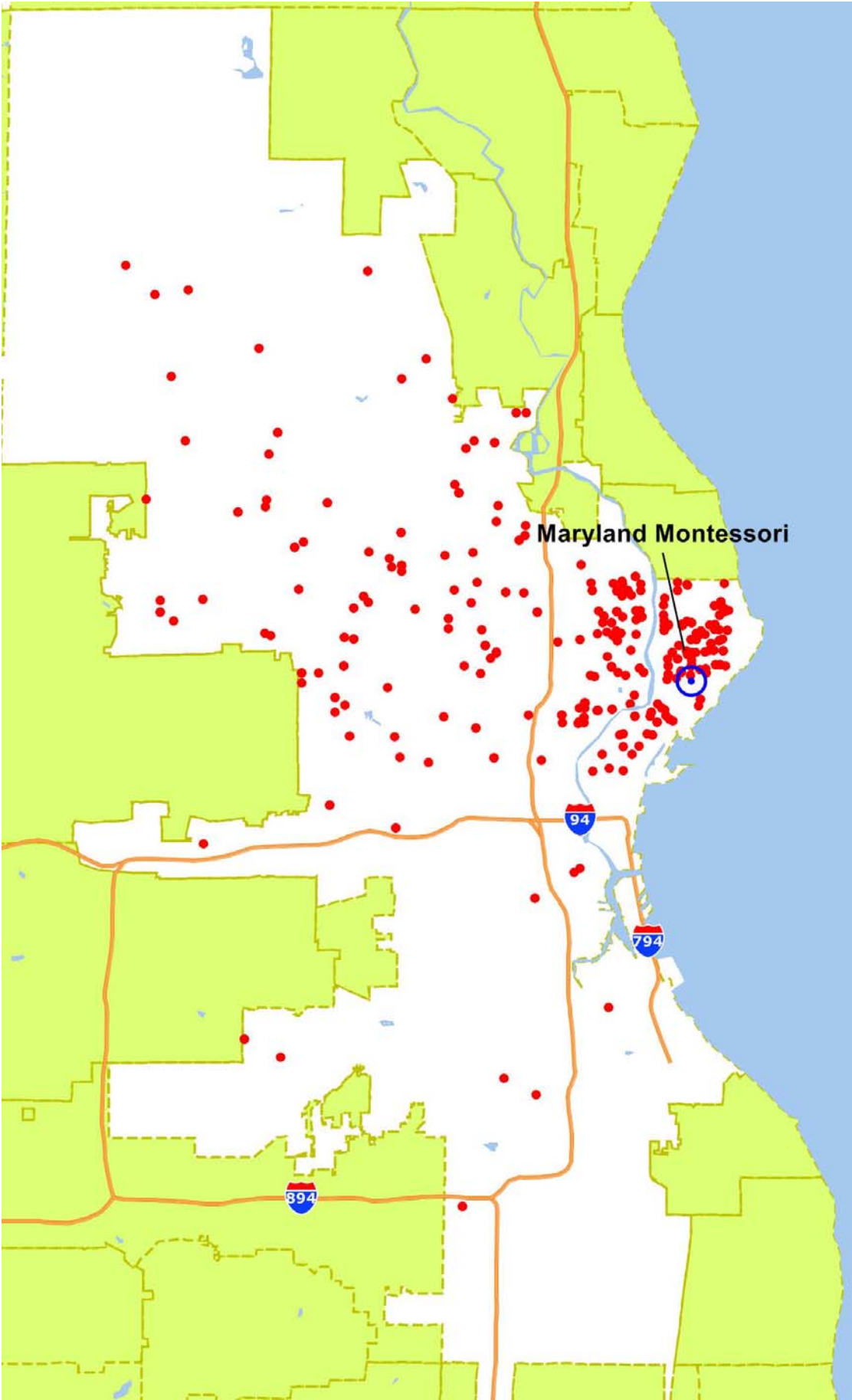
Map 2-5: Residence of Milwaukee Students Attending Lloyd Barbee Montessori, Fall 2010



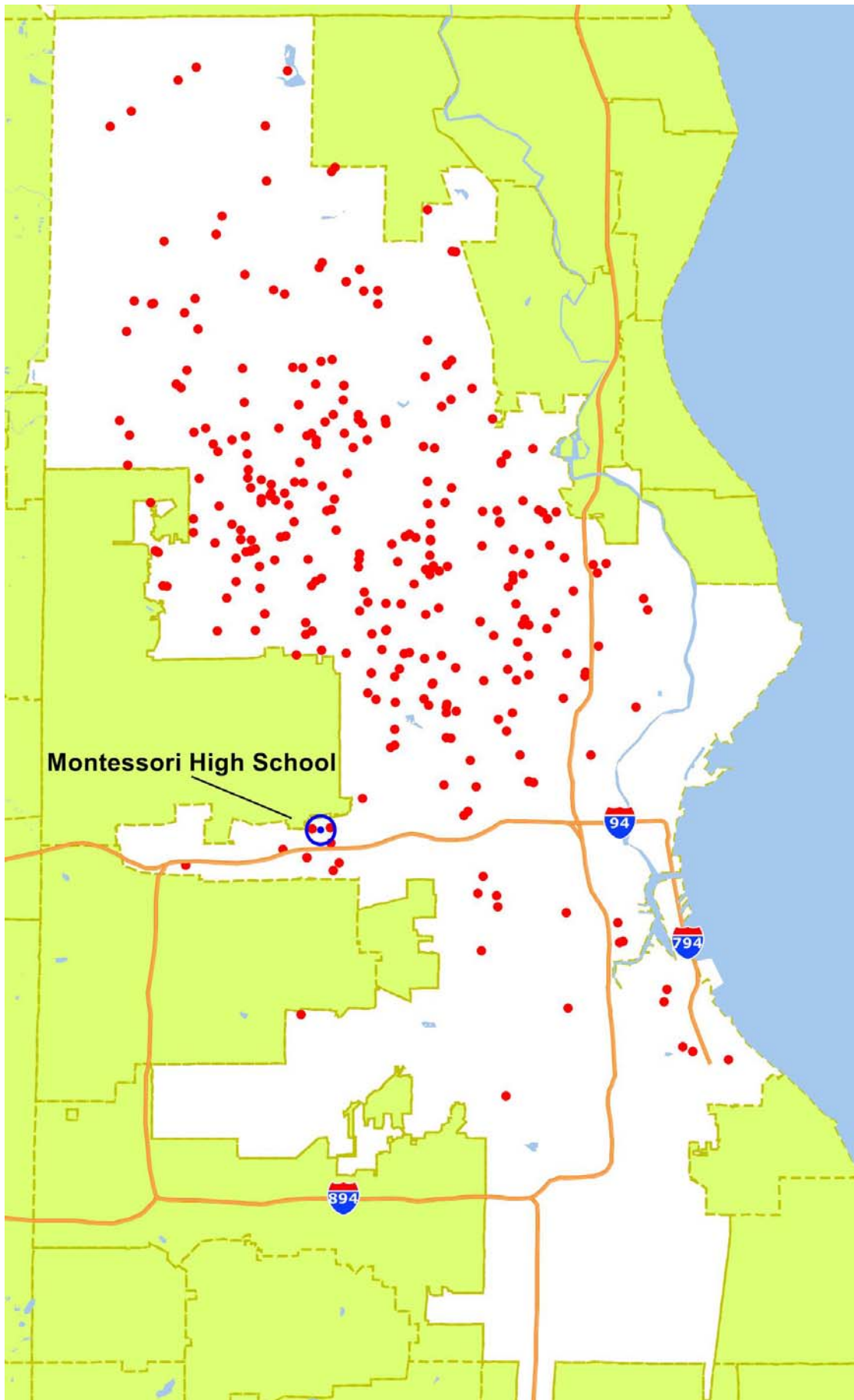
Map 2-6: Residence of Milwaukee Students Attending MacDowell Montessori, Fall 2010

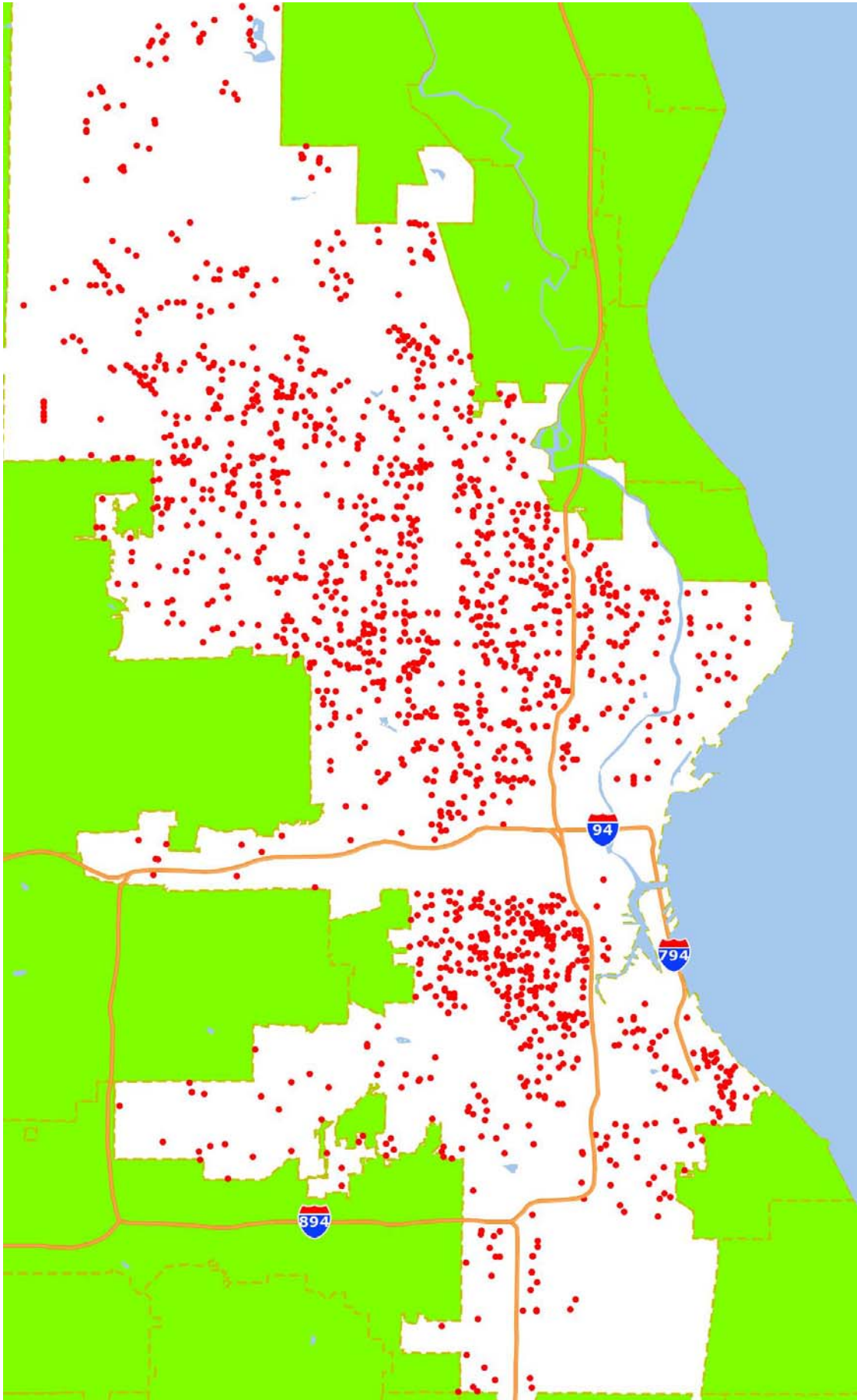

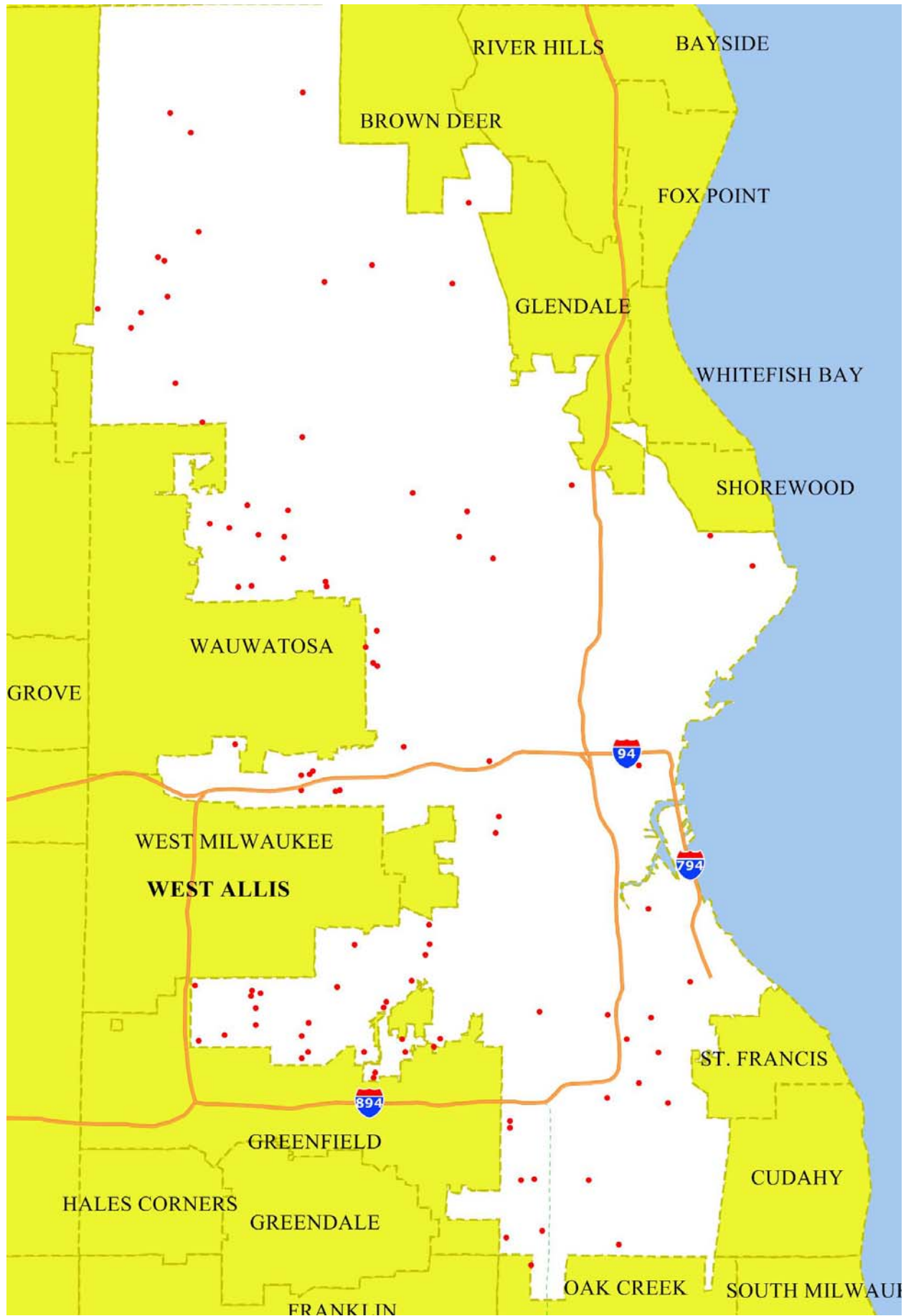

Map 3-1: 4-Year Olds (as of Sept 2010) Enrolled in Milwaukee Public Schools 2010-11

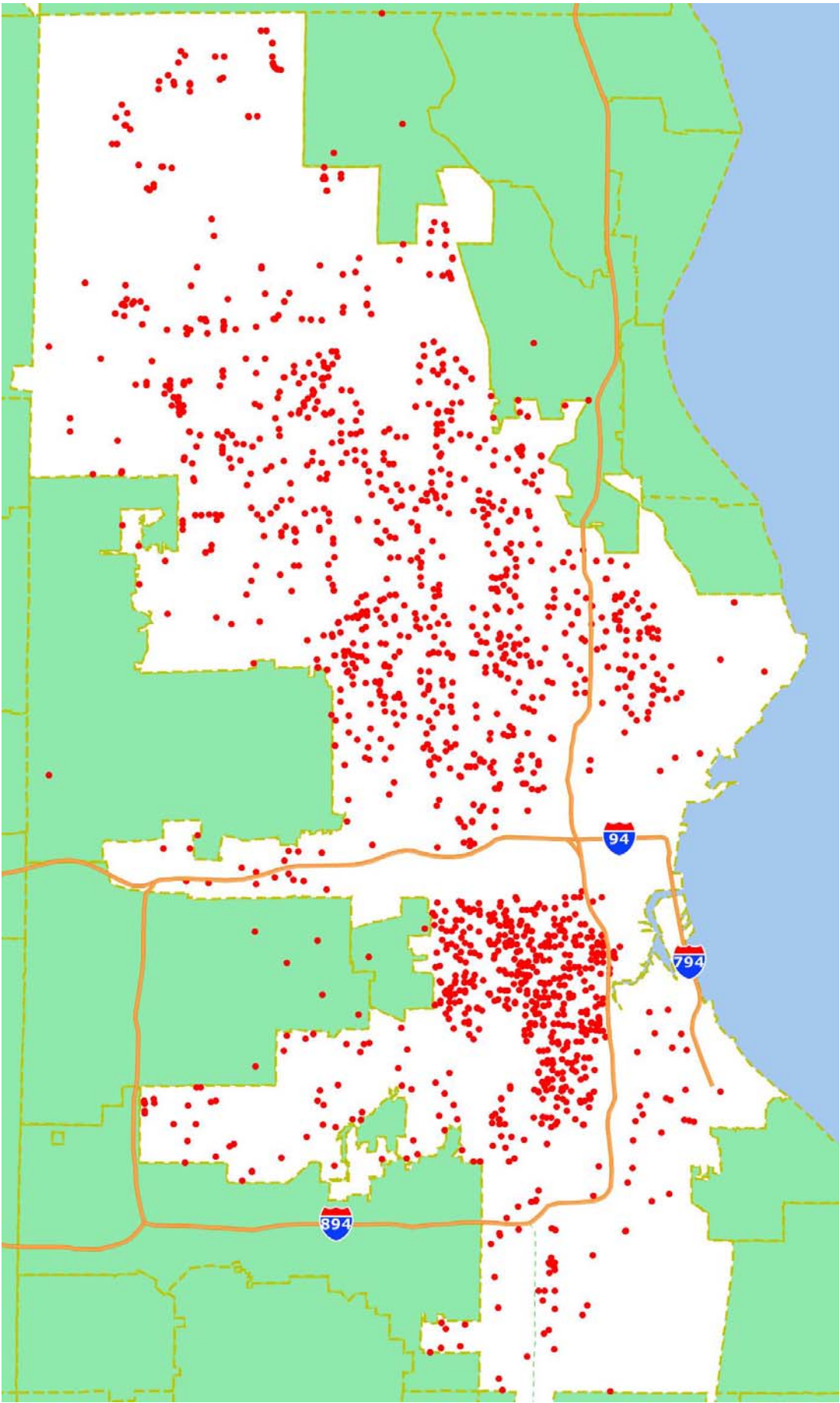

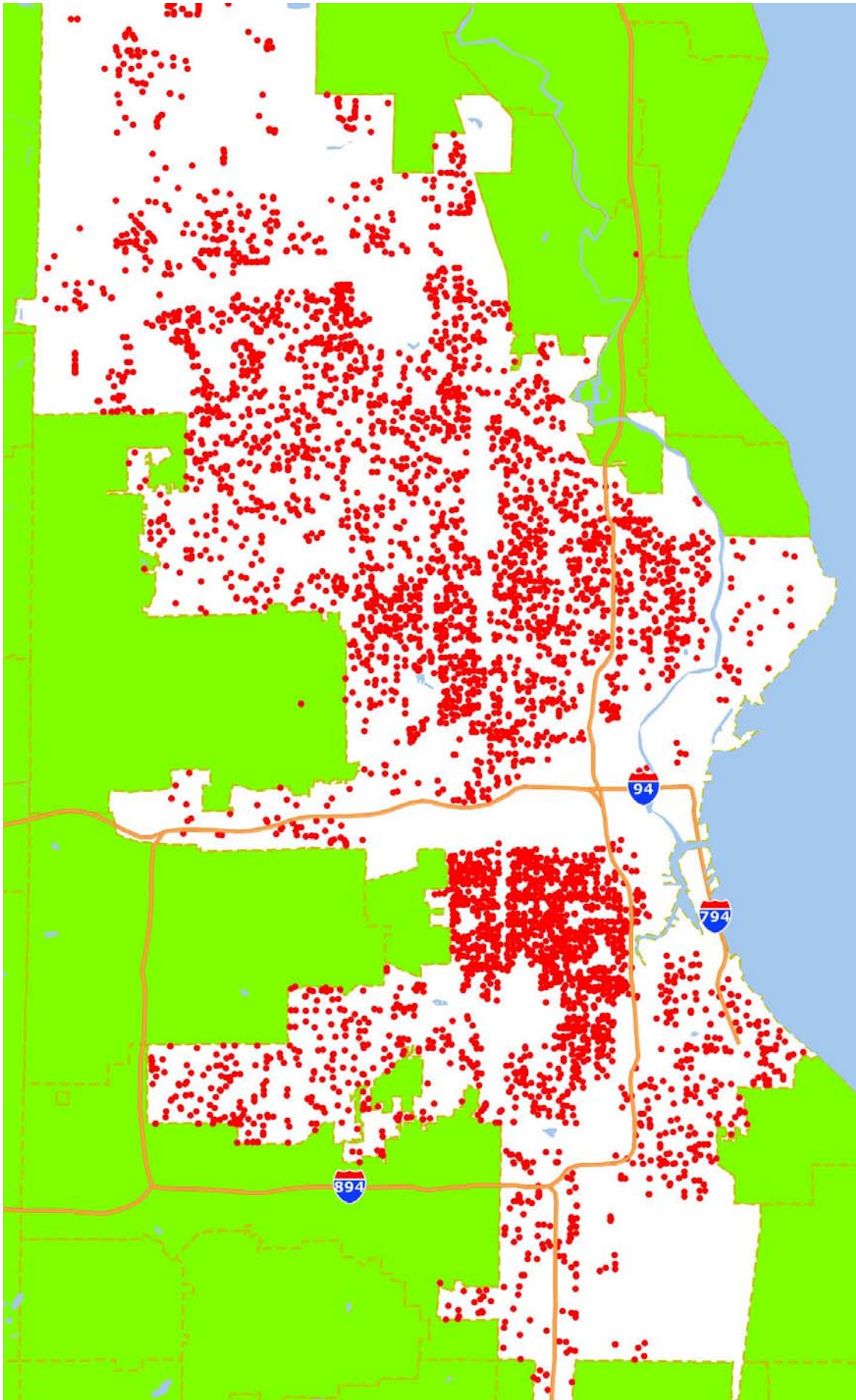




Map 3-3: 4-Year Olds (as of Sept 2010) Enrolled in Milwaukee Private Title I/Choice Schools 2010-11

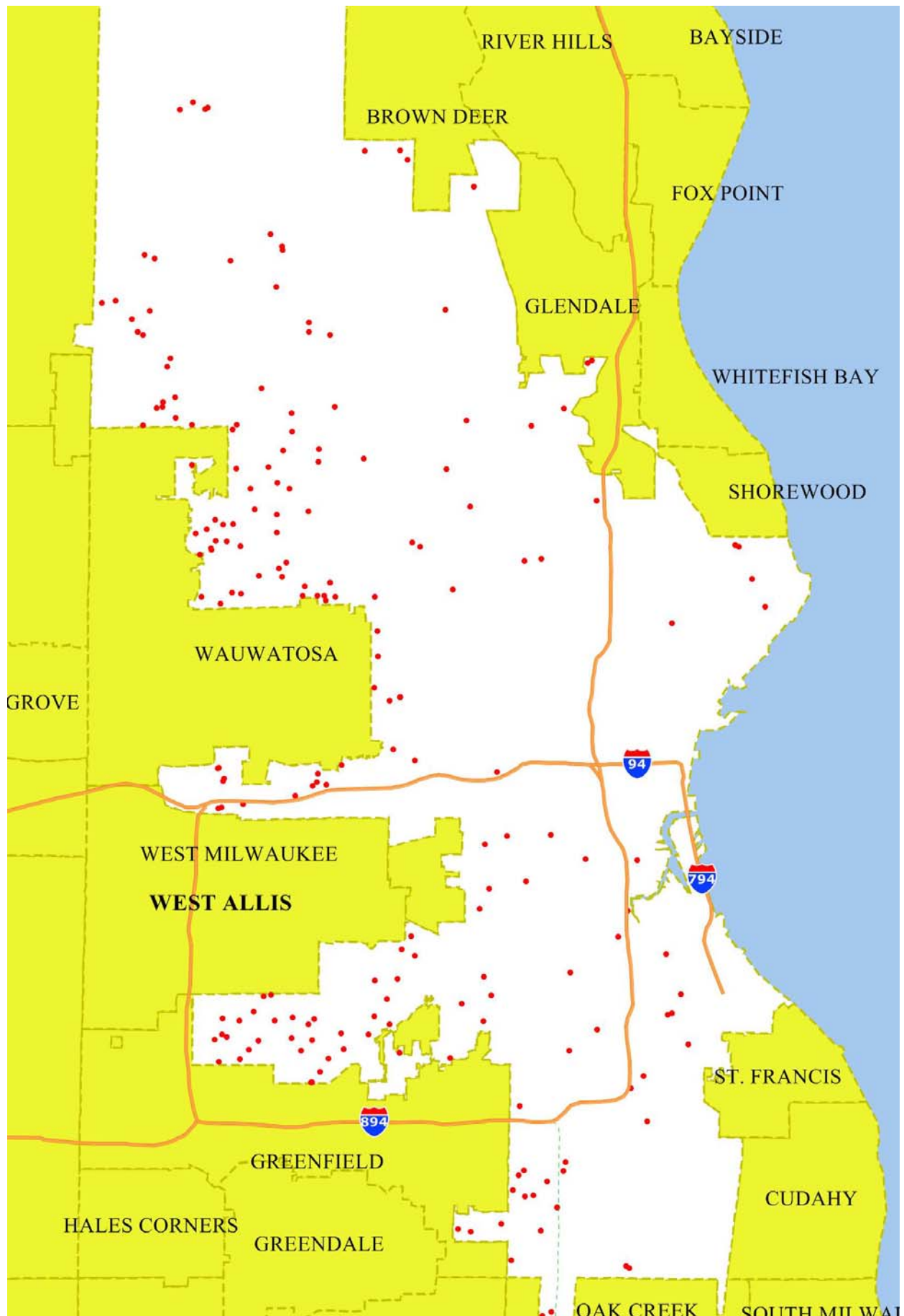


Map 3-4: 5-Year Olds (as of Sept 2010) Enrolled in Milwaukee Public Schools 2010-11



