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# Report Card on Minority and Female Participation in Construction Trade Apprentices in the Milwaukee Area: Who's in the Pipeline for Skilled Construction Trades

This report provides racial/ethnicity and gender data on apprentices in the construction trades in the Milwaukee metro area from 1999 to 2005. The data has been supplied by the Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development (DWD) Bureau of Apprenticeship Standards (BAS). The report analyzes these records to drill down to the level of individual employers and joint apprenticeship committees, where decisions are made related to employment of apprentices. Report cards are provided for 475 Milwaukee area companies with construction trade apprentices, 14 Milwaukee and Waukesha area joint apprenticeship committees (JACs), one statewide committee, and one non-union program.

Apprenticeships in Wisconsin are regulated by state statute and involve written contracts between the apprentice, the sponsoring joint apprenticeship committee, and the State of Wisconsin. All participating employers are required to take affirmative action steps to provide equal employment opportunity in apprenticeships and joint apprenticeship committees are to determine goals for participation. Sponsors with more than four apprentices must adopt an affirmative action plan for identifying, recruiting, training, and motivating present and potential minority and female (minority and non-minority) apprentices. (See the Wisconsin Administrative Code Chapter DWD 296 "Federal Equal Opportunity Standards for Apprenticeship Programs.")<sup>1</sup> Both federal and state regulations provide for systematic reviews of apprenticeship programs to determine the extent to which sponsors are complying with affirmative action requirements.<sup>2</sup>

Part One of this report (pages 1 – 58) examines the number and percentages of African Americans, Hispanics, Native Americans, and Asians employed as apprentices in individual Milwaukee area companies, compared to the numbers of white apprentices. Report cards are also provided for each of 15 local apprenticeship committees and 1 statewide committee. Part Two (pages 59 – 76) analyzes the employment of females (minority and non-minority) in apprenticeship programs. A companion study by the Employment and Training Institute, **Who Gets Construction Jobs and Where? Employment of African Americans, Hispanics and Total Minorities in the Construction Industry and Construction Trades in the Milwaukee MSA** (*online at [www.eti.uwm.edu](http://www.eti.uwm.edu)*), examines all employment for construction industries, using U.S. Census data.<sup>3</sup>

## **I. Summary Findings by Race/Ethnicity**

A total of 475 Milwaukee area companies have construction trade apprentices under contract with 15 Milwaukee joint apprenticeship committees (as of September 21, 2005) and with the Wisconsin Operating Engineers Joint Apprenticeship Committee (as of October 10, 2005).

- Milwaukee area companies are preparing 11 white apprentices for every 1 African American apprentice entering the skilled trades, and preparing 14 whites for every 1 Hispanic apprentice entering the skilled trades.

- A total of 404 of the 475 Milwaukee area companies with construction trade apprentices employ **no African American apprentices** in their programs. A total of 411 companies have **no Hispanic apprentices**.
- At the same time, nearly all of the Milwaukee area companies with construction trade apprentices (450 out of 475 companies, or 95%) employ one or more **white apprentices**, and only 25 companies have no white apprentices.
- Only 14 of the 475 companies (3%) have at least one Native American apprentice, and only 9 companies (2%) employ at least one Asian apprentice.

- Six companies each employ more than 20 **white apprentices**: Grunau Company, Pieper Electric, Town & Country Electric, Total Comfort of Wisconsin, JFK Builders, and Roman Electric Company.
- Among companies with 10 or more white apprentices, the most diversity is seen at Payne & Dolan (where 50% of apprentices are minorities) and at Zenith Tech (where 45% of apprentices are minorities). The least diversity of these companies is seen at Circle Electric (which has 10 white, but no minority, apprentices) and at Total Comfort of Wisconsin (where only 1 apprentice out of 27, or 4% , is minority).