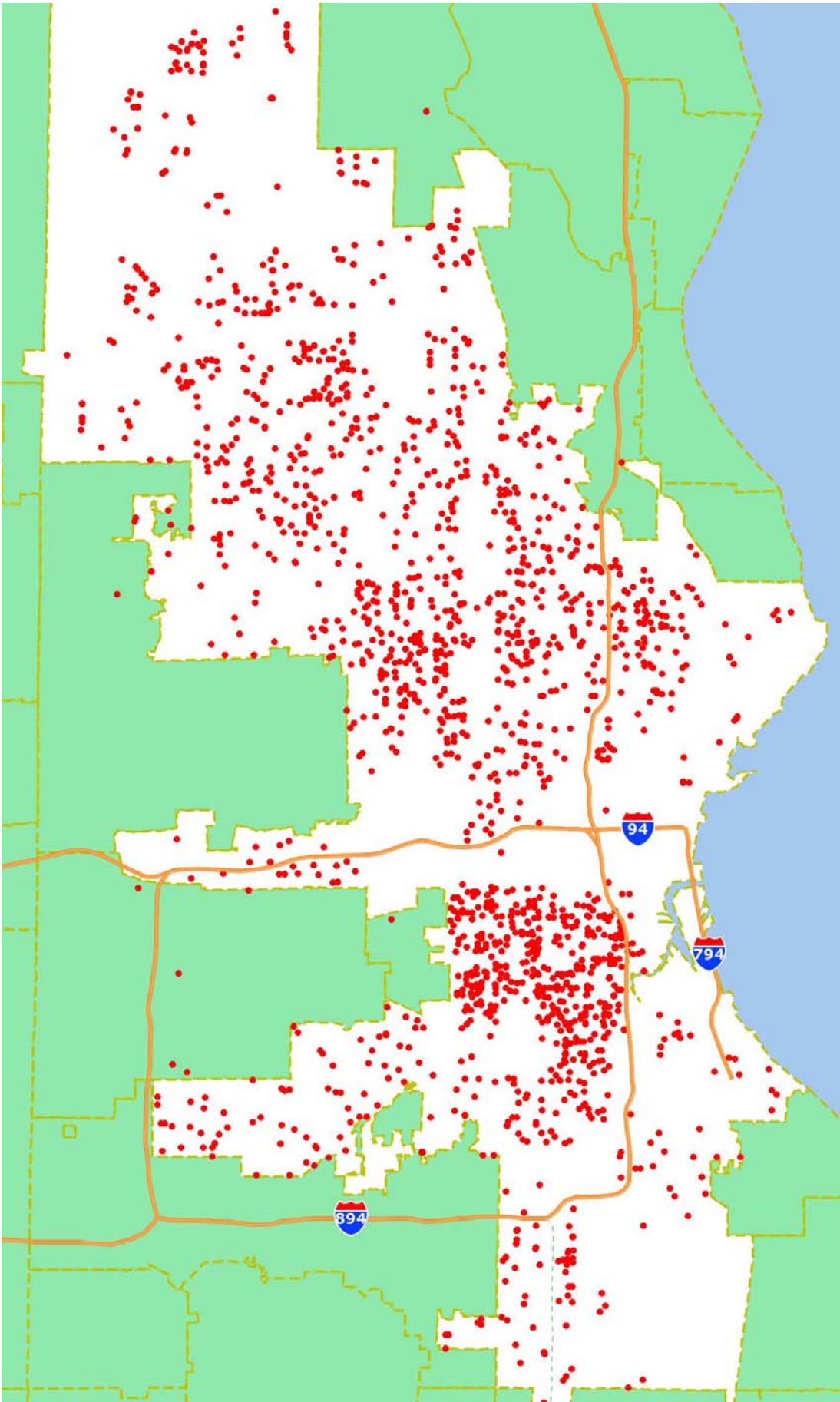


Map 3-5: 5-Year Olds (as of Sept 2010) Enrolled in Non-MPS Public Schools 2010-11  
including UWM and City of Milwaukee Charter Schools, Open Enrollment, Chapter 220

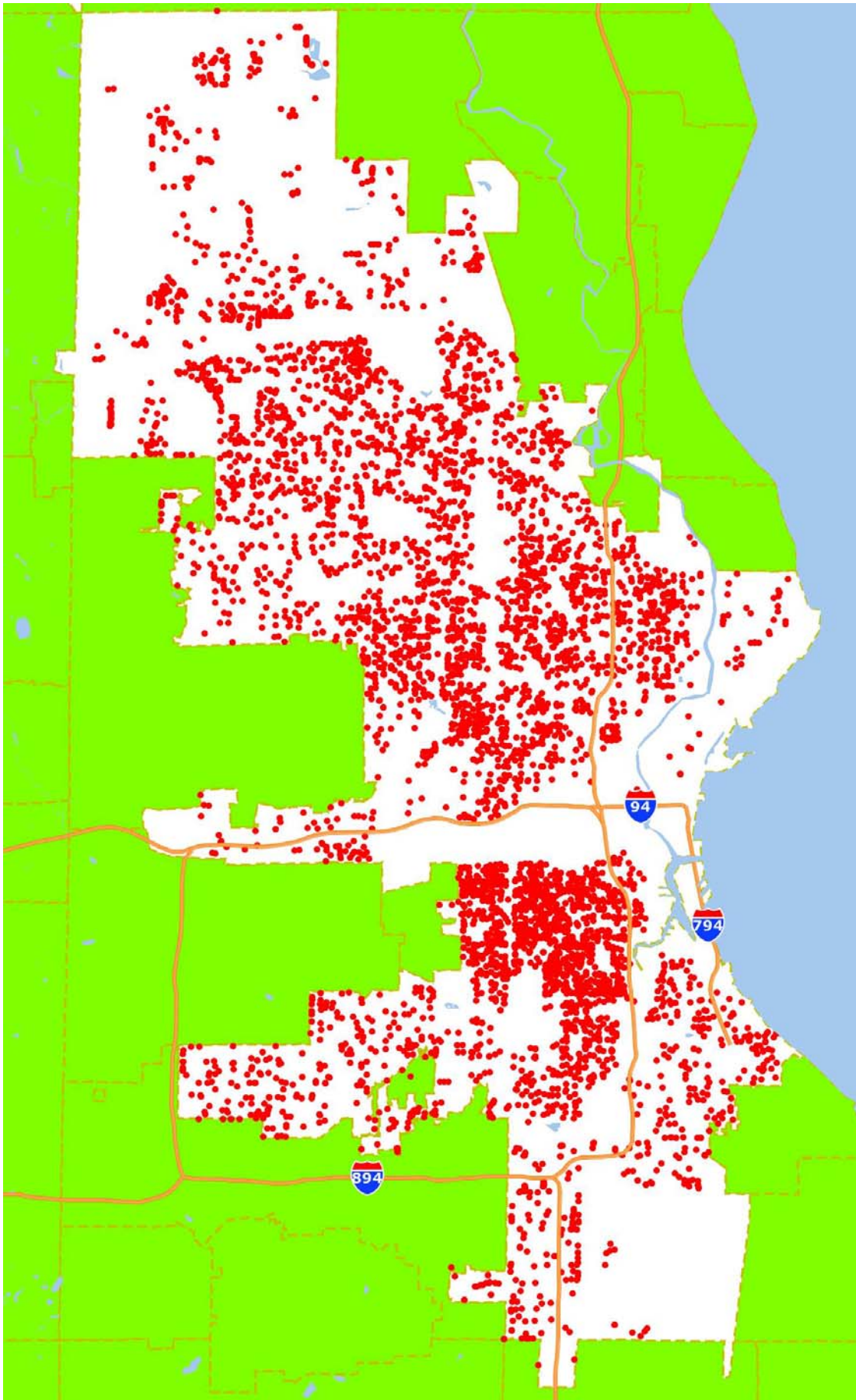




Map 3-6: 5-Year Olds (as of Sept 2010) Enrolled in Milwaukee Private Title I/Choice Schools 2010-11

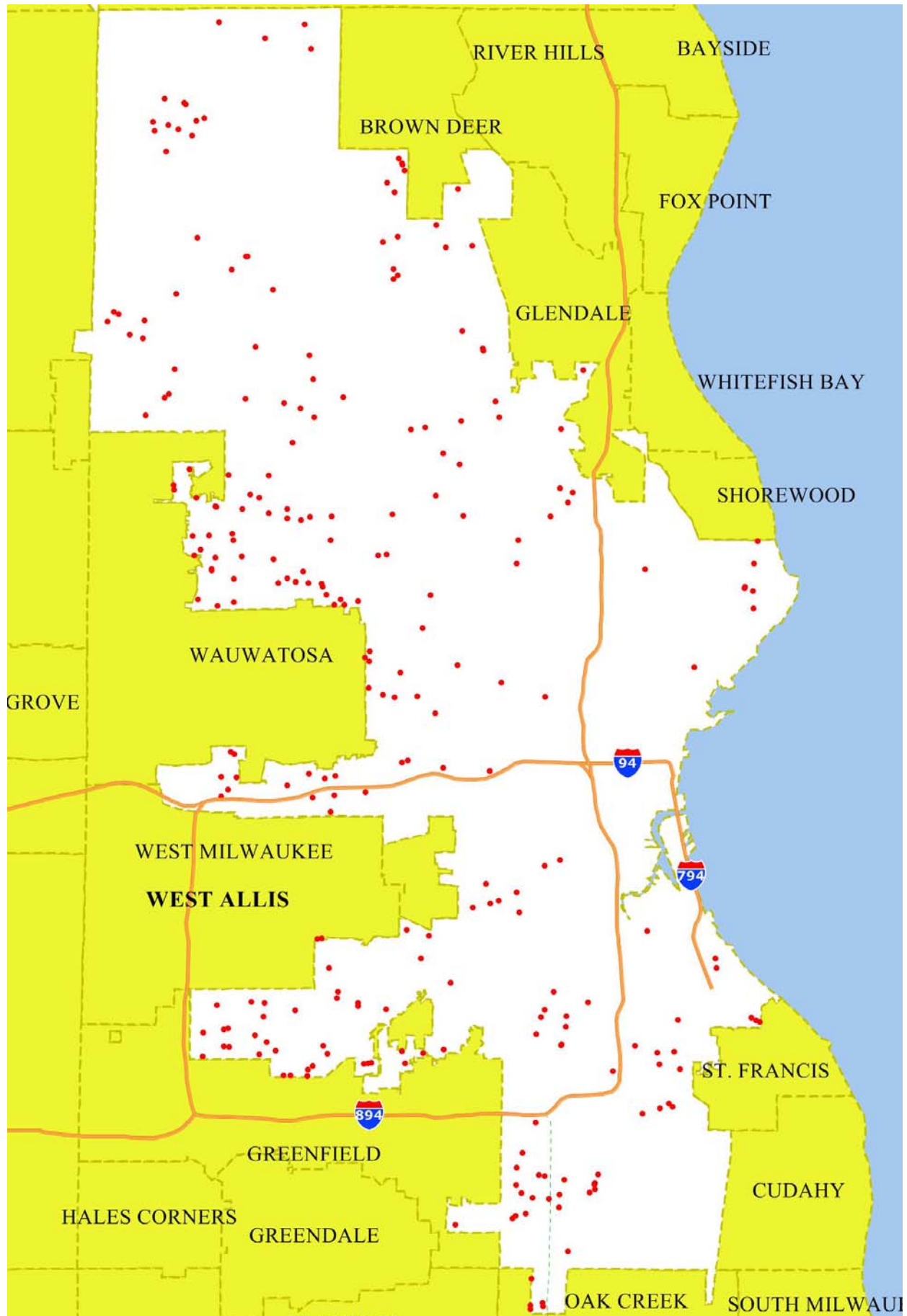


Map 3-7: 6-Year Olds (as of Sept 2010) Enrolled in Milwaukee Public Schools 2010-11



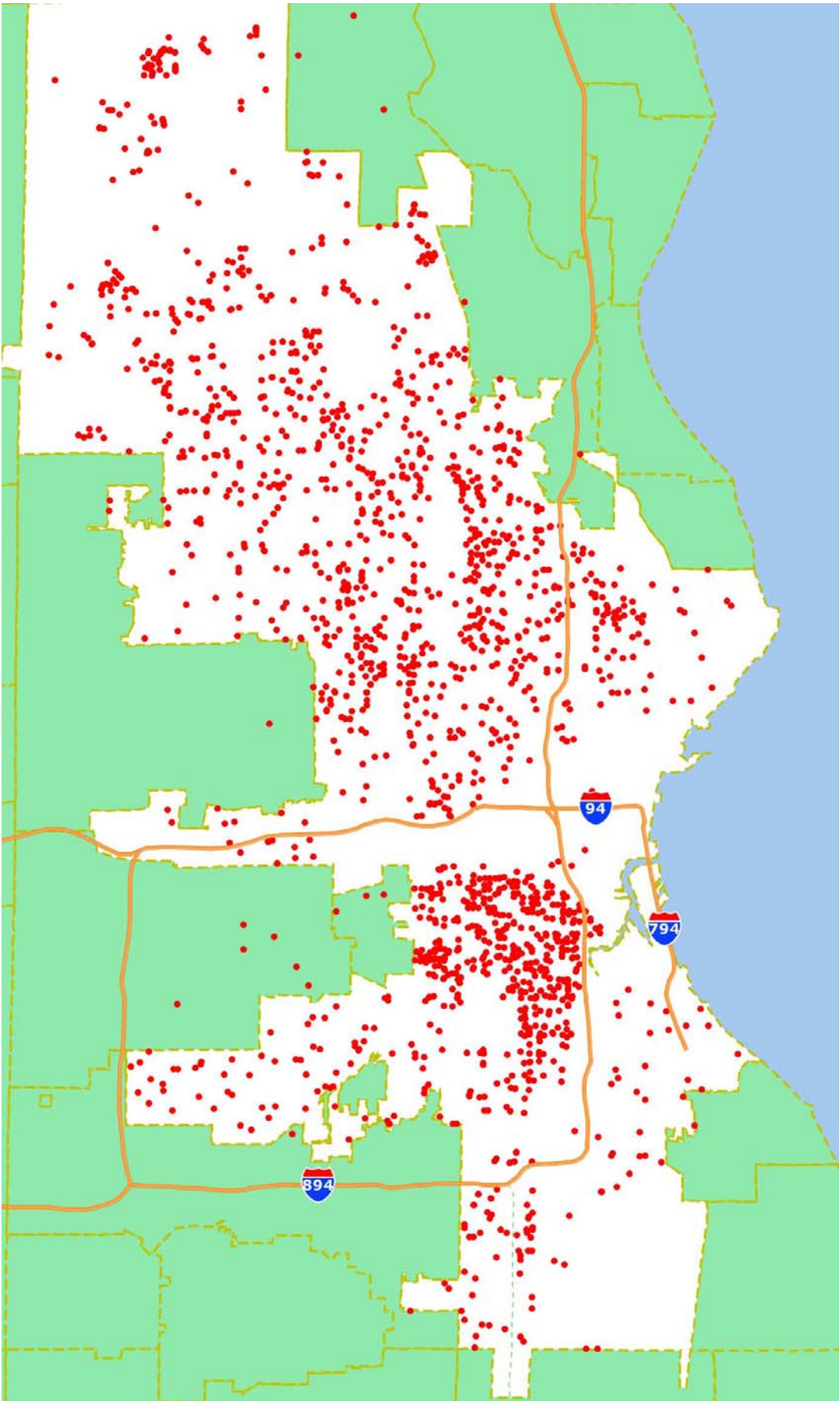

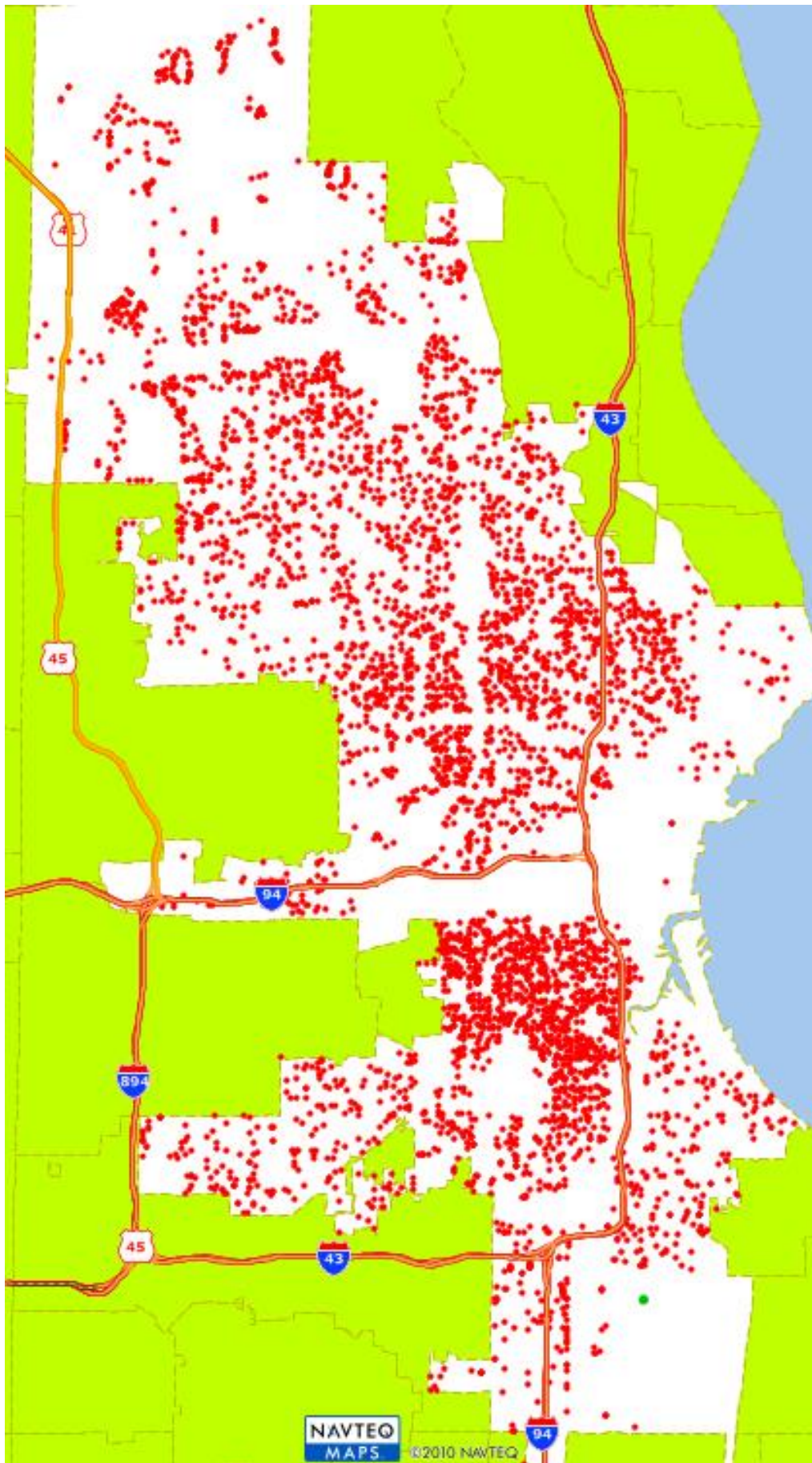




Map 3-9: 6-Year Olds (as of Sept 2010) Enrolled in Milwaukee Private Title I/Choice Schools 2010-11

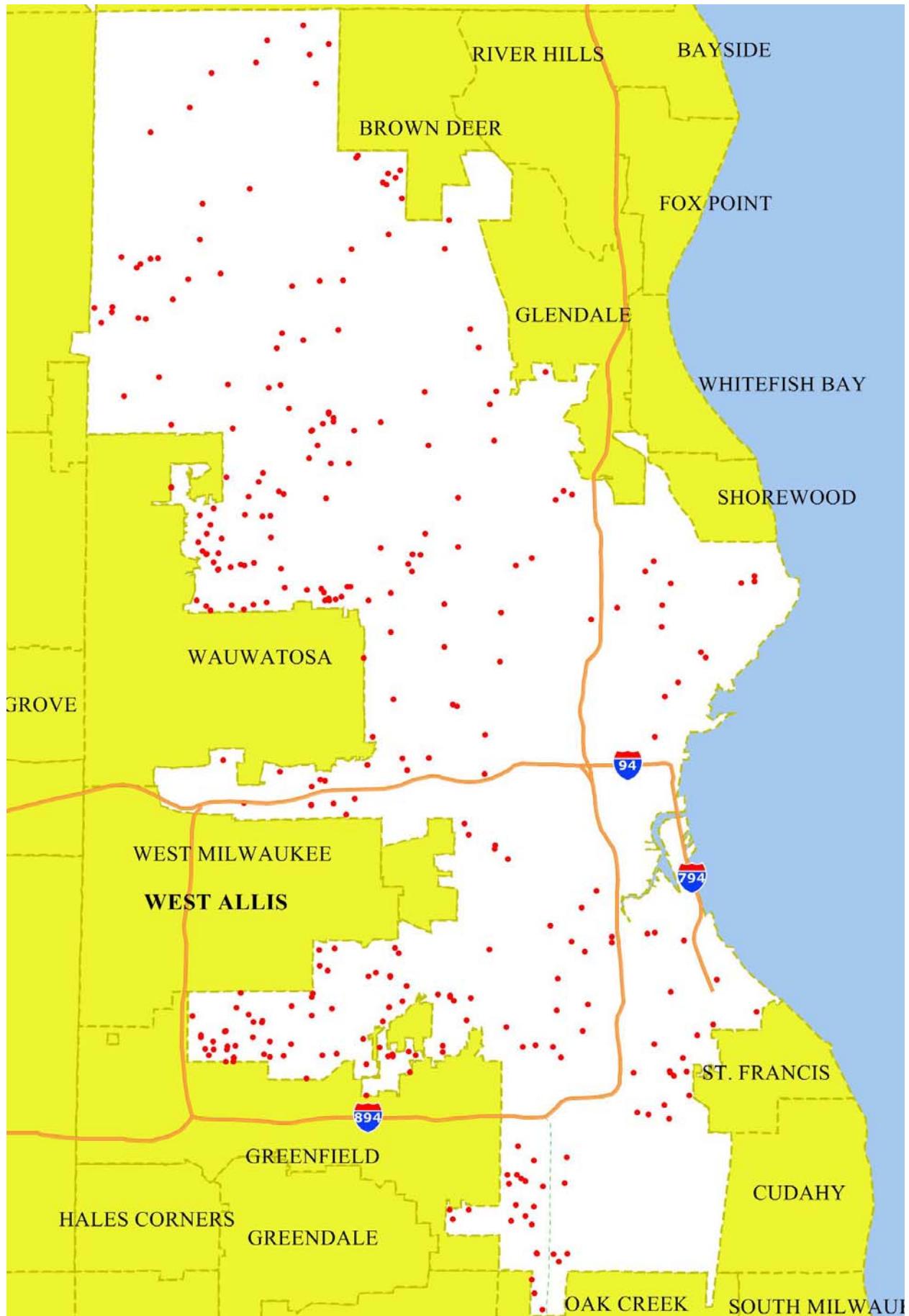


Map 3-10: 7-Year Olds (as of Sept 2010) Enrolled in Milwaukee Public Schools 2010-11