- Midwestern Roofing & Construction has 12 roofing and waterproofing apprentices who are African American – the highest employment of **African American apprentices** in the construction trades in fall of 2005. Payne & Dolan has 8 African American apprentices, Arteaga Construction has 6 African American apprentices, and Zenith Tech has 5. Seven other companies have at least 3 African American apprentices.

- Three companies (FJA Christiansen Roofing Co., Zenith Tech, and Zignego Company) employ 5 **Hispanic apprentices**, and three companies (Payne & Dolan, LaLonde Contractors, and Service Painting Corp.) employ 3-4 Hispanic apprentices.
- Only one company (B & D Contractors) has 2 **Native Americans** in its construction trade apprenticeship program. Another 14 companies have 1 Native American apprentice each.
- One company (Payne & Dolan) employs 2 **Asian apprentices**, and only 9 companies employ 1 Asian apprentice each in their current programs.

## **Findings by Joint Apprenticeship Committee**

- In September 2005, 14 union local construction trade joint apprenticeship committees and 1 non-union program in the Milwaukee area sponsored 1,515 apprentices under active contract. The vast majority (1,285 apprentices, or 85% of the total) of construction trade apprentices are white males. Only 118 apprentices are African Americans (7.8% of the total), 89 are Hispanics (5.9%), 14 are Native Americans (0.9%), and 9 are Asians (0.6% of the total). Women hold only 26 of the apprenticeships, less than 2% of the total.
- Most construction apprentices remain the domain of white males. In September 2005, more than 90% of the apprentices were white for electricians, sheet metal workers, heat and frost insulators, and tile setters. Over 80% of apprentices were white in programs for carpenters, plumbers, ironworkers, sprinklerfitters, and glaziers.
- The trades with the highest percentages of minorities in apprenticeship programs were construction craft laborers (51% minority), cement masons (47% minority), and roofers and waterproofers (47% minority).
- The largest numbers of **African American** apprentices are sponsored by the Southeast Wisconsin Area Carpentry Joint Apprenticeship Committee (24 African American apprentices), the SE Wisconsin Roofing and Waterproofing JAC (22 apprentices), and the SE WI Construction Craft Laborers JAC (19 apprentices). Seven of the joint apprenticeship committees (JACs) currently have less than 5 African American apprentices, and 1 JAC has no African American apprentices.
- The Associated Builders and Contractors of WI-Waukesha Joint Apprenticeship Committee reports only 2 African American apprentices (in all represented trades) out of 241 apprentices, as of September 2005.
- The largest number of **Hispanic apprentices** are sponsored by the Associated Builders and Contractors of WI-Waukesha JAC (18 Hispanic apprentices), Southeast WI Area Carpentry JAC (16 apprentices), and SE Wisconsin Roofing & Waterproofing JAC (11 apprentices). Six of the joint apprenticeship committees currently have less than 5 Hispanic apprentices, and 2 committees have no Hispanic apprentices.
- Only two JACs have more than 1 **Native American apprentice** (the Southeast WI Area Carpentry JAC with 3, and the Milwaukee Area Ironworking JAC with 2). Four JACs have no Native American apprentices.
- Only five JACs have **Asian apprentices** (including Associated Builders and Contractors of WI-Waukesha with 3, and Milwaukee Area Sprinkler Fitting JAC with 2). Ten JACs have no Asian apprentices.

## **Wisconsin Operating Engineer Apprentice**

The operating engineer apprenticeship program is operated by the statewide Wisconsin Operating Engineers Joint Apprenticeship Committee. A total of 47 companies in the Milwaukee area employed 133 operating engineer apprentices, as of October 2005. (Area companies were identified by address matches with employer files. Some apprentices may be employed at worksites outside the metro area.)

- The vast majority (86%) of the Milwaukee area operating engineer apprentices are white males. (Statewide, 90% of operating engineer apprentices are white males).
- Only 14 minorities – all males -- are employed in these apprenticeships by Milwaukee area companies. These include 4 African Americans, 7 Hispanics, 1 Native American, and 1 Asian. Four women (all white) are in operating engineers apprenticeships in the Milwaukee area.

<sup>3</sup> According to the 2000 Census EEO special tabulation file, 89% of skilled construction workers in the Milwaukee metro area are white, as are 93% of construction industry supervisors and managers. When all construction company employees are considered (including laborers and support staff), whites hold 82% of construction company jobs at City of Milwaukee worksites, 90% of jobs at worksites in the Milwaukee County suburbs, and 96% of jobs at worksites in the WOW counties (Waukesha, Ozaukee, and Washington counties). ## II. Apprentices by Race/Ethnicity for 475 Milwaukee Area Companies

Data were analyzed for all Milwaukee area companies with construction trade apprentices under the jurisdiction of 15 joint apprenticeship committees in the Milwaukee and Waukesha area, as of September 21, 2005, and the Wisconsin Operating Engineers Joint Apprenticeship Committee, as of October 10, 2005. Data are reported by the Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development Bureau of Apprenticeship Standards for the following joint apprenticeship committees: Milwaukee Area Electrical, Milwaukee Area Bricklaying, Milwaukee Area Ironworking, Milwaukee Area Plumbing, Milwaukee Area Sheet Metal, Milwaukee Area Cement Masonry, Milwaukee Painting and Decorating, Milwaukee Area Sprinkler Fitting, Southern WI Area Carpentry, Southern WI Heat & Frost Insulators, Southeastern Glazing, Milwaukee Area Tile Setters, SE Wisconsin Roofing & Waterproofing, and Associated Builders and Contractors of WI-Waukesha. Apprentices under the (statewide) Operating Engineers Joint Apprenticeship Committee are included for companies located in the Milwaukee area (although the worksite of the apprentice was not identified).

The table below summarizes the data by company. Note: Apprentices are not included for the Milwaukee Area Steam Fitter Joint Apprenticeship Committee, where 2005 data was not provided.

### **III. Number and Percent of Minority Apprentices by Trade for the Last Six Years**

#### **A. Milwaukee Area Bricklaying Joint Apprenticeship Committee**

The Milwaukee Area Bricklaying Joint Apprenticeship Committee reported 41 apprentices as of 2005 (September), 50 apprentices in 2003 (March), 36 in 2001 (June), and 43 in 1999 (September).

- Twenty-two percent of the bricklayer apprentices are held by minorities, including 8 African Americans and 1 Hispanic in 2005.
- This trade has shown improvements in the number of African American apprentices, from 1 in 1999 to 8 in 2005.

## B. Southeast WI Carpentry Joint Apprenticeship Committee

Reports by the Southeast WI Carpentry Joint Apprenticeship Committee showed 267 apprentices in 2005 (September), 301 in 2003 (March), 328 in 2001 (June), and 309 in 1999 (September).

- The vast majority of carpenter apprentices in the Milwaukee area continue to be white males.
- There are currently nine white carpenter apprentices employed for every 1 African American apprentice, and 14 white apprentices for every 1 Hispanic apprentice.

The Milwaukee Area Steamfitter Joint Apprenticeship Committee reported 126 apprentices in 2003 (March), 153 in 2001 (June), and 120 in 1999 (September). Data reports were not provided in 2005.

- In March of 2003, out of 126 steamfitter apprentices, 109 were white, 9 African American, 3 Hispanic, 4 Native American, and 1 Asian.

## P. Wisconsin Operating Engineers Joint Apprenticeship Committee

The operating engineers apprenticeship program is sponsored by a statewide joint apprenticeship committee, which reported 436 apprentices employed as of October 10, 2005. (Milwaukee area companies were identified based on name matches with employer address files.)

- Milwaukee area companies account for at least 133 of these apprentices, of which only 4 are African Americans, 7 are Hispanics, 1 is a Native American, and 2 are Asians.
- Statewide, 94.3% of operating engineer apprentices are whites. In Milwaukee area companies, 89.5% of the apprentices are white.