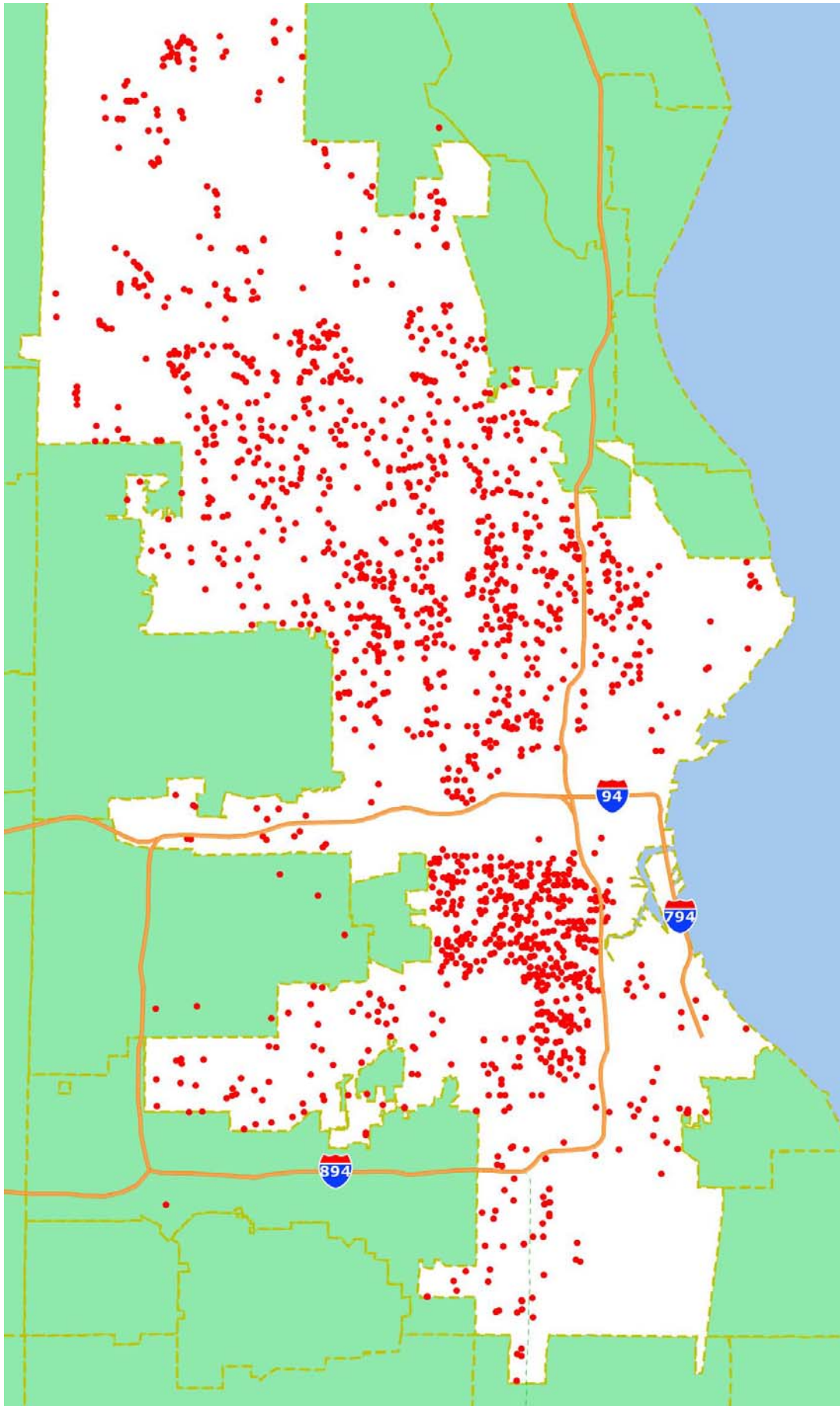


Map 3-11: 7-Year Olds (as of Sept 2010) Enrolled in Non-MPS Public Schools 2010-11  
including UWM and City of Milwaukee Charter Schools, Open Enrollment, Chapter 220

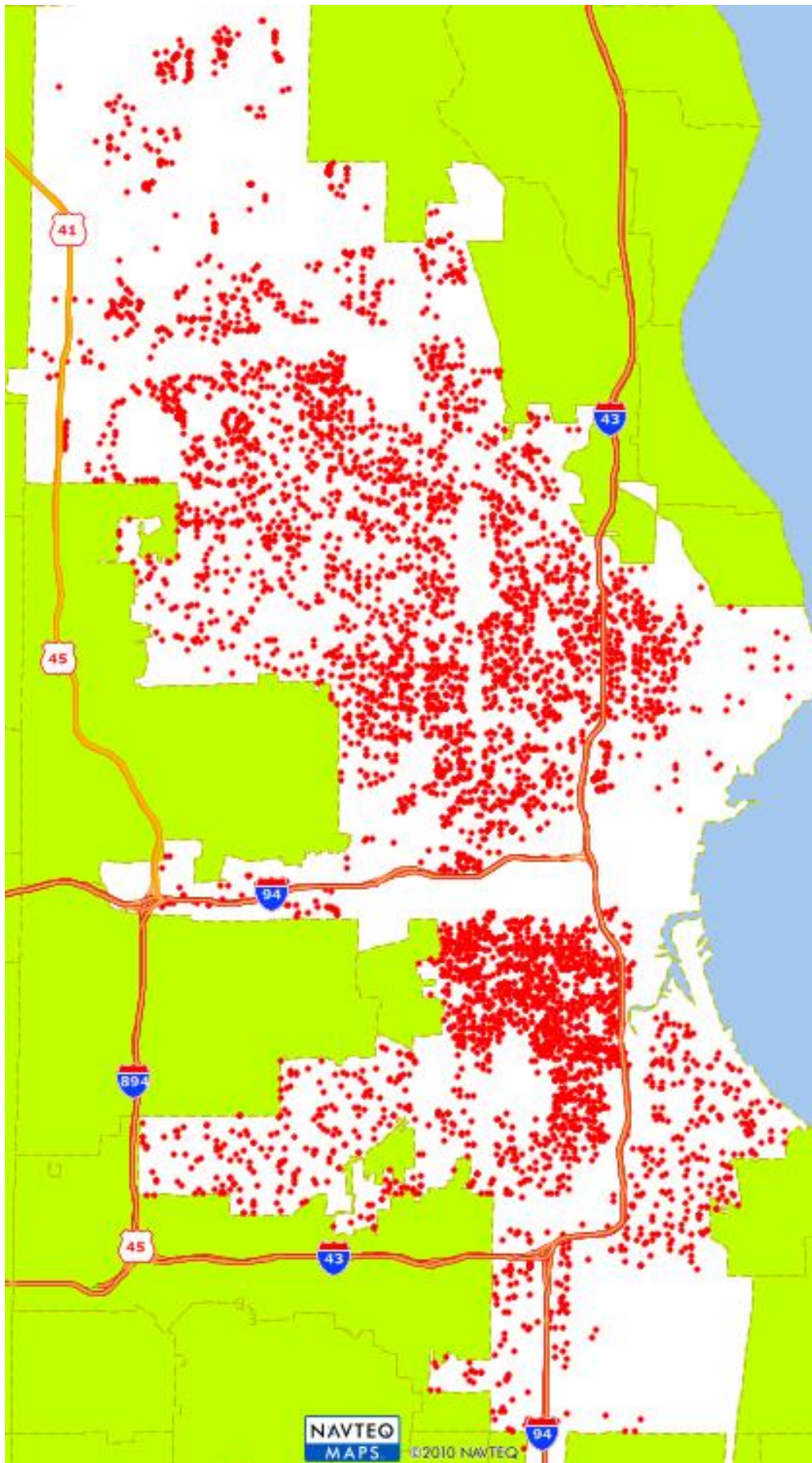




Map 3-12: 7-Year Olds (as of Sept 2010) Enrolled in Milwaukee Private Title I/Choice Schools 2010-11

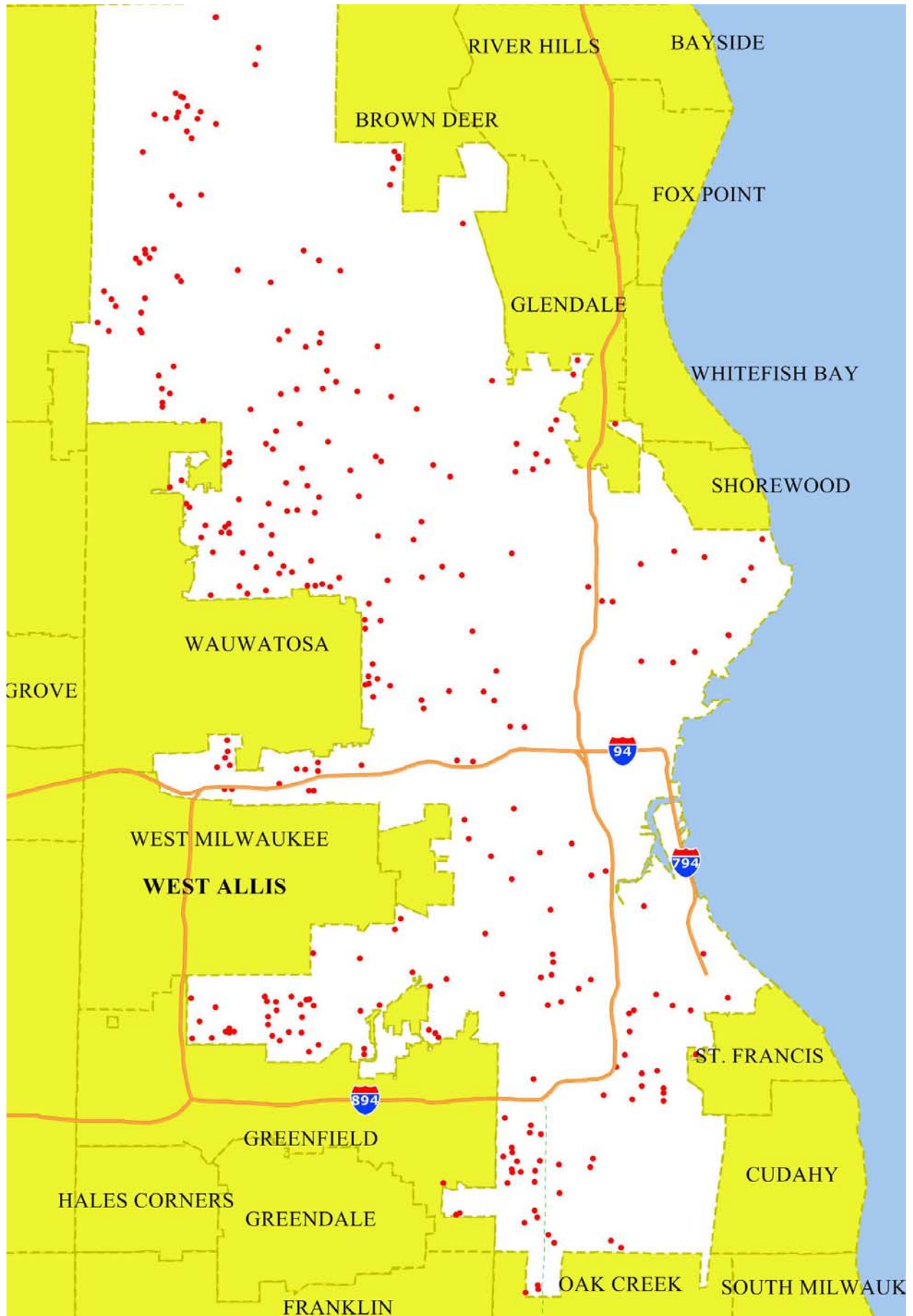


Map 3-13: 8-Year Olds (as of Sept 2010) Enrolled in Milwaukee Public Schools 2010-11



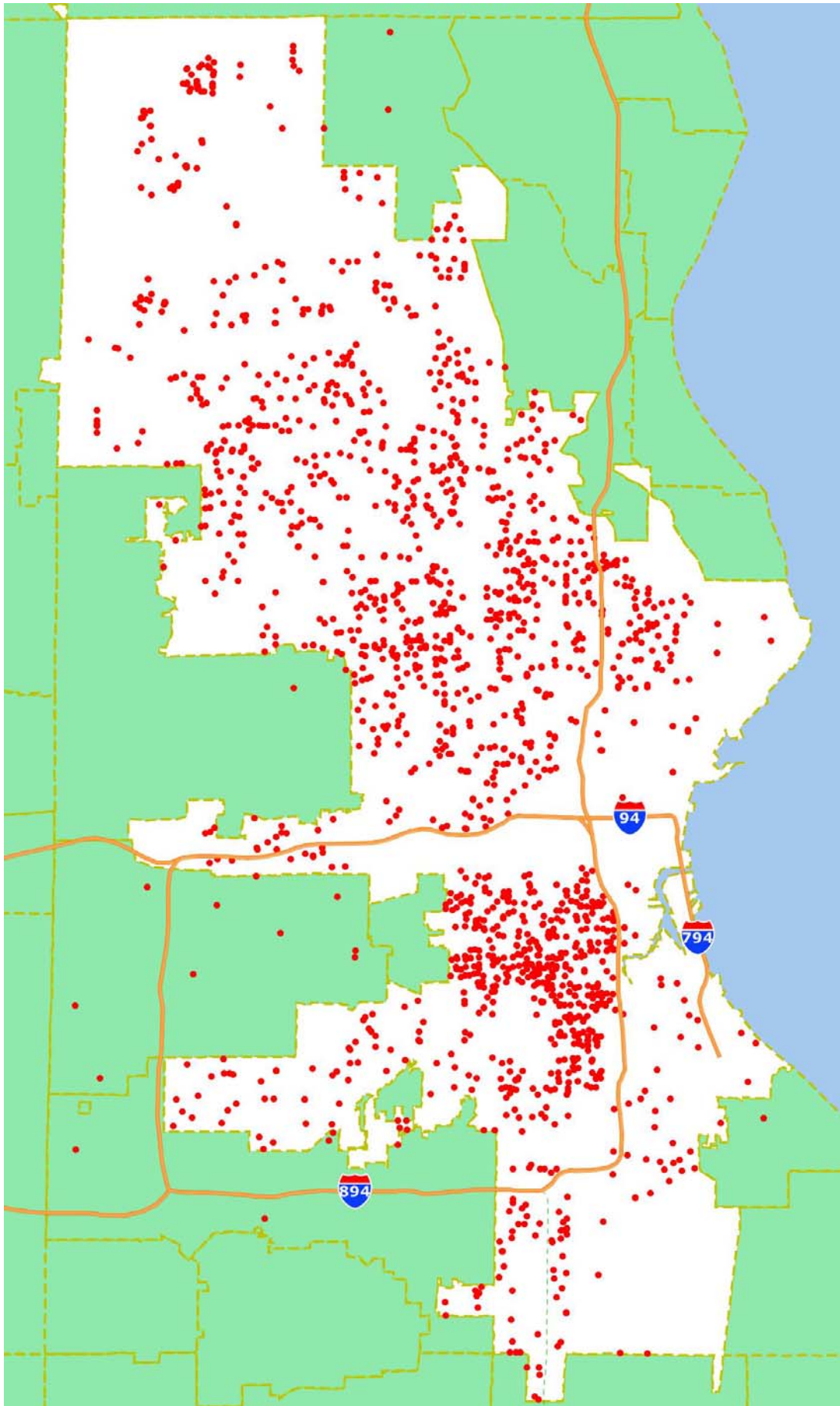


Map 3-14: 8-Year Olds (as of Sept 2010) Enrolled in Non-MPS Public Schools 2010-11  
including UWM and City of Milwaukee Charter Schools, Open Enrollment, Chapter 220

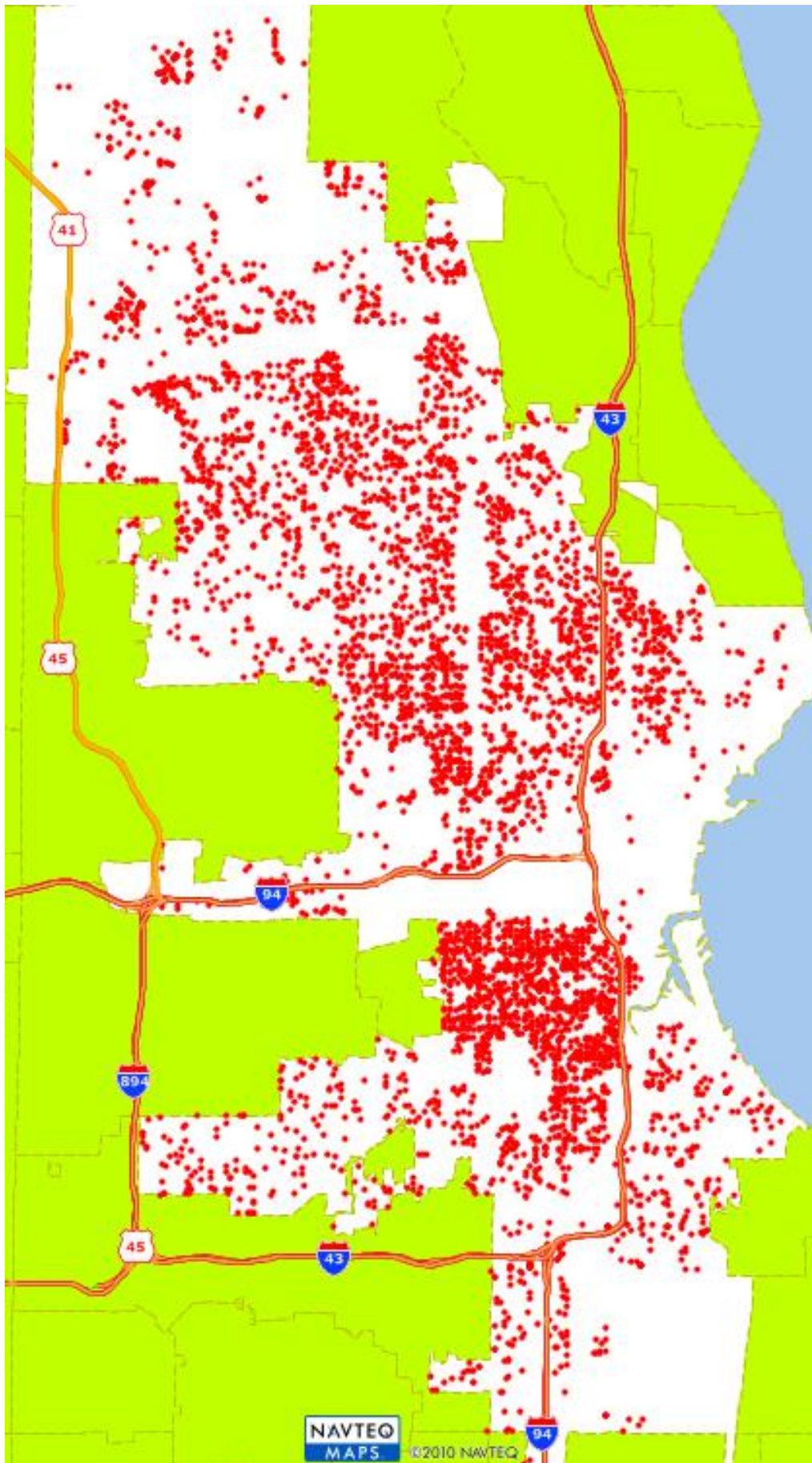




Map 3-15: 8-Year Olds (as of Sept 2010) Enrolled in Milwaukee Private Title I/Choice Schools 2010-11

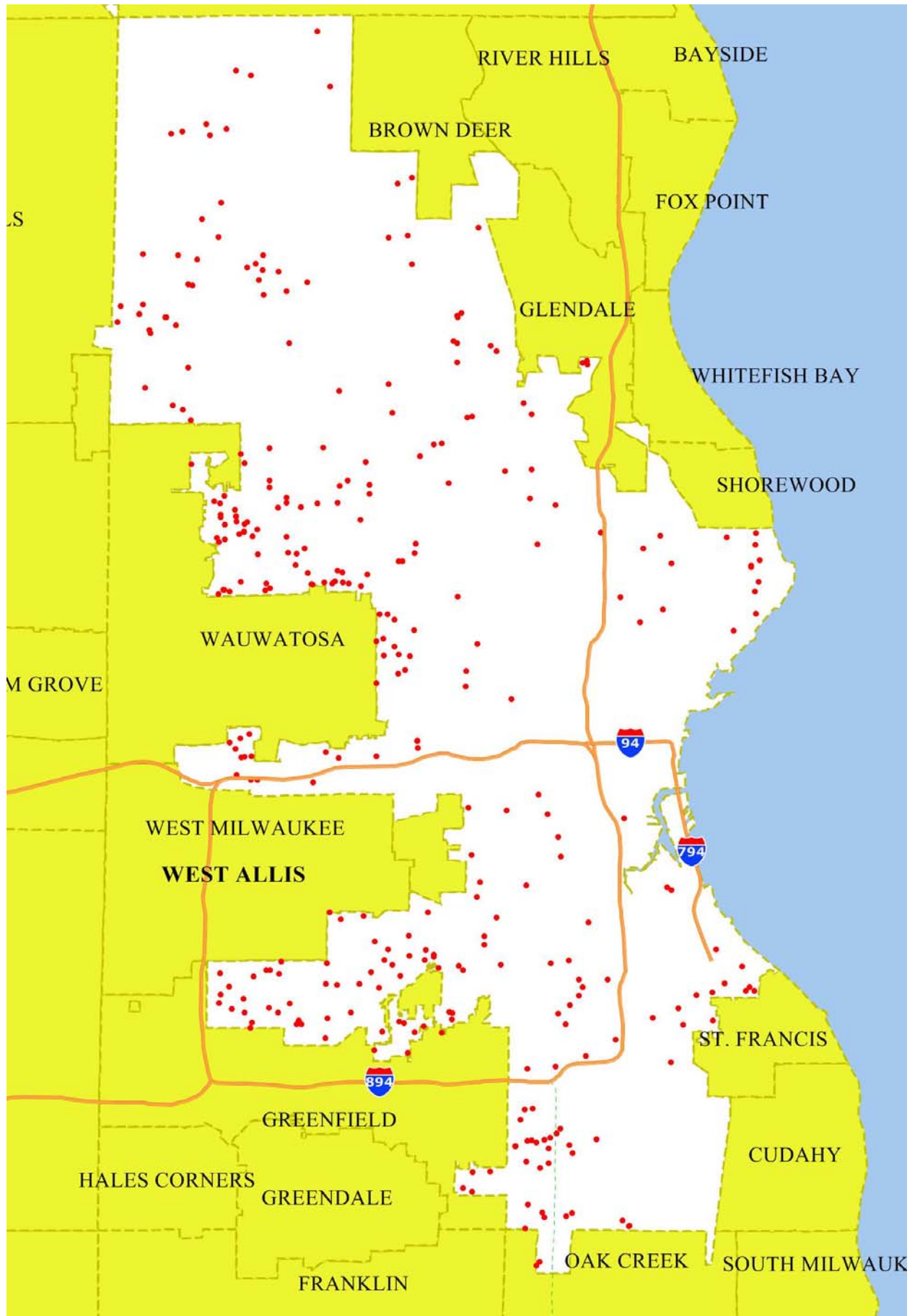


Map 3-16: 9-Year Olds (as of Sept 2010) Enrolled in Milwaukee Public Schools 2010-11