## Q. Associated Builders and Contractors of WI-Waukesha Apprentices (Non-Union)

The Associated Builders and Contractors of WI-Waukesha Joint Apprentices Committee reported 241 apprentices as of September 21, 2005, in 12 construction trade areas. (Note: These apprentices are not included in union joint apprenticeship committees totals for Sections A. to P. above.)

- Only 2 apprentices (less than 1%) under the Associated Builders and Contractors of WI-Waukesha JAC are African Americans, while 224 (90%) are white.
- A total of 18 Hispanics are in apprentices under the Associated Builders and Contractors of WI-Waukesha JAC. Other minorities include 3 Asians and 1 Native American.
- The Associated Builders and Contractors of WI-Waukesha JAC reported 3 female apprentices, all white.
- The most white apprentices are employed by Town & Country Electric (which has 30 white, 1 African American, and 2 Hispanic apprentices) and Circle Electric (which has 10 white and no minority apprentices).
- All of the 106 companies employing apprentices under the Associated Builders and Contractors of WI-Waukesha JAC have at least one white apprentice, and 20 companies have at least 3 white apprentices. At the same time, only 11 companies have any non-white apprentices.
- Two companies have at least 5 minority apprentices: FJA Christiansen Roofing Co. (with 5 Hispanic, 1 Native American and 1 white apprentices) and Zignego (with 5 Hispanic and 7 white apprentices).

#### IV. Summary Findings for Female Apprentices

In September 2005, 15 local construction trade joint apprenticeship committees in the Milwaukee area reported 1,515 apprentices under active contract. Of these, 1848 are males and only 31 are females. (Another 5 females are operating engineer apprentices, out of 133 operating engineer apprentices with Milwaukee area companies.)

- In apprentices sponsored by the 15 local trade committees, very few women (31 out of 1,515 apprentices) are employed, and only 6 are minority women. These include 5 African Americans (2 painting apprentices, 2 construction craft laborer apprentices, and 1 electrician apprentice) and 1 Hispanic woman in a plumbing apprentice.
- Females are underrepresented in every trade area.

Another 5 women are employed in operating engineer apprenticeships with Milwaukee area companies. All are white.

#### **Apprentices by Gender for Milwaukee Area Companies**

Of the 475 Milwaukee area companies with construction trade apprentices, only 31 companies employ female apprentices (as of Fall 2005).

- Thirty-six female apprentices are employed in the 16 construction trades analyzed for Milwaukee area companies. These included 28 whites (78% of the total), 7 African Americans (19%), and 1 Hispanic (3%).

- Olympic Wall Systems has 4 female apprentices as tapers and finishers, and Payne & Dolan has 2 female apprentices – an operating engineer and a constructive craft laborer.

**V. Number and Percent of Female Apprentices by Trade for the Last Six Years**

**A. Milwaukee Area Bricklaying Joint Apprenticeship Committee**

The Milwaukee Area Bricklaying Joint Apprenticeship Committee sponsored no females (out of 41 apprentices) as September 2005 and no female apprentices (out of 50 apprentices) as of March 2003. In June 2001, the committee sponsored 1 female (out of 36 apprentices), and in September 1999 the committee sponsored 1 female (out of 43 apprentices).

- One white female apprentice (white) was sponsored in 2001 (June) and two (one white and one Hispanic) were sponsored in 1999 (September).

## B. Southeast WI Carpentry Joint Apprenticeship Committee

The Southeast WI Carpentry Joint Apprenticeship Committee sponsored 1 female apprentice in 2005 (September), 7 in 2003 (March), 12 in 2001 (June), and 9 in 1999 (September).

- Only 3 women (1.1% of the total) is sponsored in the carpenter apprenticeship program (as of September 2005), compared to 12 in 2001 (3.7% of the total).
- Most of the female carpenter apprentices have been white.