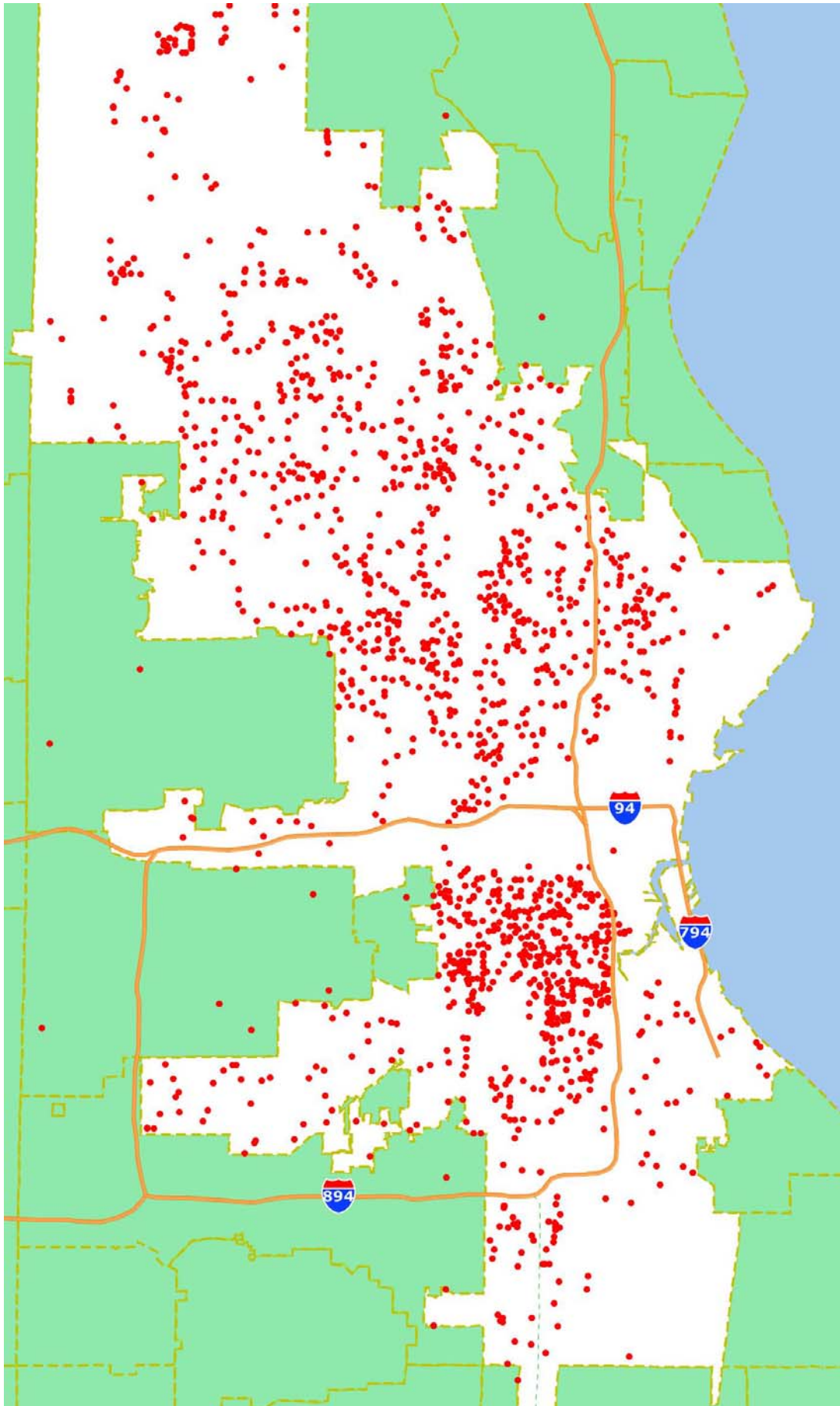

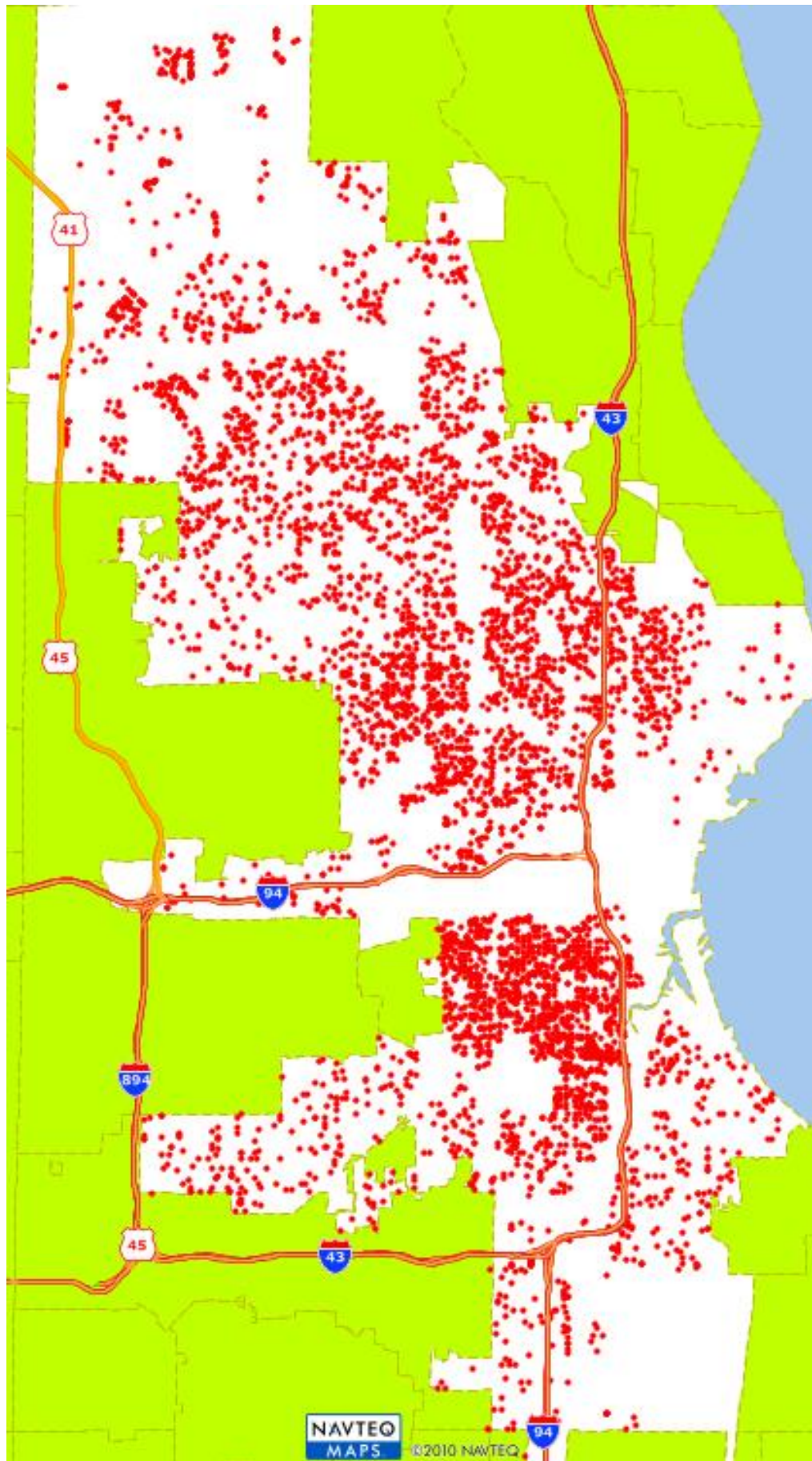




Map 3-18: 9-Year Olds (as of Sept 2010) Enrolled in Milwaukee Private Title I/Choice Schools 2010-11

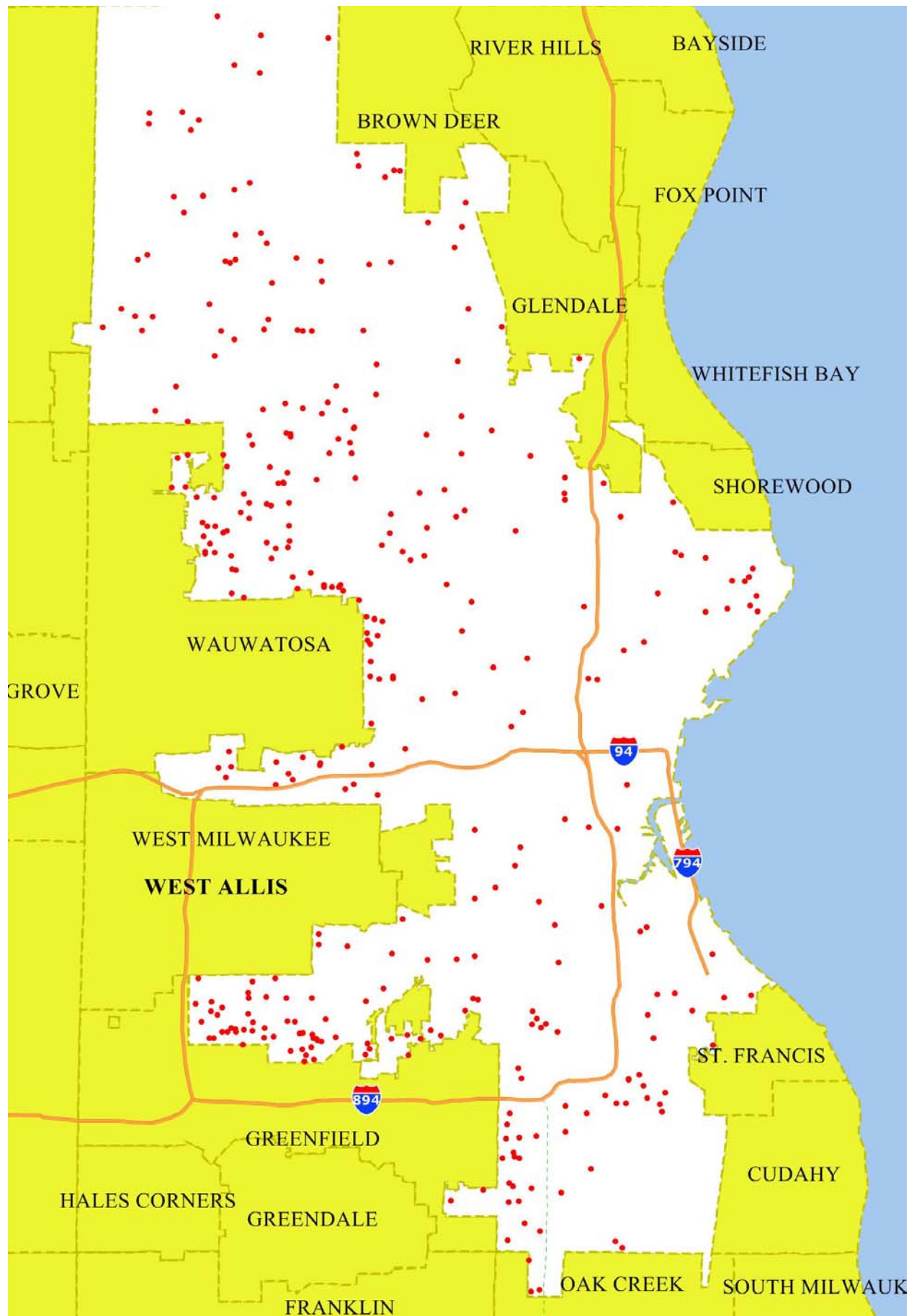


Map 3-19: 10-Year Olds (as of Sept 2010) Enrolled in Milwaukee Public Schools 2010-11



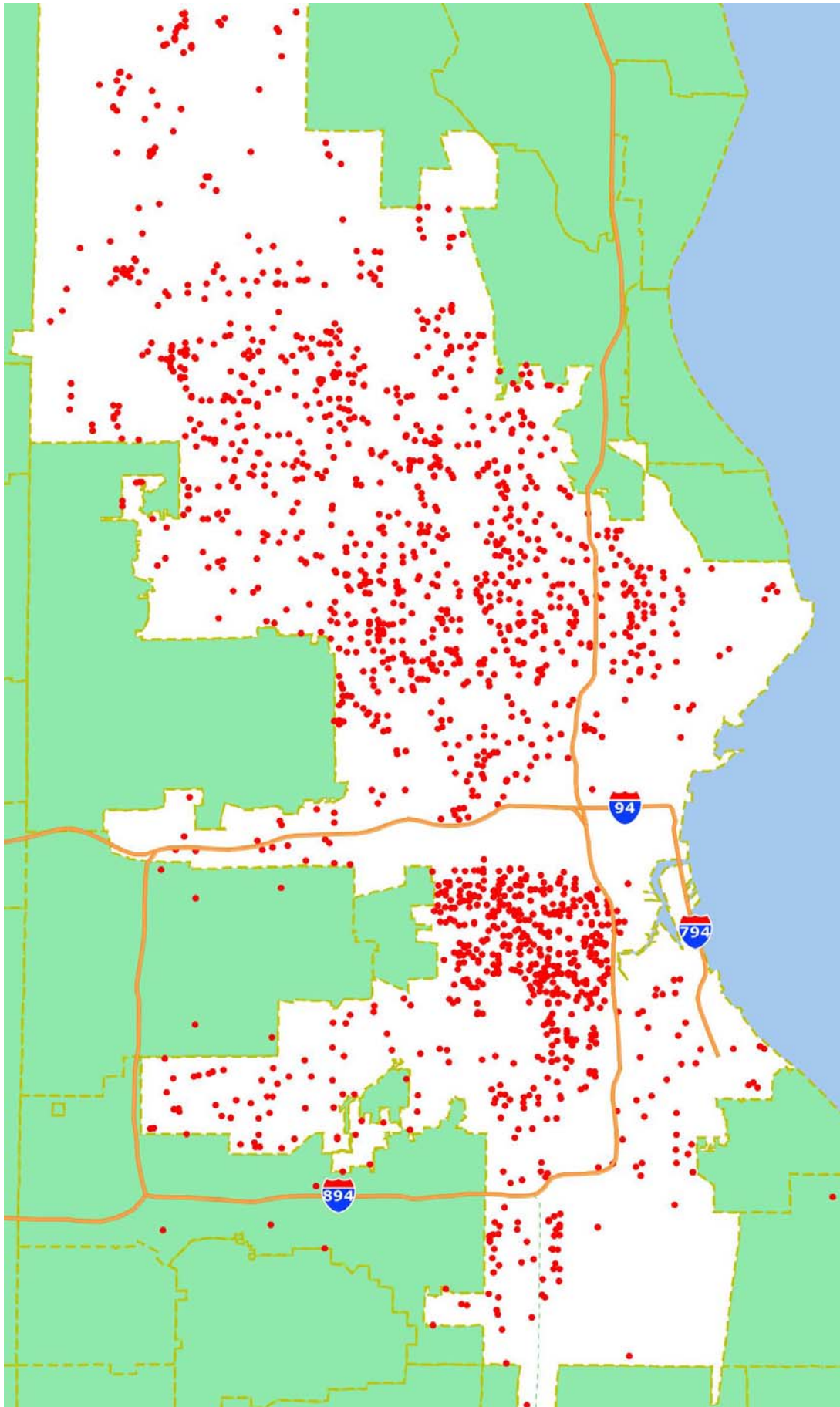

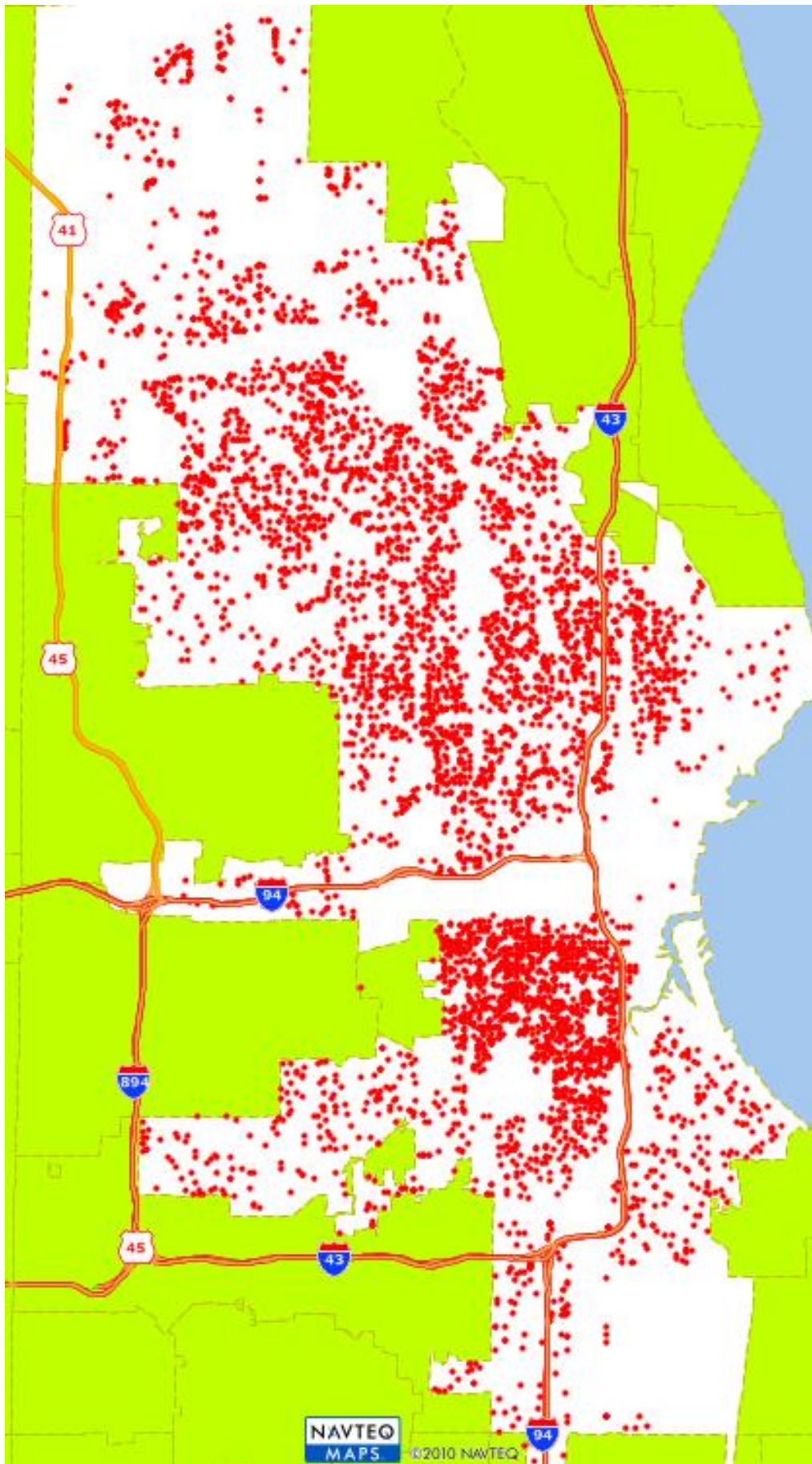




Map 3-21: 10-Year Olds (as of Sept 2010) Enrolled in Milwaukee Private Title I/Choice Schools 2010-11

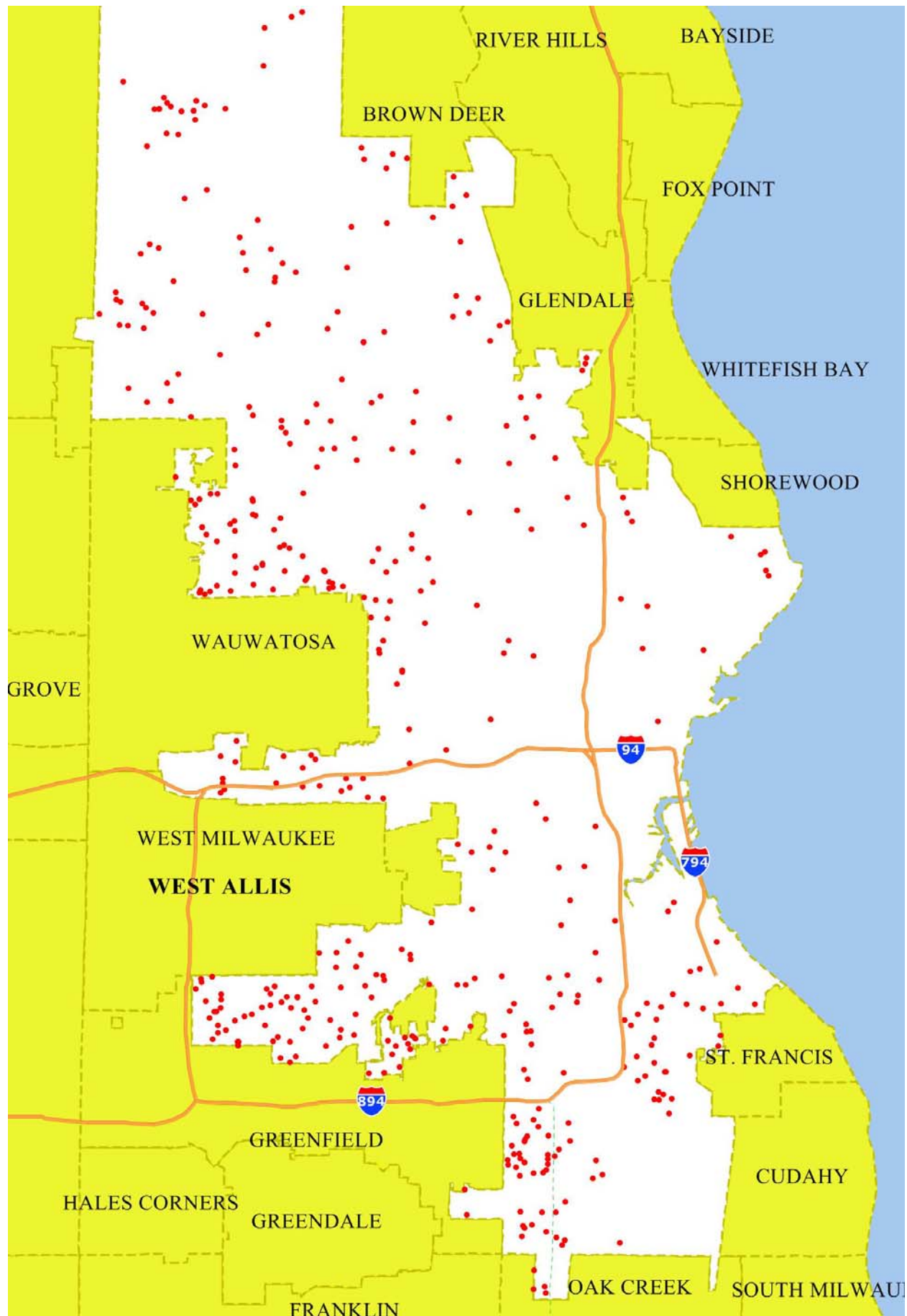


Map 3-22: 11-Year Olds (as of Sept 2010) Enrolled in Milwaukee Public Schools 2010-11



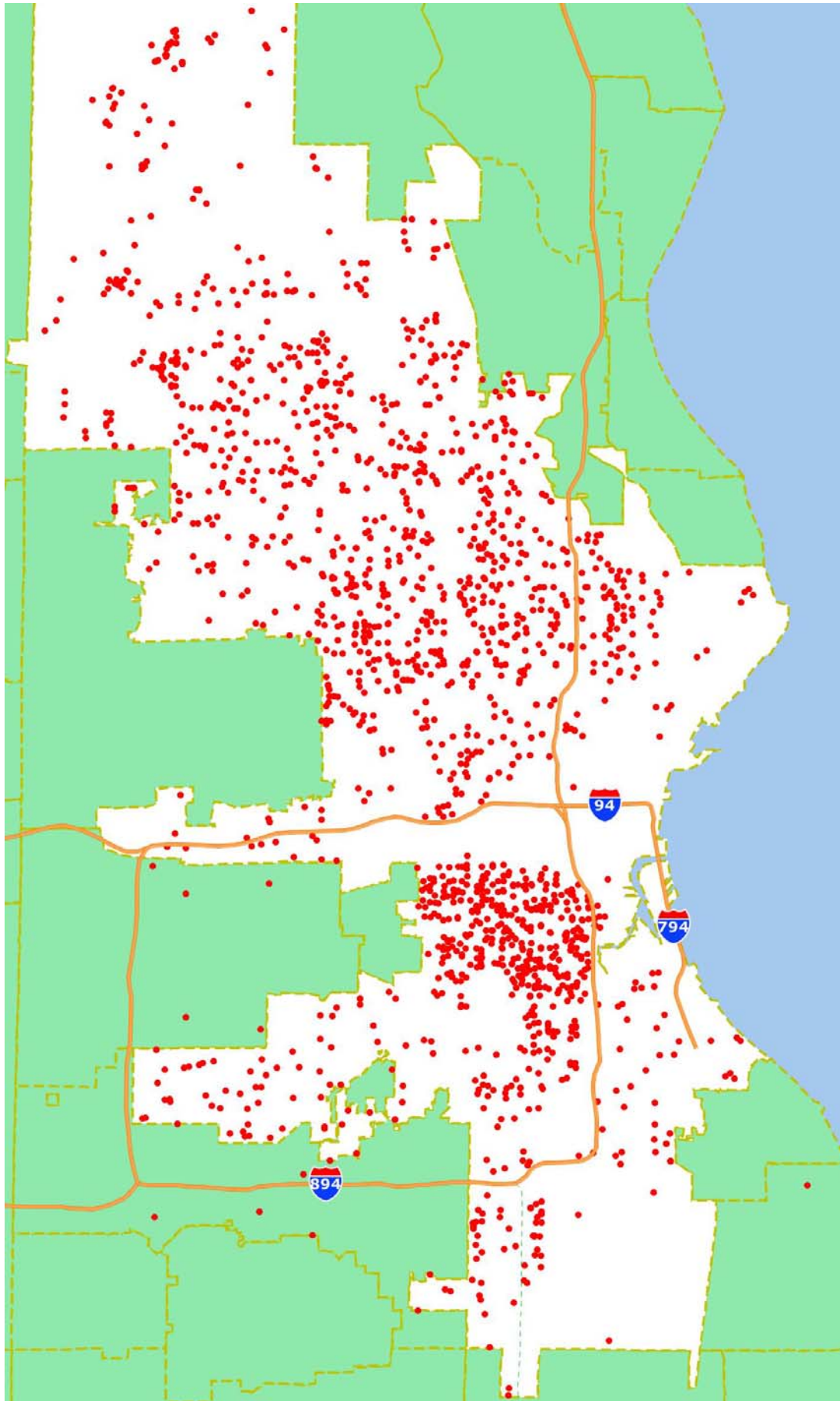

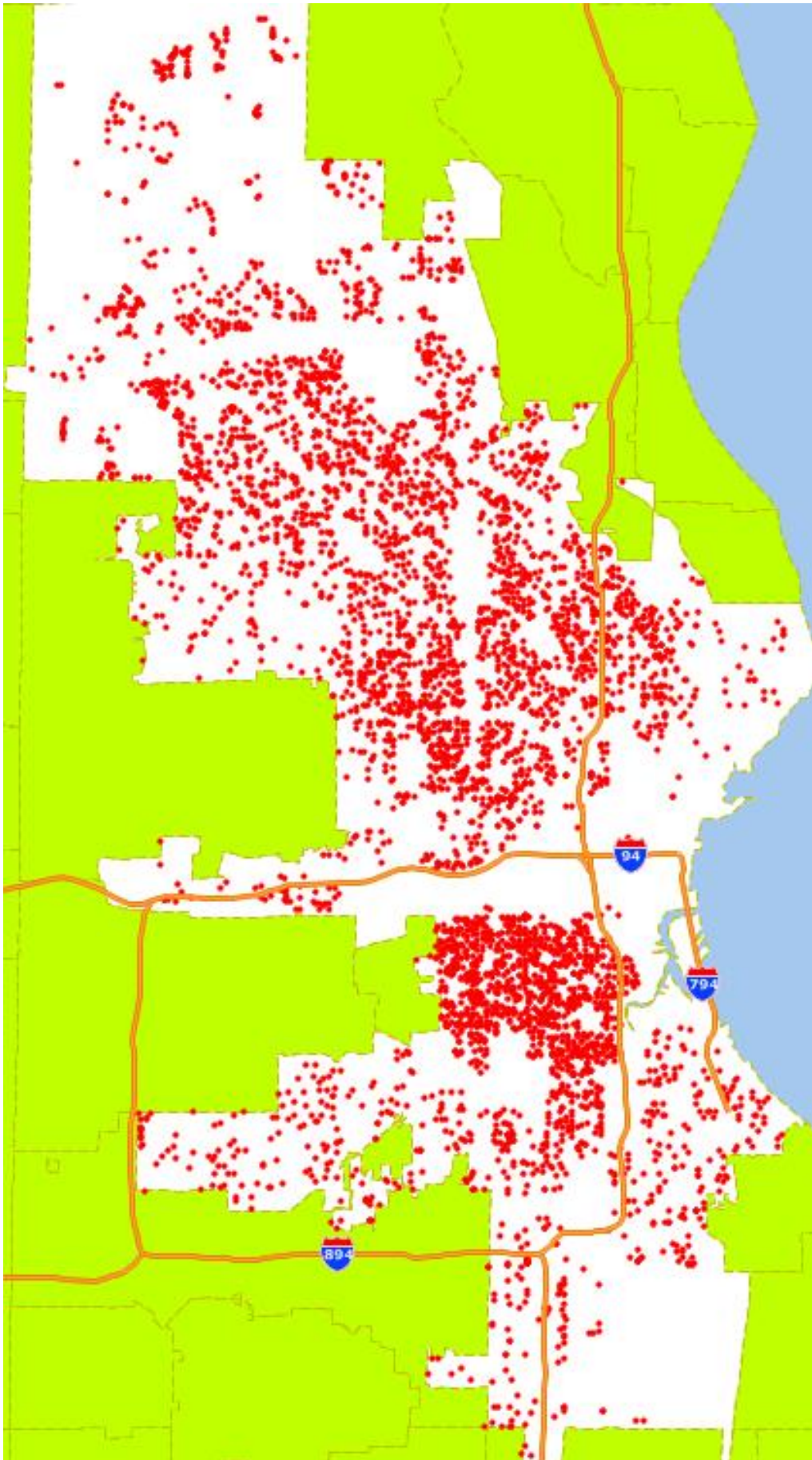




Map 3-24: 11-Year Olds (as of Sept 2010) Enrolled in Milwaukee Private Title I/Choice Schools 2010-11

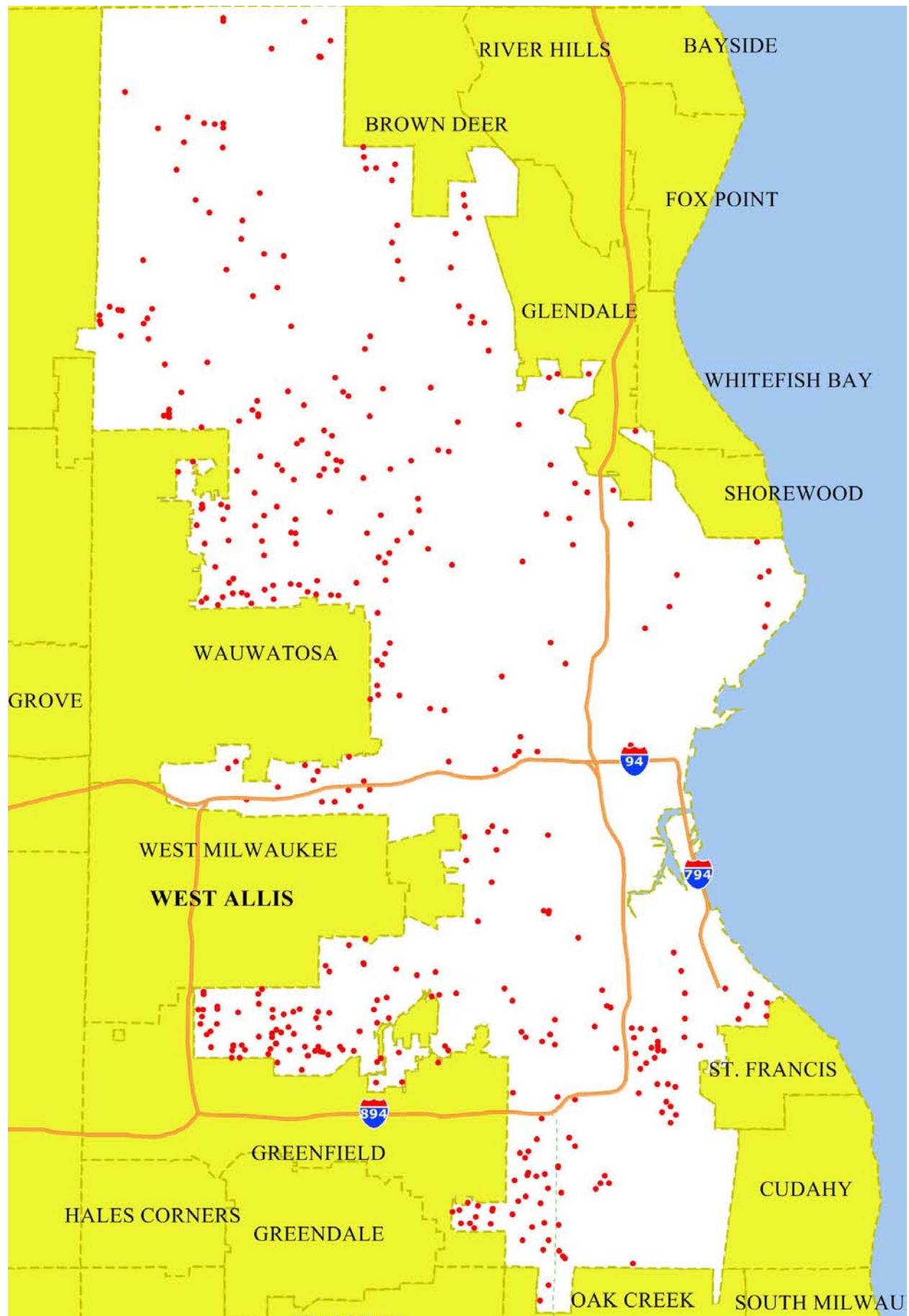


Map 3-25: 12-Year Olds (as of Sept 2010) Enrolled in Milwaukee Public Schools 2010-11



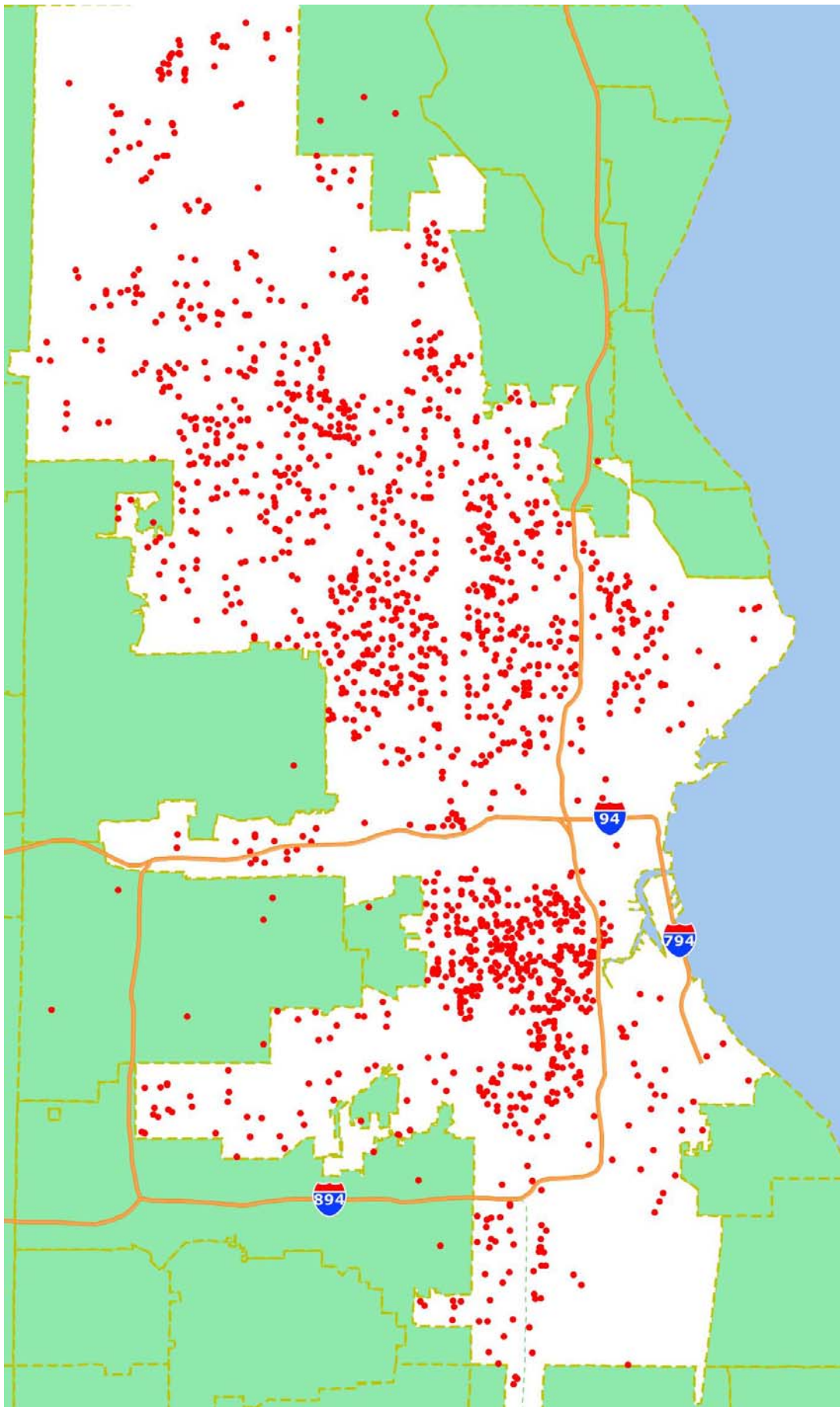

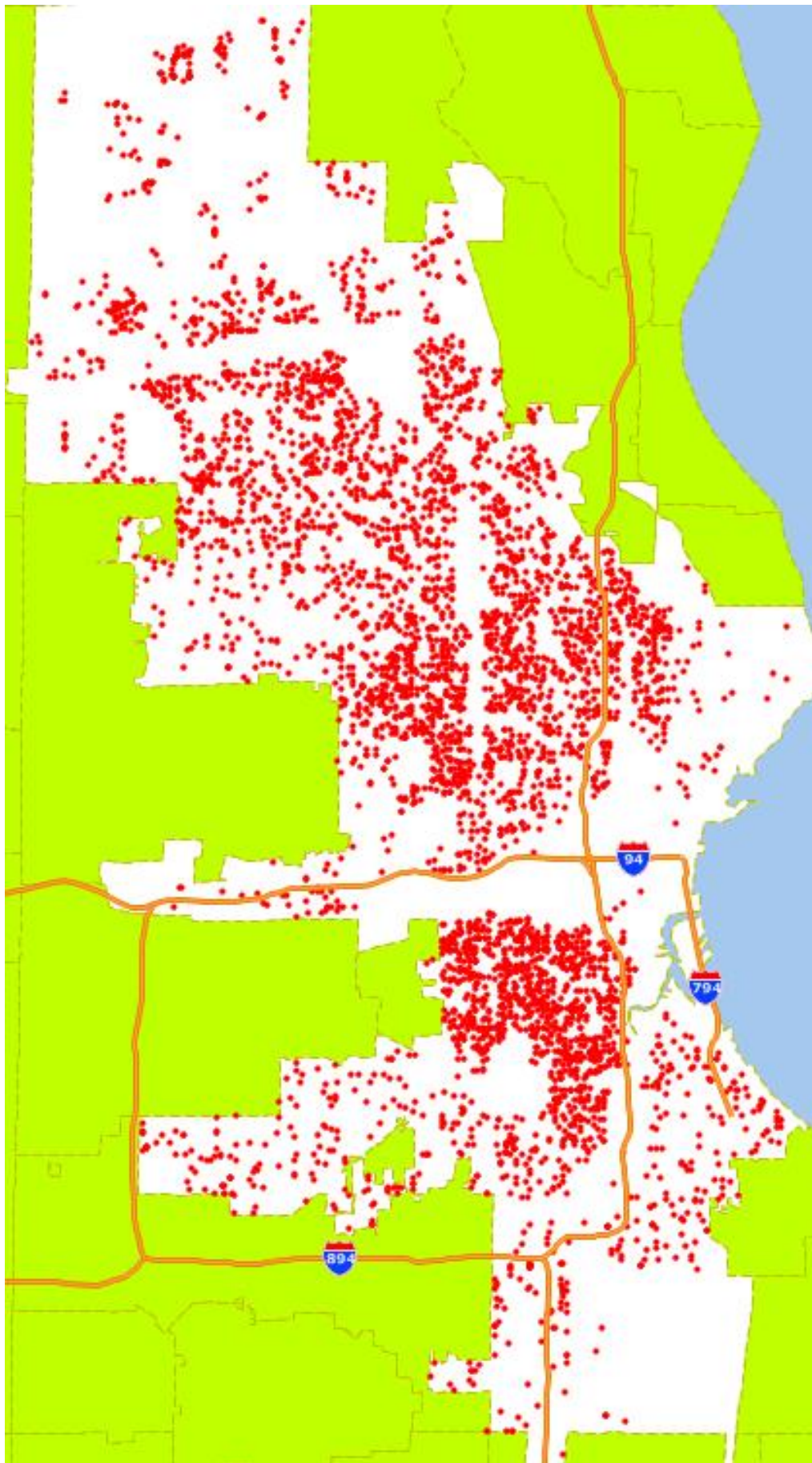




Map 3-27: 12-Year Olds (as of Sept 2010) Enrolled in Milwaukee Private Title I/Choice Schools 2010-11

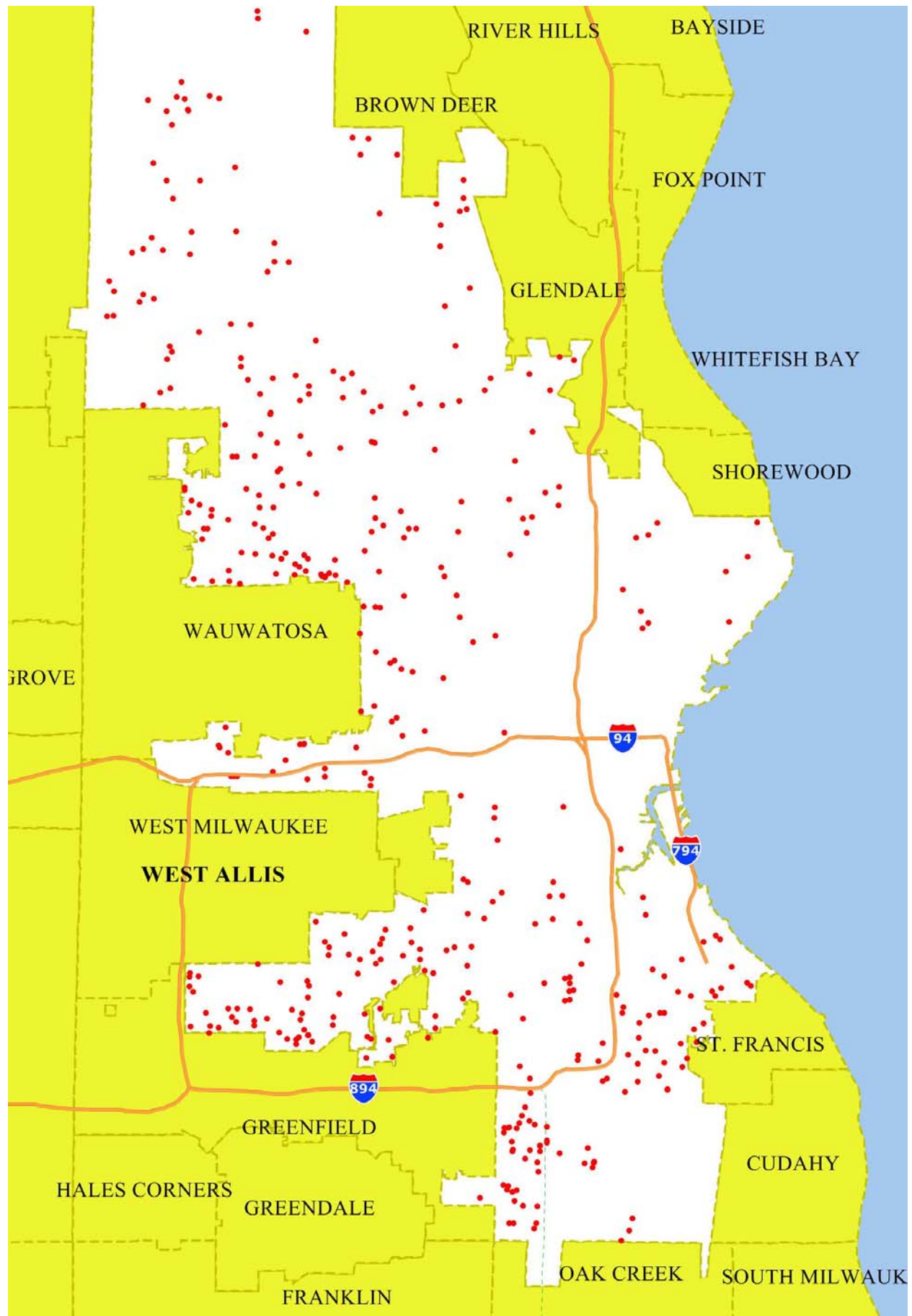


Map 3-28: 13-Year Olds (as of Sept 2010) Enrolled in Milwaukee Public Schools 2010-11



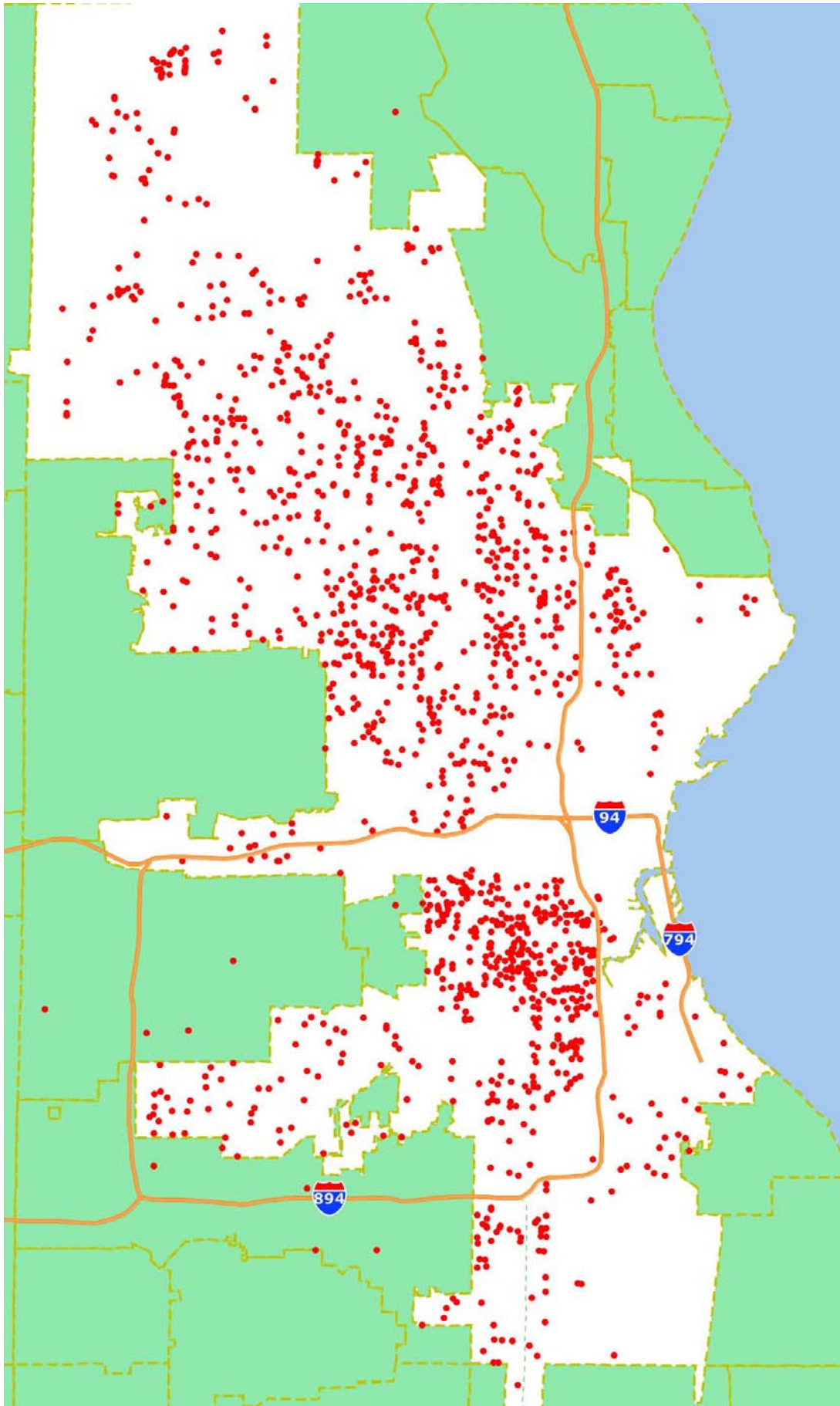

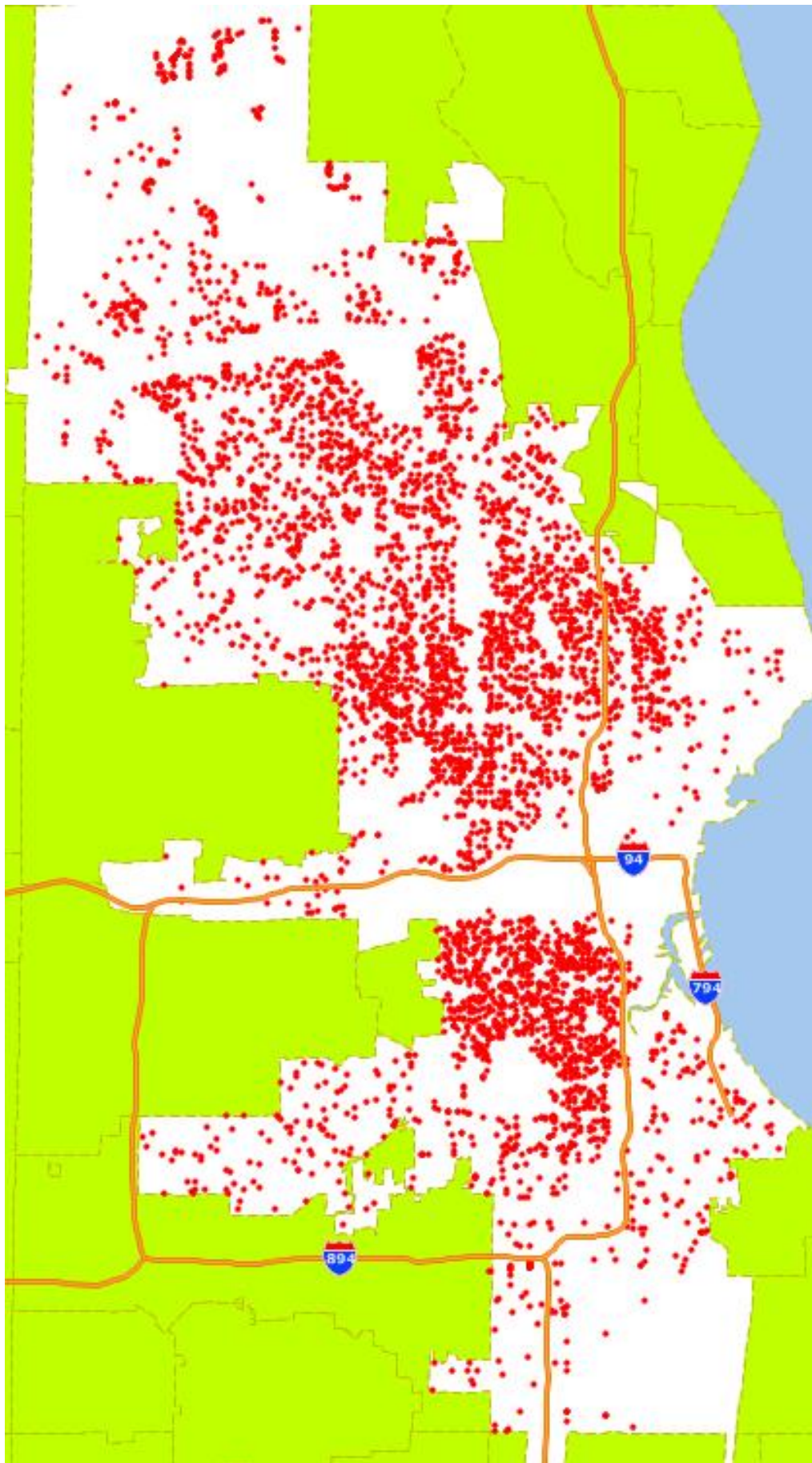




Map 3-30: 13-Year Olds (as of Sept 2010) Enrolled in Milwaukee Private Title I/Choice Schools 2010-11

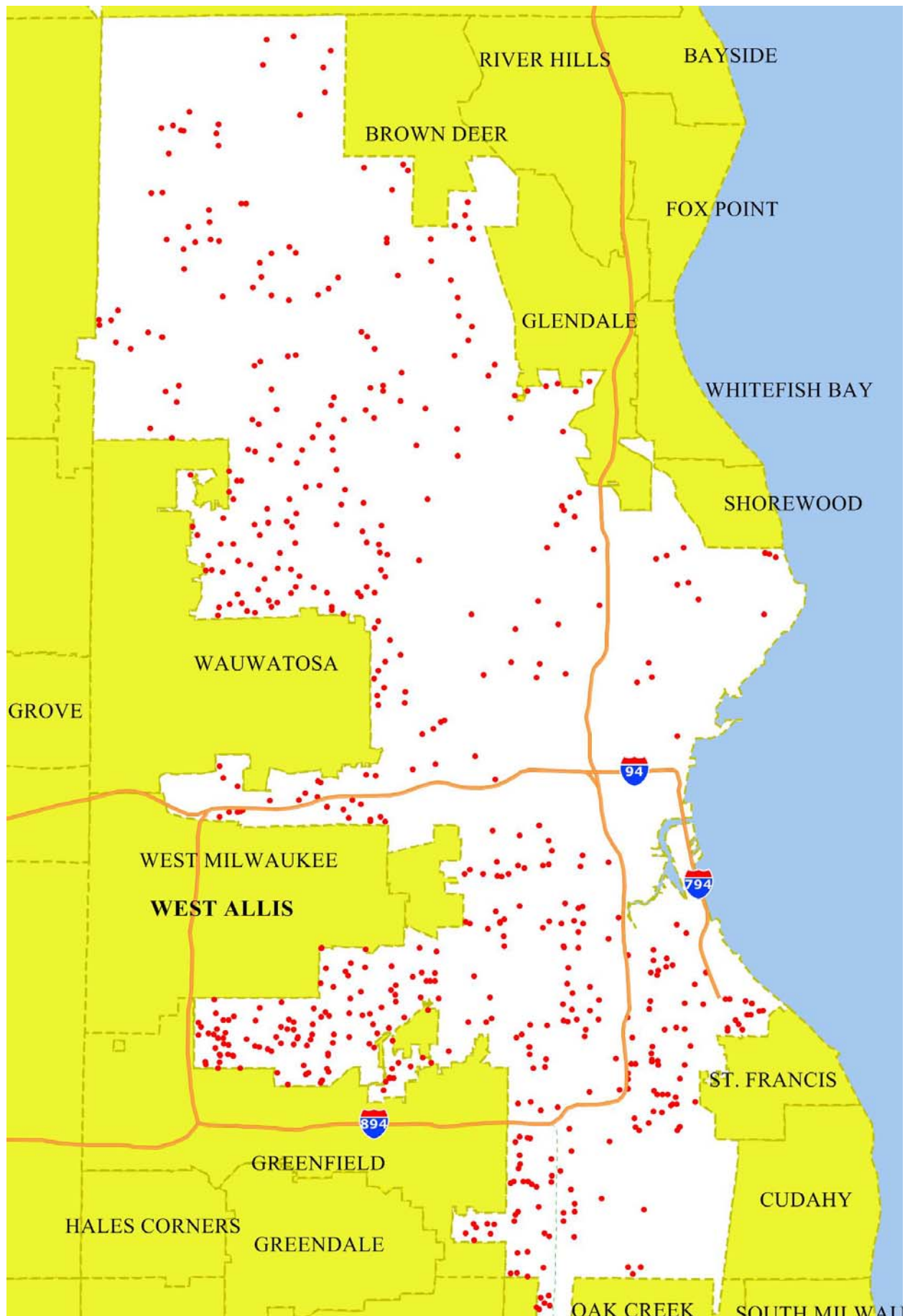


Map 3-31: 14-Year Olds (as of Sept 2010) Enrolled in Milwaukee Public Schools 2010-11



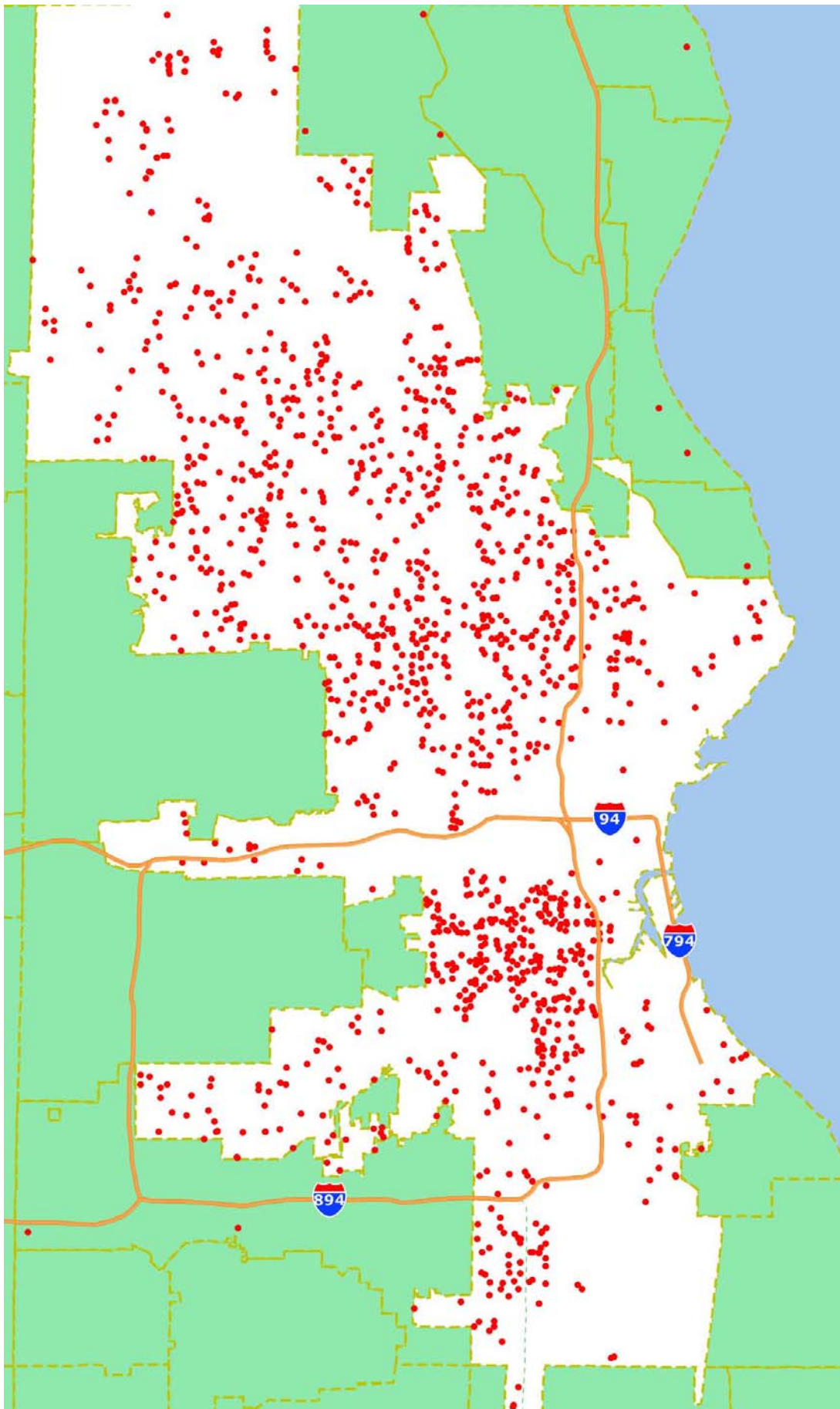

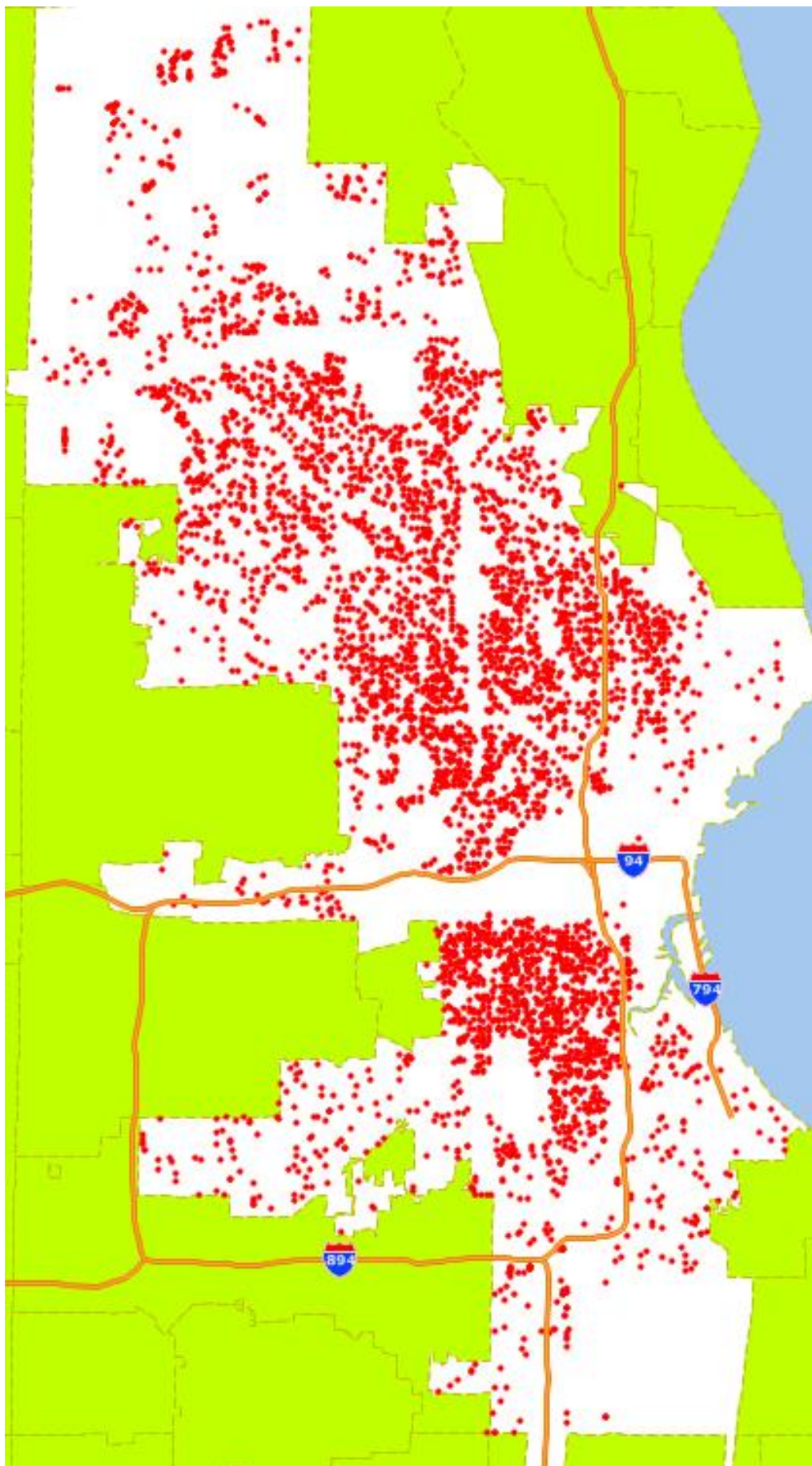




Map 3-33: 14-Year Olds (as of Sept 2010) Enrolled in Milwaukee Private Title I/Choice Schools 2010-11

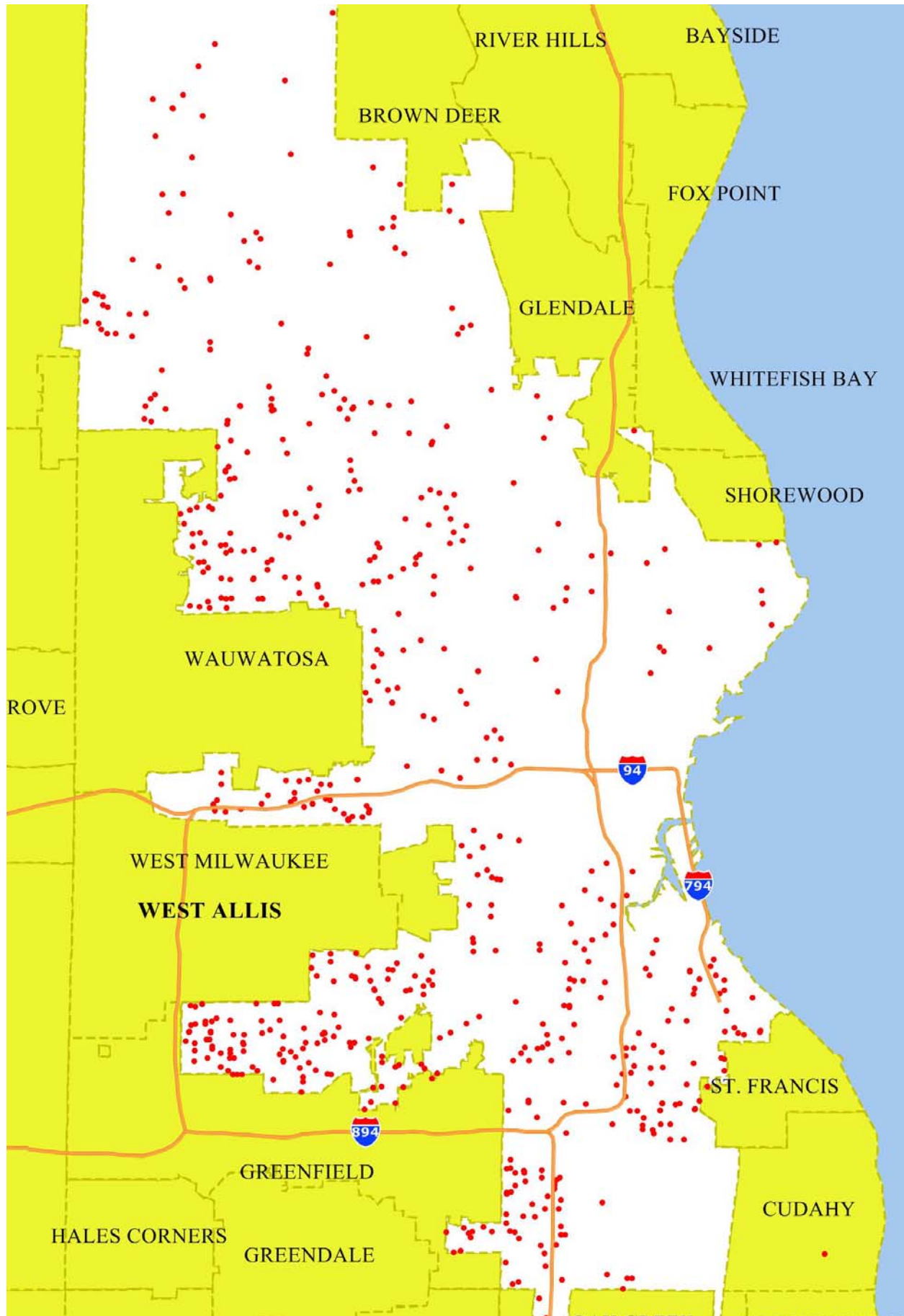


Map 3-34: 15-Year Olds (as of Sept 2010) Enrolled in Milwaukee Public Schools 2010-11



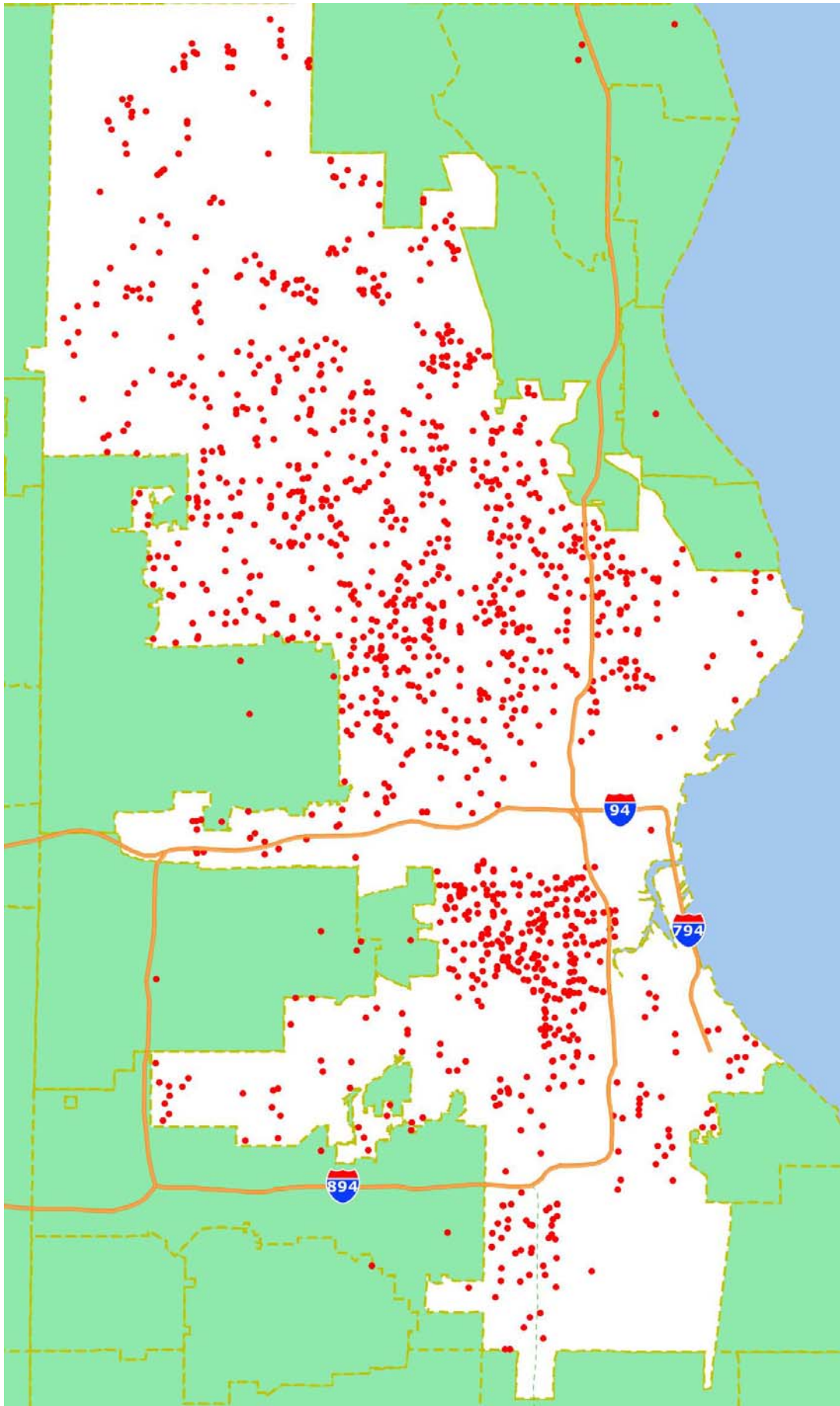


Map 3-35: 15-Year Olds (as of Sept 2010) Enrolled in Non-MPS Public Schools 2010-11  
including UWM and City of Milwaukee Charter Schools, Open Enrollment, Chapter 220

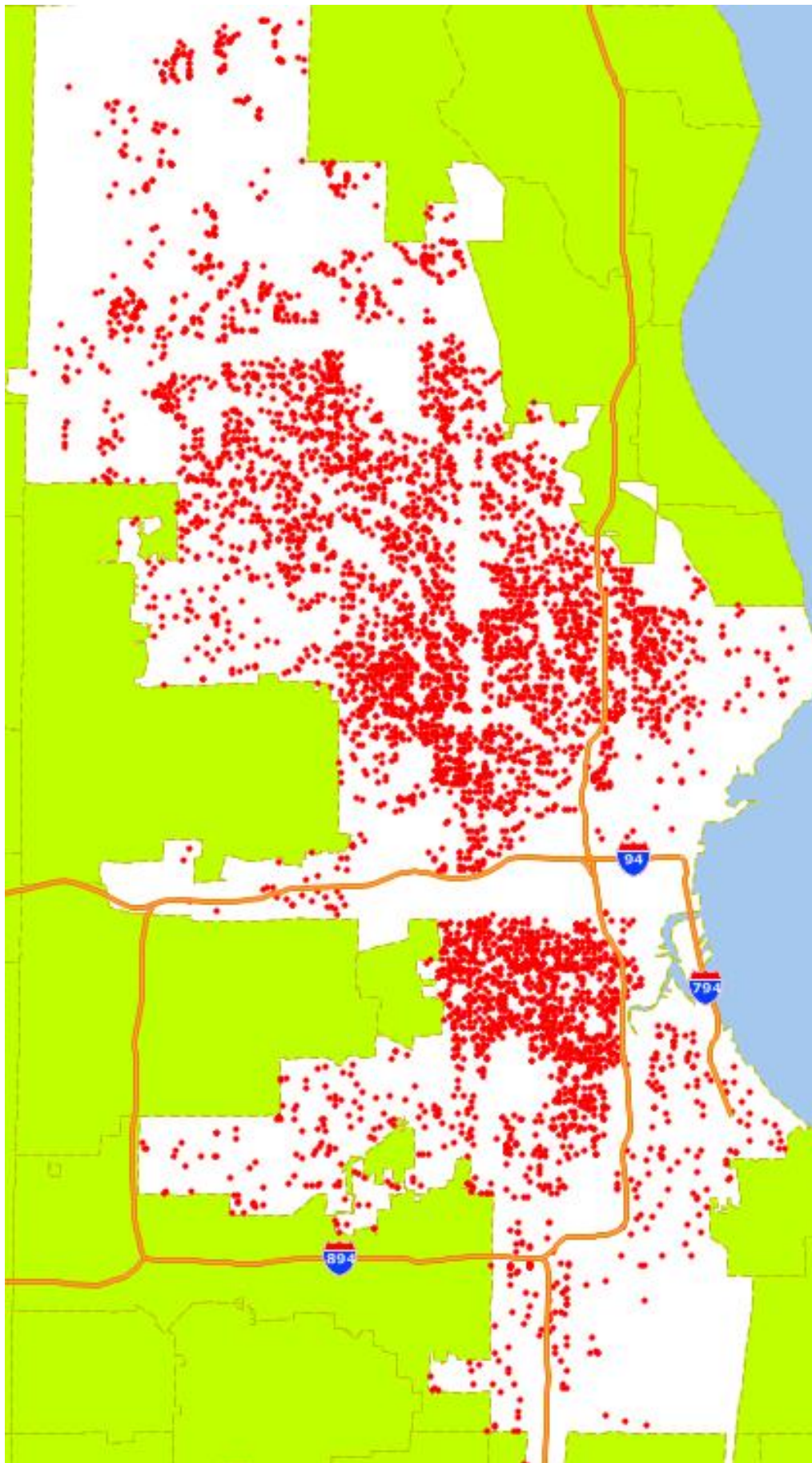




Map 3-36: 15-Year Olds (as of Sept 2010) Enrolled in Milwaukee Private Title I/Choice Schools 2010-11

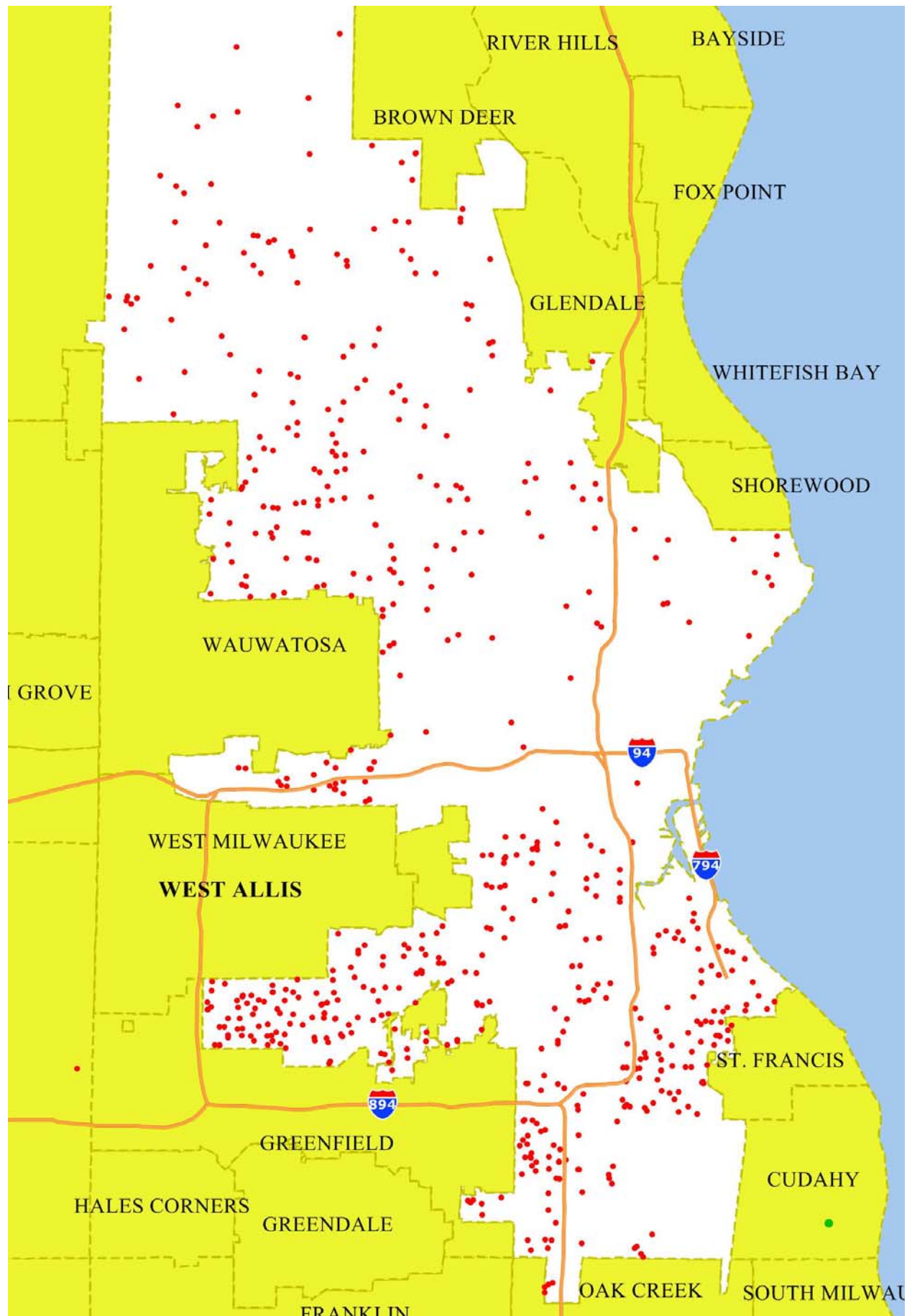


Map 3-37: 16-Year Olds (as of Sept 2010) Enrolled in Milwaukee Public Schools 2010-11



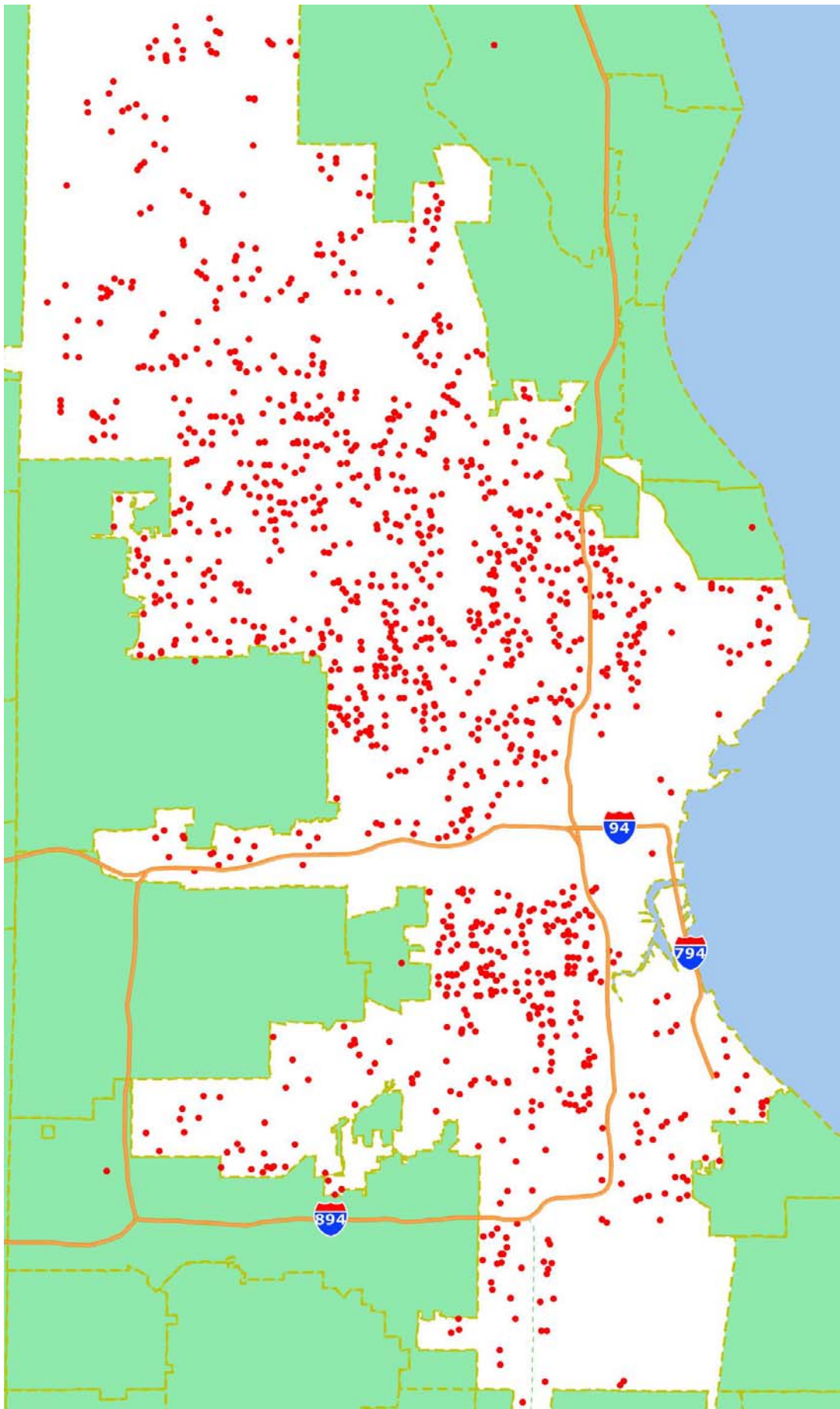


Map 3-38: 16-Year Olds (as of Sept 2010) Enrolled in Non-MPS Public Schools 2010-11  
including UWM and City of Milwaukee Charter Schools, Open Enrollment, Chapter 220

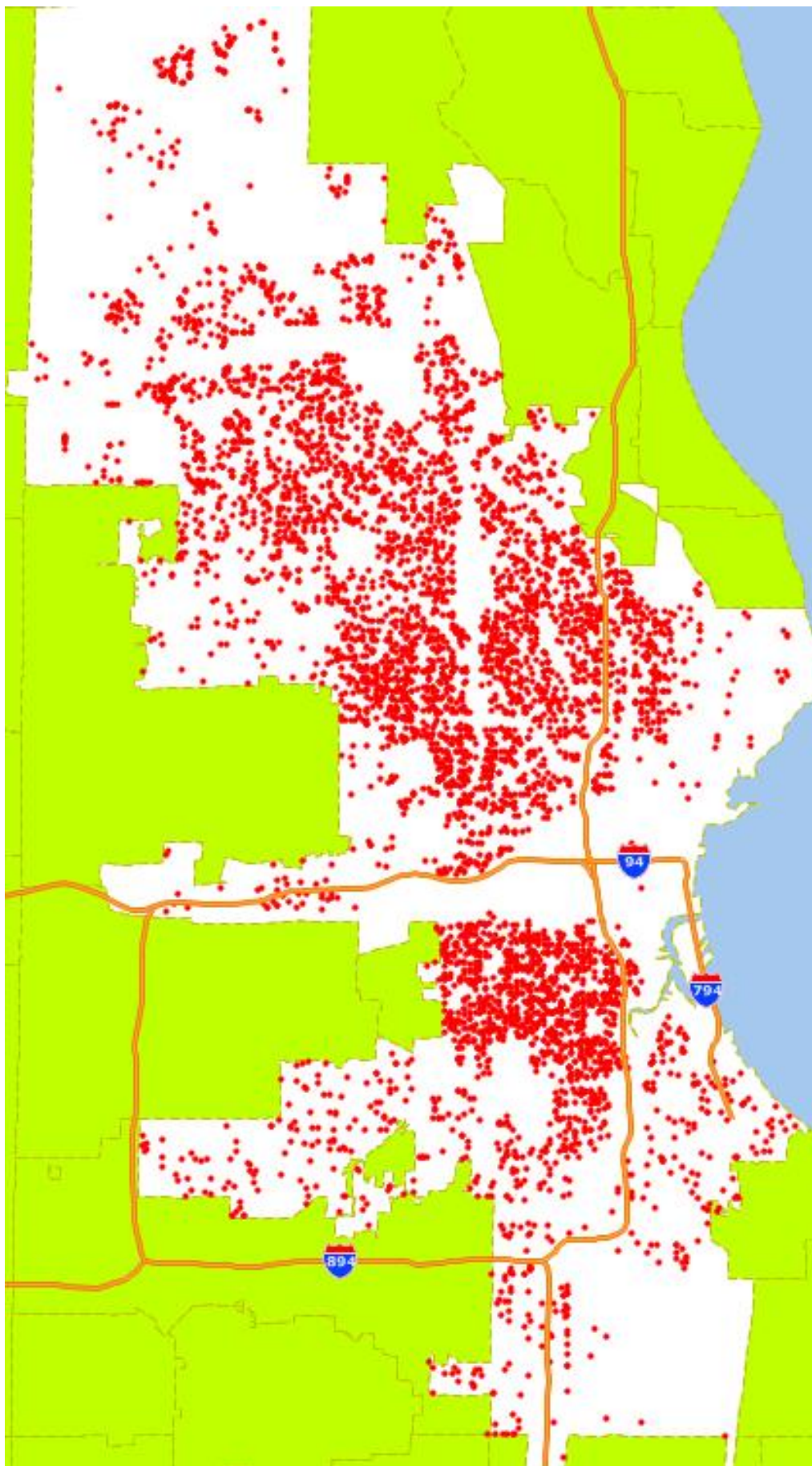




Map 3-39: 16-Year Olds (as of Sept 2010) Enrolled in Milwaukee Private Title I/Choice Schools 2010-11

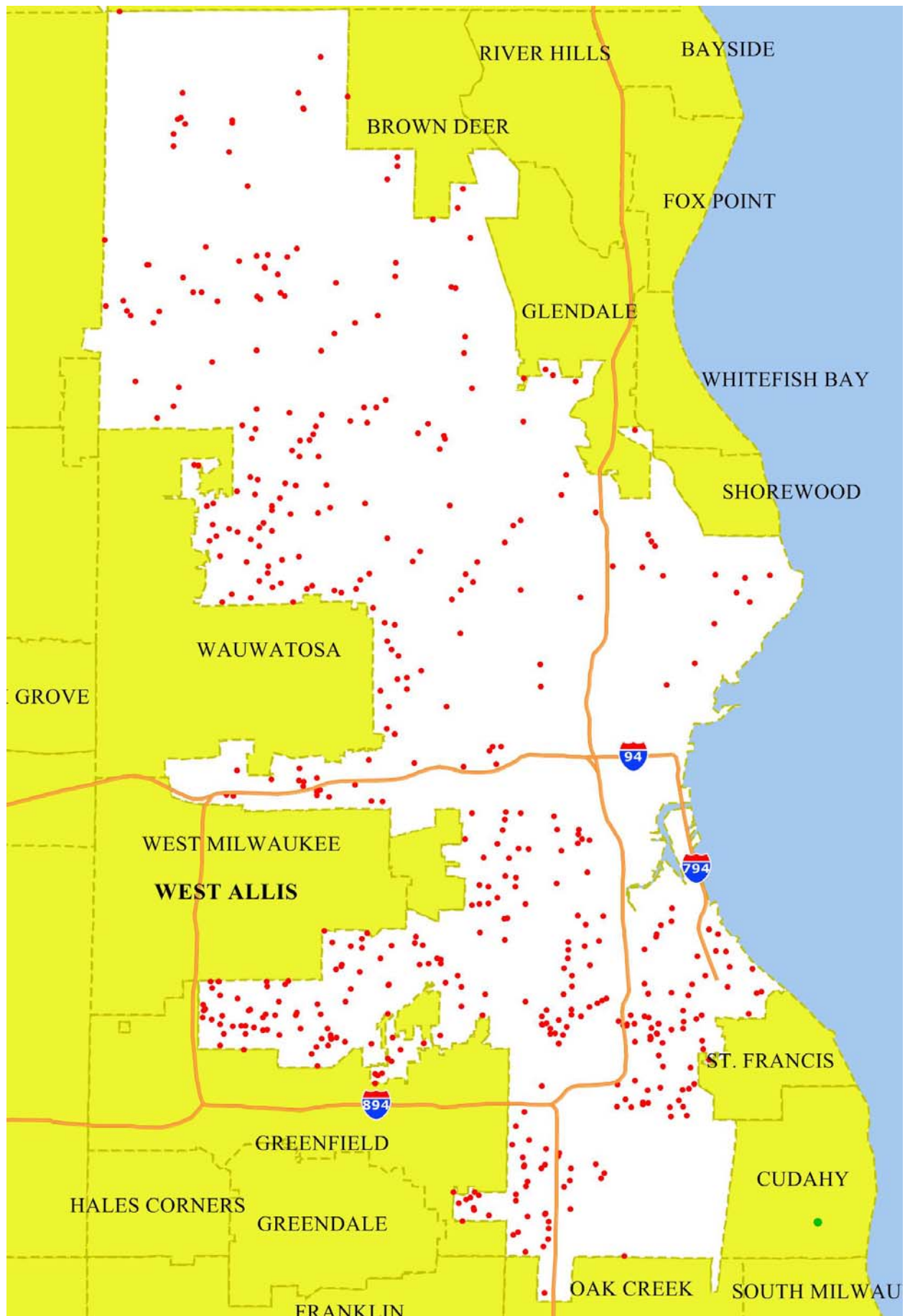


Map 3-40: 17-Year Olds (as of Sept 2010) Enrolled in Milwaukee Public Schools 2010-11



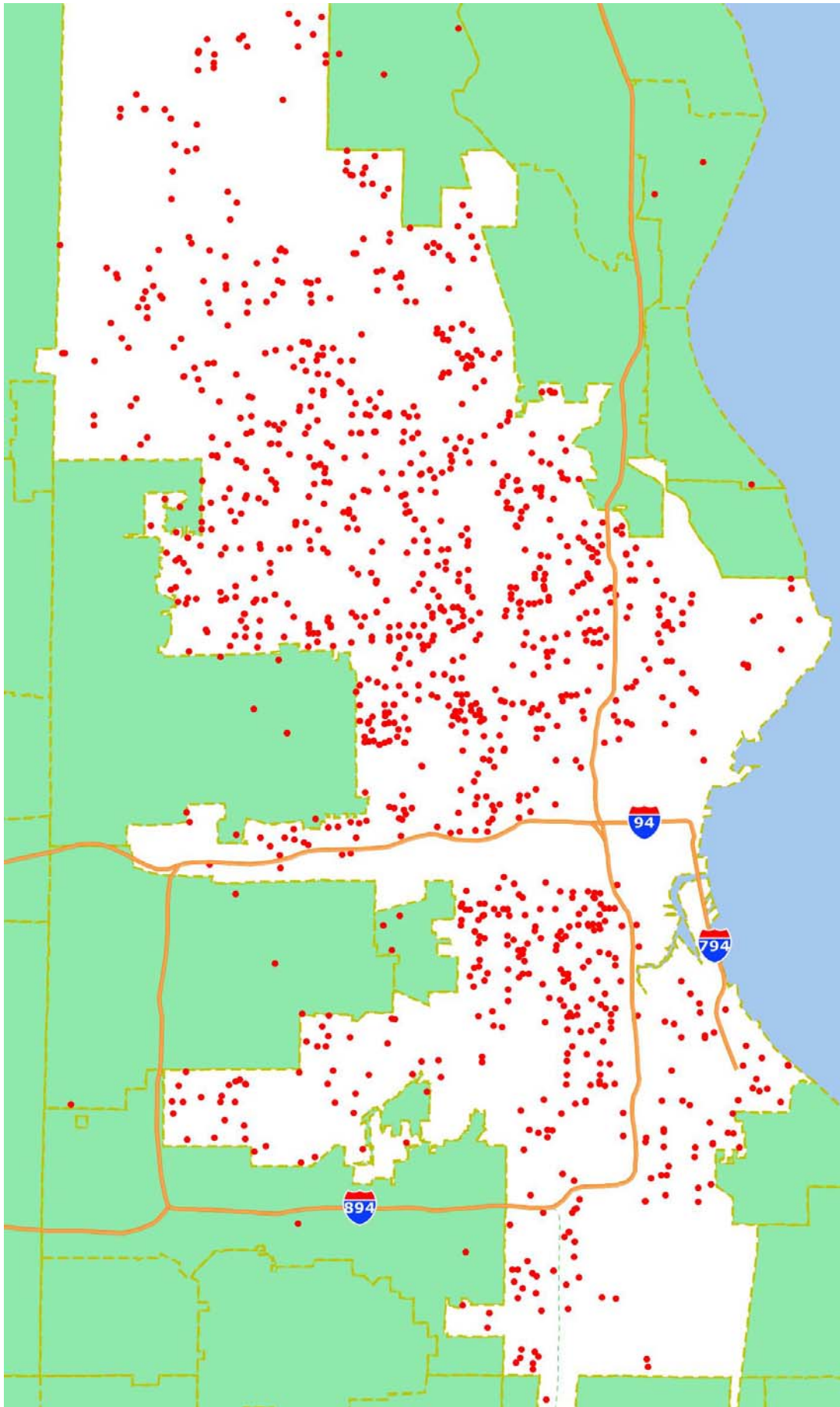


Map 3-41: 17-Year Olds (as of Sept 2010) Enrolled in Non-MPS Public Schools 2010-11

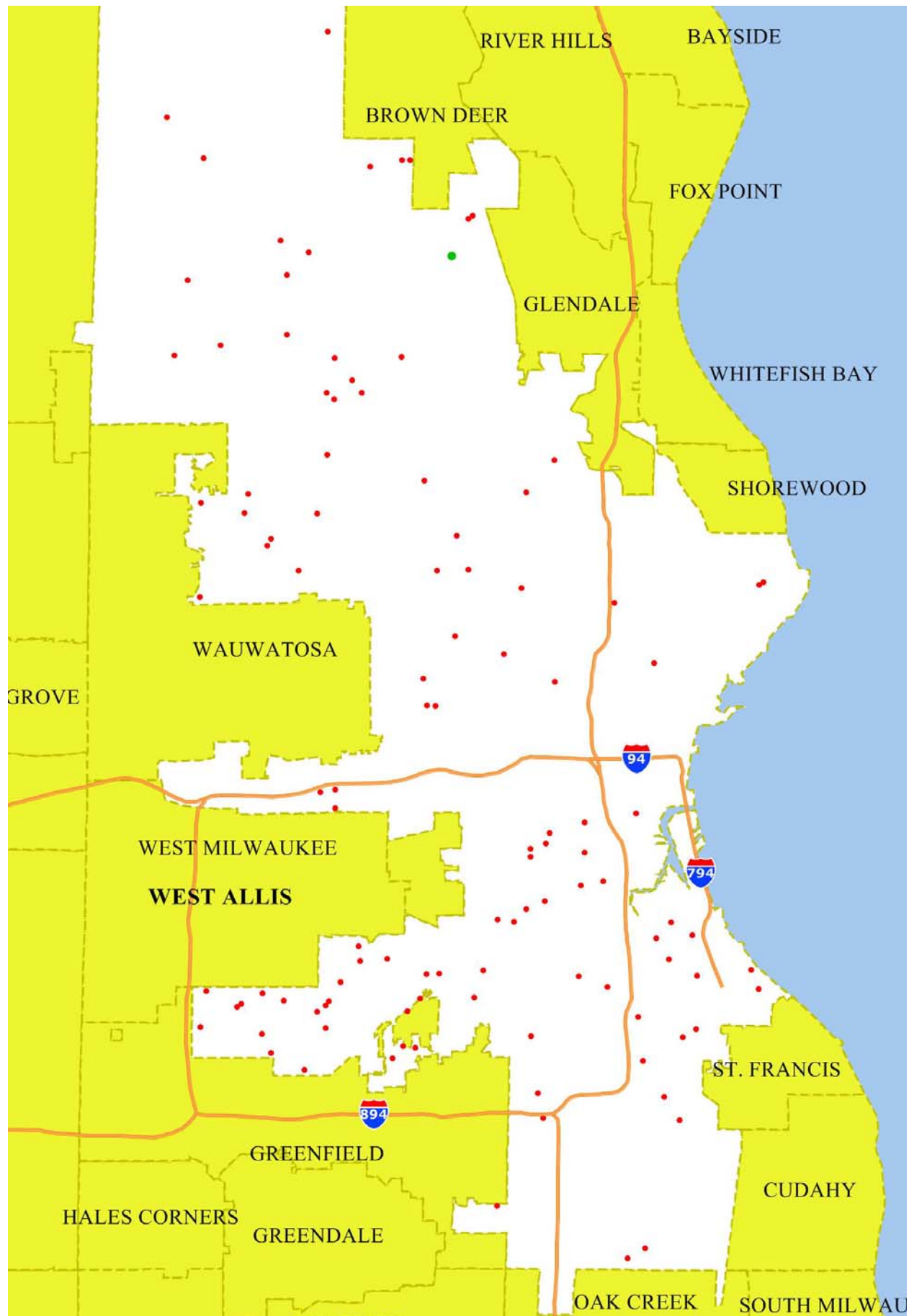
Map 3-42: 17-Year Olds (as of Sept 2010) Enrolled in Milwaukee Private Title I/Choice Schools 2010-11

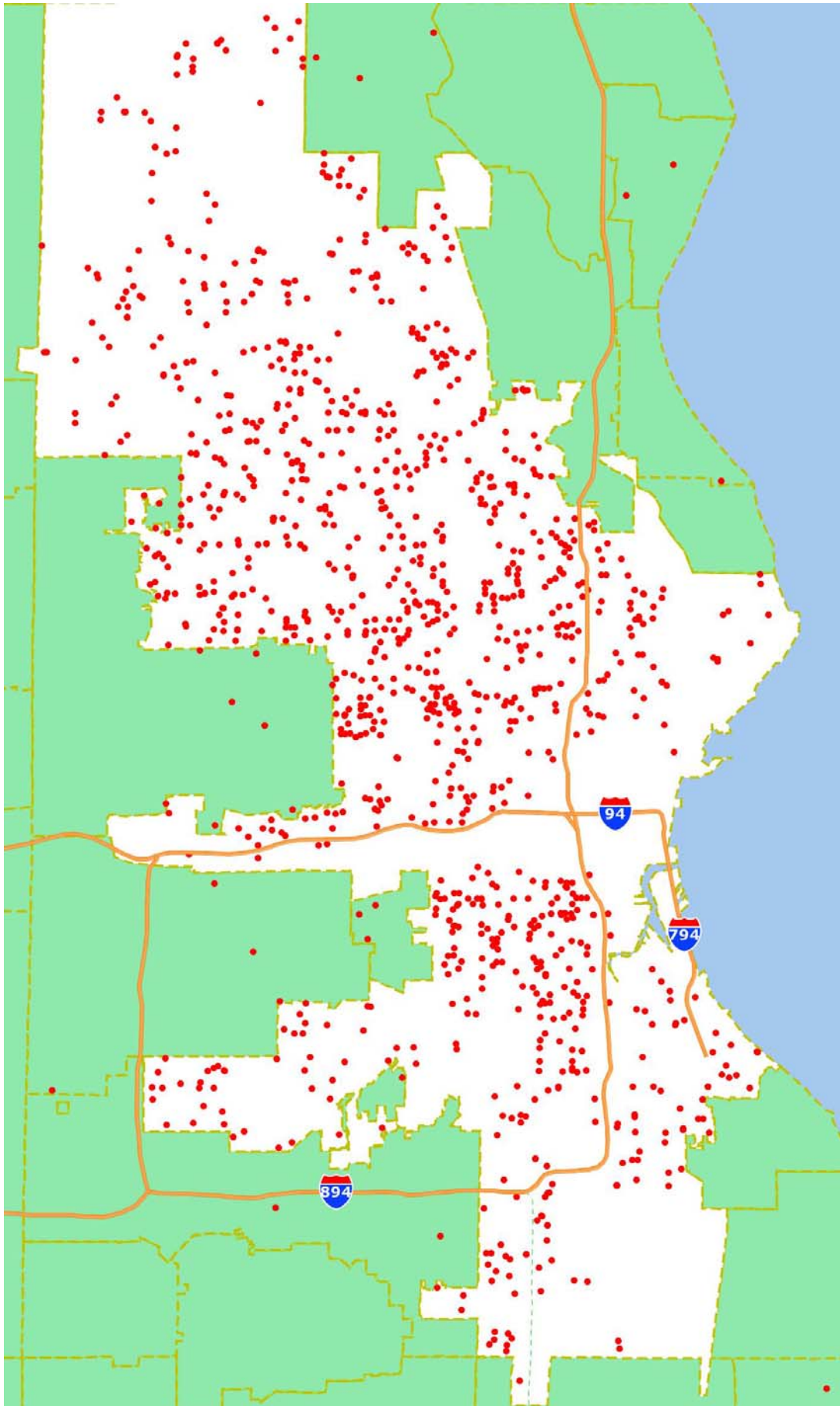

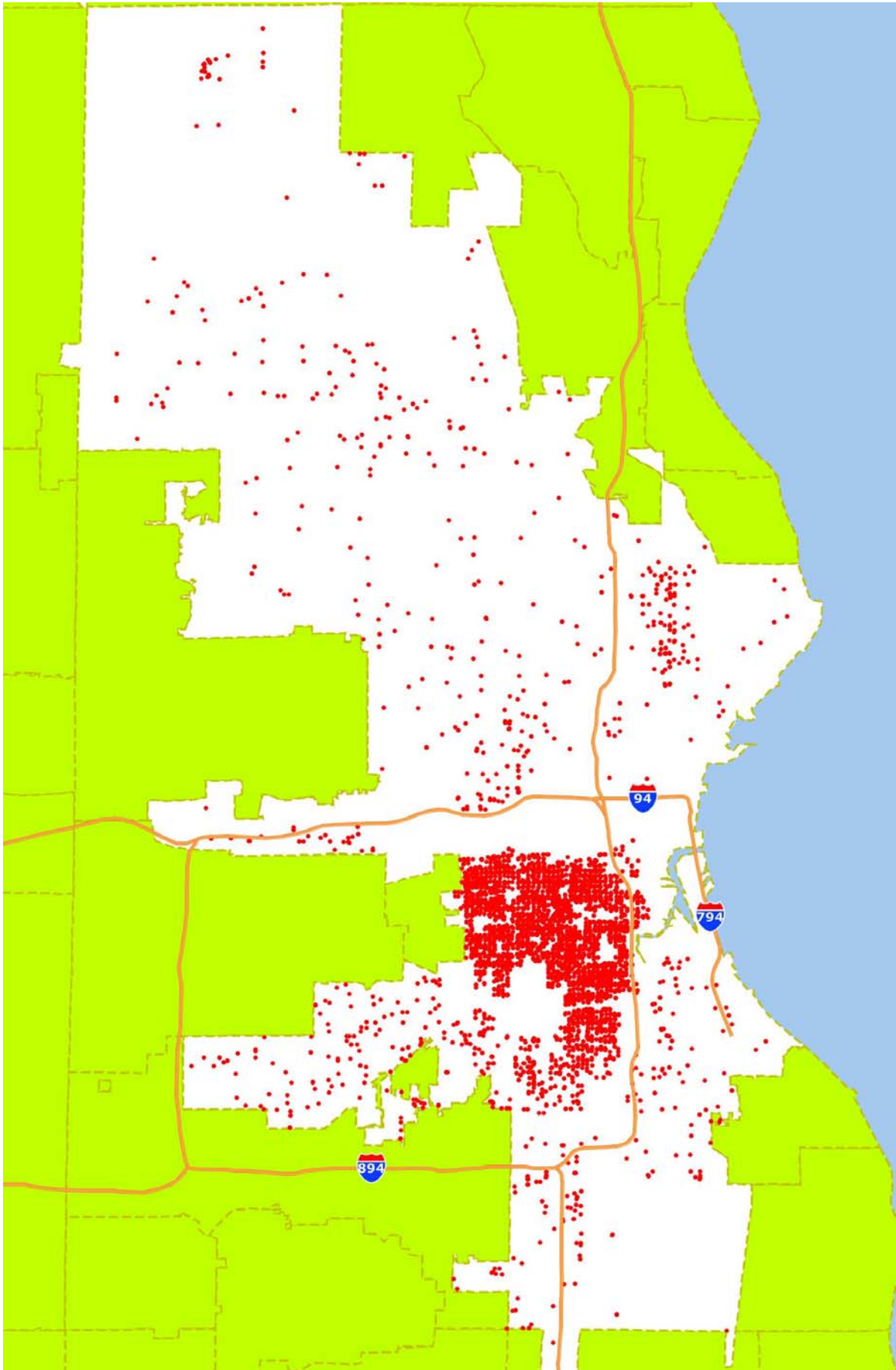

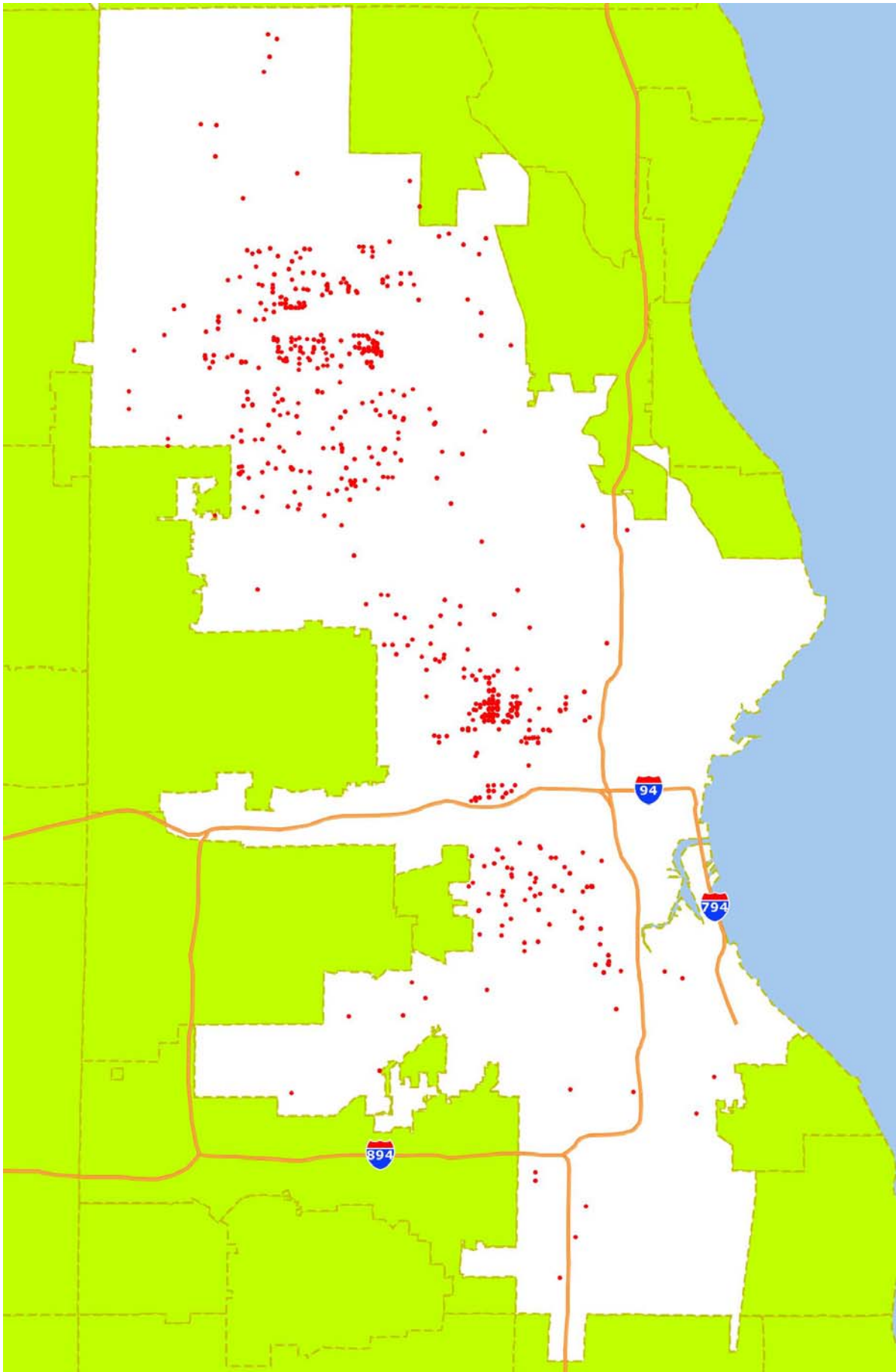

Map 4-1: English Language Learners, Spanish Speakers





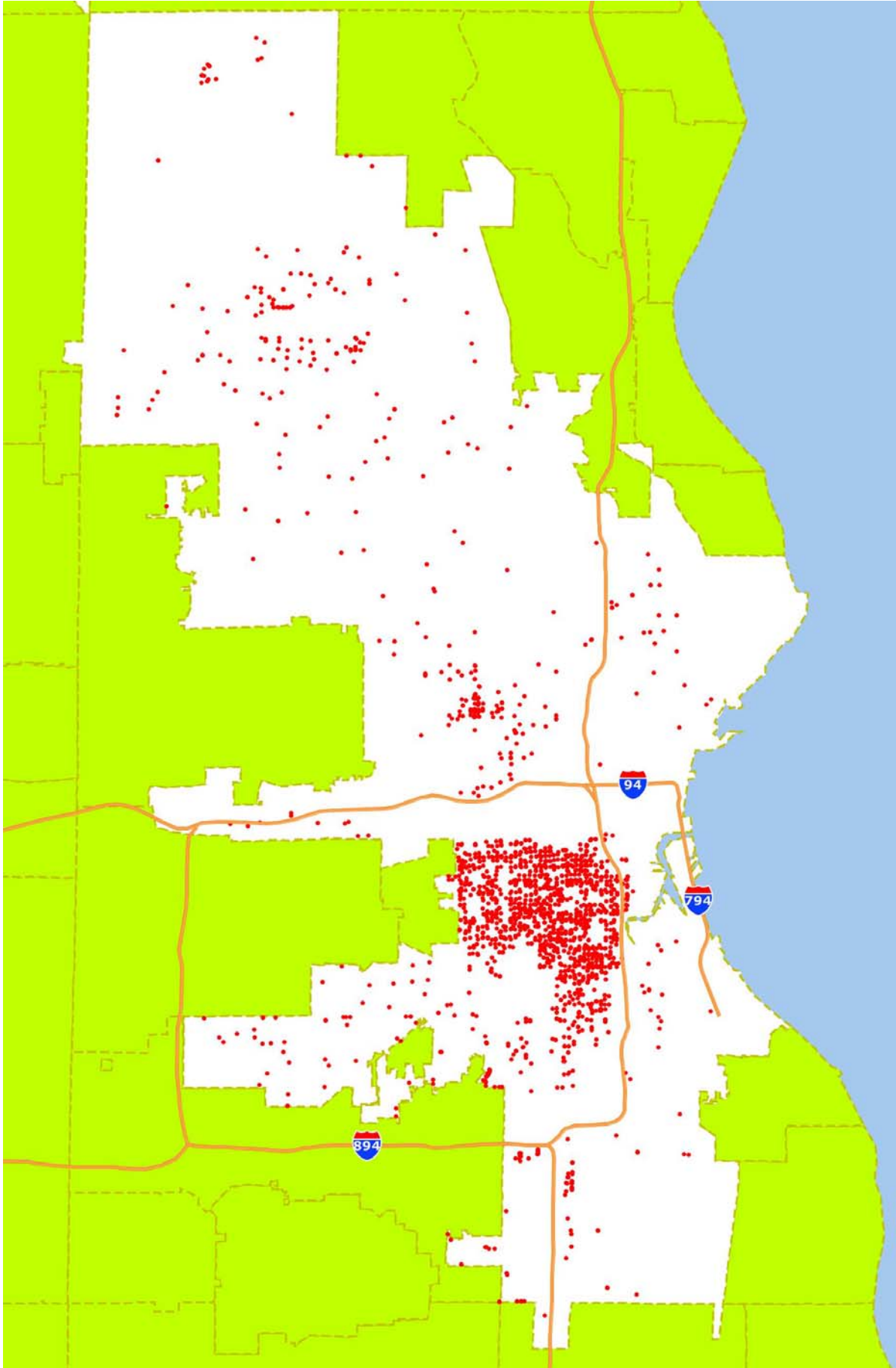
Map 2-2: English Language Learners, Hmong and Lao Speakers

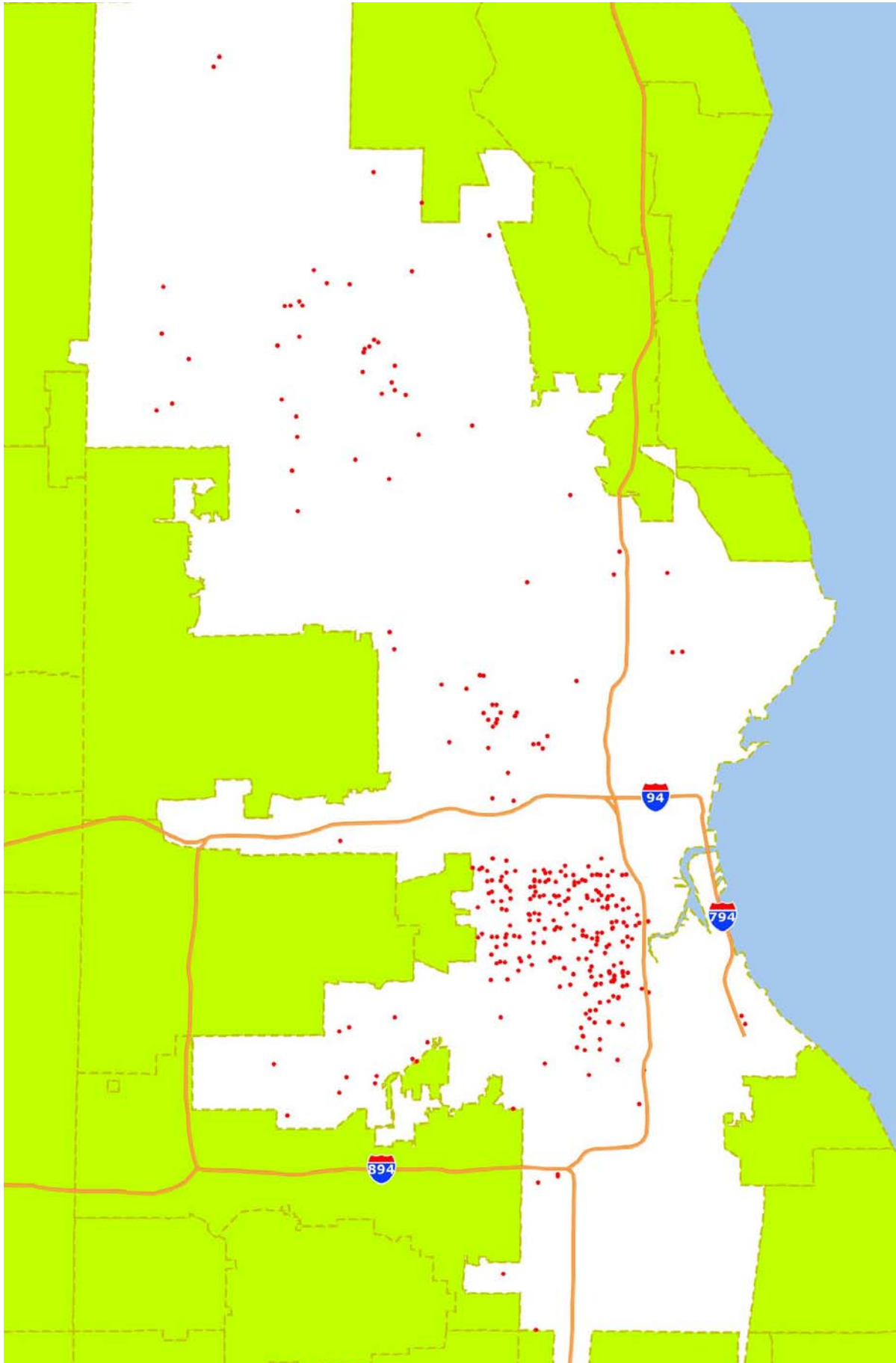

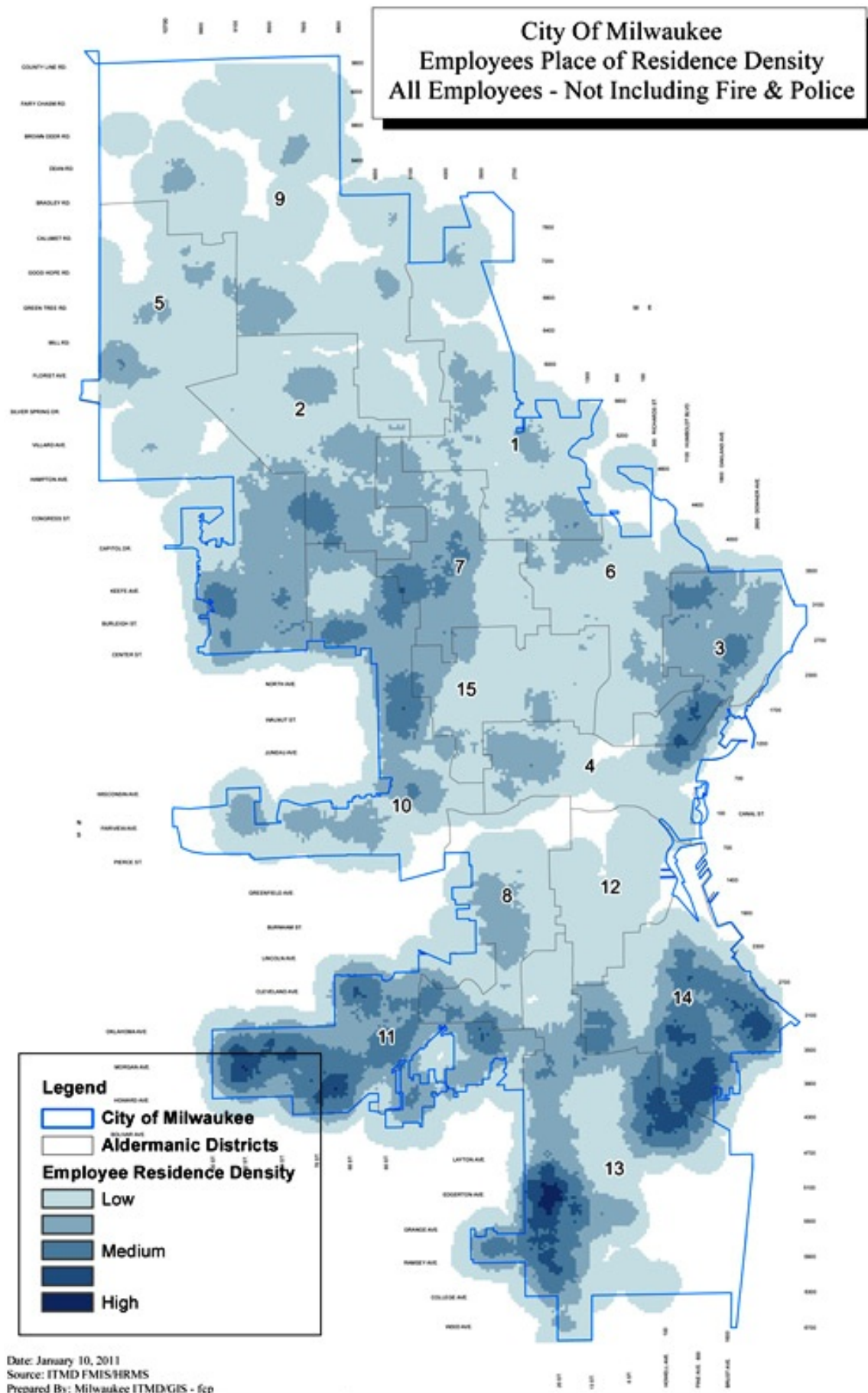
Level 3=Pupil understands and speaks conversational and academic English with decreasing hesitancy and difficulty.

Level 4=Pupil understands and speaks conversational English without apparent difficulty, but understands and speaks academic English with some hesitancy.





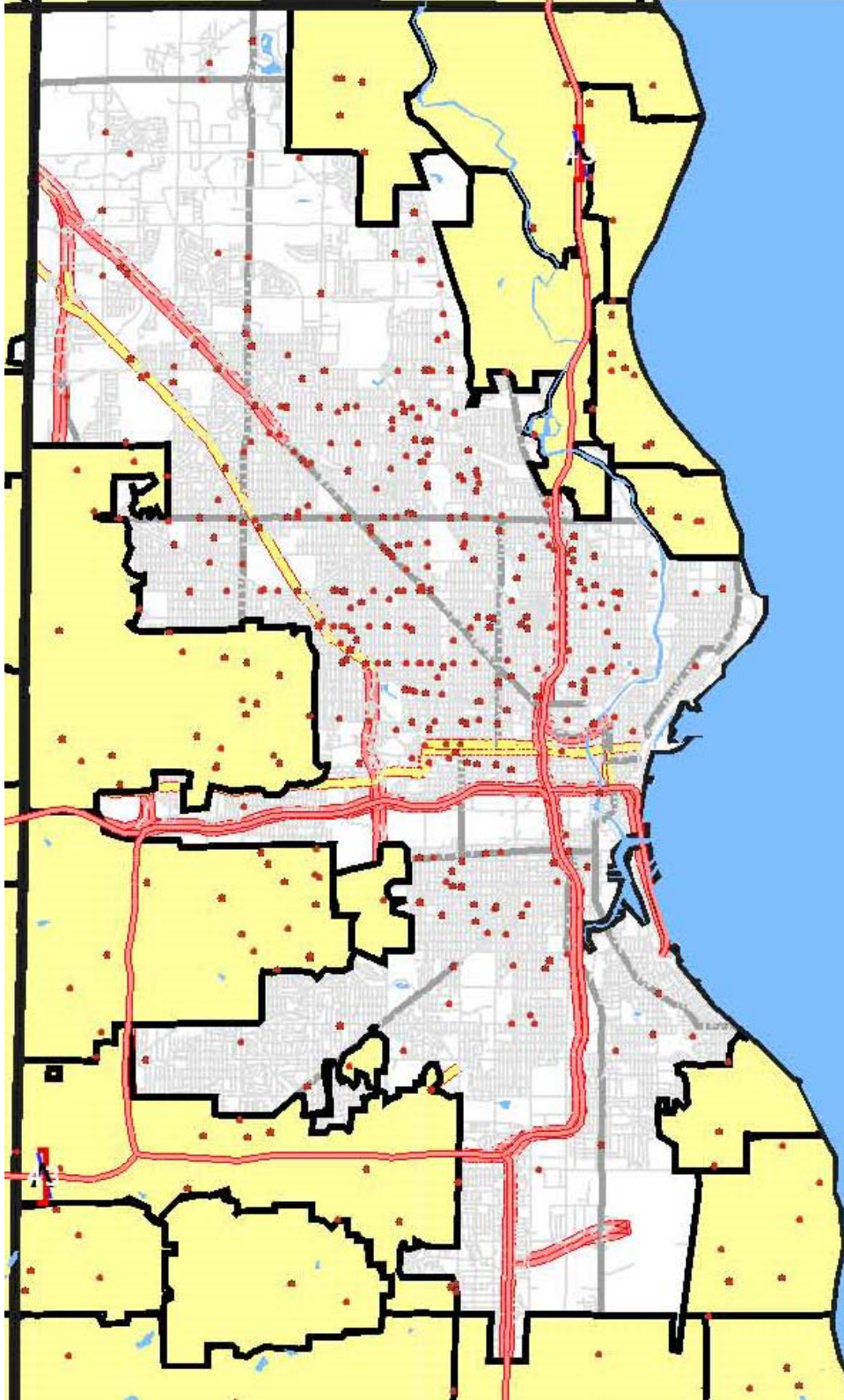
